# premature

# administer

v. to oversee and control the operation or arrangement of something

synonym: allocate, distribute, dispense

# specifically

adv. only associated with or meant for one thingsynonym: especially, particularly, notably

(1) designed specifically for men, (2) for specifically

This ad campaign is aimed **specifically** at young women.

### sustain

v. to supply enough of what somebody or something needs to survive or exist; to accept as valid

synonym: maintain, nurture, support

American customers

(1) **sustain** a good relationship with him, (2) **sustain** a wellness lifestyle

She struggled to **sustain** the children's reading habits.

#### addiction

 the inability to stop using or doing something as a habit, especially something harmful synonym: dependence

# progression

# consumption

 the amount used or eaten; the act of using up a resource such as energy, food, or materials

synonym: usage, uptake, utilization

# prevalence

the state or condition of being widespread or common;
 the extent or frequency of occurrence of a disease or condition in a given population at a specific time

*synonym*: preponderance, currency, frequency

(1) **prevalence** rate, (2) high **prevalence** of a diabetes

The **prevalence** of allergies has increased in recent years.

### historic

adj. famous or significant in history, or potentially so synonym: memorable, momentous, historical

(1) **historic** accomplishment, (2) achieve the **historic** feat The Chinese people have accomplished several **historic** feats.

# primarily

adv. mainly

synonym: largely, mainly, mostly

(1) intended **primarily** for young people, (2) **primarily** affect adults

All peaceful cooperation is based primarily on mutual trust.

### firsthand

adv. from the source; directly; (adjective) received directly from a source

*synonym*: direct

(1) hear customer's voices **firsthand**, (2) conduct **firsthand** research

The manager tried to hear customers' voices firsthand.

#### secondhand

*adj.* having been previously owned or used by someone else *synonym*: used, pre-owned, recycled

(1) **secondhand** car, (2) **secondhand** information

He was excited to find a vintage suit at the **secondhand** shop for a fraction of the price of a new one.

# exposure

 the state of being in a particular situation or place where there is no protection from or guarantee to something harmful; the disclosure of something secret

synonym: vulnerability, disclosure, uncovering

#### disease

 a disorder or illness that affects the body or mind, often characterized by specific symptoms or abnormal functioning of organs or systems

### alcohol

 a clear liquid that can make people drunk and is used in medicines, cleaning products, etc.

# predecessor

# surgeon

toll

money that you have to pay to use a particular road,bridge, etc.; (verb) to ring slowly

synonym: fee, cost, expense

(1) a **toll** road, (2) **toll** a bell at his death There is no **toll** car park nearby.

#### relate

 to establish a connection or association between two or more things; to narrate or tell about an event, experience, or relationship; to empathize or feel sympathy with someone or something

synonym: connect, link, associate

#### conservative

adj. holding traditional views and values and opposed to change or innovation

### wrap

# confer

v. to have a meeting or discussion to come to a decision or agreement or exchange ideas; to bestow something

### individual

# unnecessary

# trajectory

#### horrible

adj. extremely unpleasant or bad; causing fear or disgust synonym: dreadful, terrible, awful

The experience was horrible and left a lasting impression.

#### conclude

 to come to an end or close; to reach a judgment or opinion by reasoning

synonym: complete, finish, decide

(1) **conclude** a meeting, (2) **conclude** that he is healthy We **concluded** a cease-fire.

#### enormous

adj. extremely large or great synonym: huge, giant, gigantic

(1) **enormous** amount, (2) **enormous** potential Shakespeare's output of poetry was **enormous**.

# regulator

 a person or thing that controls or balances something; a person or an organization that is responsible for control and supervision of a particular activity or area of public interest

synonym: controller, supervisor, monitor

(1) regulator body, (2) a speed regulator

The financial industry **regulator** was responsible for ensuring that companies followed the laws.

#### reverse

v. to change something's direction, order, position, decision, etc., to the opposite one; (adjective) directed or moving toward the rear

synonym: overturn, shift, switch

(1) **reverse** the trend, (2) **reverse** the order

The restaurant **reversed** a ban on smoking.

#### unravel

- v. undo twisted, knitted, or woven threads by separating it synonym: separate, unknot, ravel

#### industrious

# unregulated

# marketplace

# internal

adj. of or relating to the inside of something synonym: interior, inner, domestic

#### nicotine

# gesture

### storage

 the act or process of putting in and keeping something in a particular place for use in the future; an electronic memory device that can store information

# dispense

v. to distribute, allocate, or deliver something to the intended recipients

synonym: distribute, allocate, deal out

any customary observance or practice; any prescribed procedure for conducting religious ceremonies

synonym: tradition, ceremony, routine

# stylize

v. to show, do, or represent something according to a particular style, especially a conventional one

# segment

a part or section of something; a distinct group within a larger whole

# pharmaceutical

adj. relating to the production and selling of the medical drugs

synonym: drug, medication, prescription

# physiological

adj. relating to the normal functioning of living organisms and their organs and systems; concerning the physical or biochemical processes and activities that occur within the body synonym: biological, organic, bodily

# publicly

adv. in a manner accessible to or observable by the public; by the government

# deny

v. to state that one refuses to admit the existence or truth of something

synonym: refute, reject, repudiate

adamantly deny killing, (2) deny the allegations
 still denying stealing the money from the cash register.

#### causal

adj. relating to or indicating a cause or the relationship between causes and effects; resulting from a causesynonym: causative, contributory, connected

synonym. Causalive, Continuatory, Connected

(1) causal chain, (2) causal effect

The study aimed to establish a **causal** relationship between smoking and lung cancer.

#### scare

- v. to frighten a person or animal, or to become frightened synonym: frighten, spook, intimidate
- (1) **scare** off her attacker by screaming, (2) **scare** the birds away

We hit the ground to **scare** out the rabbits.

#### advertise

v. to draw attention to something such as a product, service, or event in public to encourage people to buy, use, or attend it

### feat

# imagery

#### reassurance

- the act of giving advice or help to make someone feel less worried; the act of giving someone confidence
- synonym: encouragement, comfort, support
- (1) give **reassurance**, (2) **reassurance** of my commitment He needed **reassurance** that everything would be alright.

# physician

- n. a medical doctor who practices medicinesynonym: doctor, practitioner, medic
- (1) the advice of the **physician**, (2) consult with a **physician** She visited the local **physician** to seek treatment for her persistent headache.

# irritating

adj. causing annoyance, frustration, or exasperation; provoking impatience or irritation

*synonym*: annoying, bothersome, vexing

#### irritation

 a feeling of annoyance or frustration that results from something bothersome or unpleasant; a physical reaction such as itching or inflammation that results from exposure to an irritant

# cough

### absence

# regulation

 an official rule made and maintained by a government or some other authority; the act of controlling or directing something according to a rule

synonym: constraint, restriction, rule

(1) a company regulation, (2) regulation by the

government

The **regulation** approved by Congress was perfunctorily implemented.

#### modification

*n.* the act of changing something, usually to improve it, or something changed

*synonym*: change, amendment, alteration

#### filter

 any of several types of equipment or systems used to separate particles from liquids or gases or to remove specific forms of light

*synonym*: strainer

### innovation

 the creation of a new device or process resulting from study and experimentation

*synonym*: invention, initiation, creation

(1) innovation leader, (2) cutting-edge innovation

The vegetarian burger was an **innovation** that quickly spread to the United Kingdom.

# proof

 a fact or piece of information that shows something is true or exists

synonym: testimony, evidence, assurance

(1) documentary **proof**, (2) a geometric **proof** 

**Proof** is better than argument.

# government

 the group of people with authority to control a country or state

*synonym*: administration, regime, state

(1) **government** bureaucracy, (2) **government** funding The federal **government** is planning to increase taxes for the next fiscal year.

#### asbestos

n. a set of naturally occurring fibrous minerals that were previously used in various building materials, including insulation, roofing, and fireproofing, but later found to be carcinogenic and cause respiratory diseases

synonym: mineral fiber, chrysotile

#### inhale

# lung

- either of the two organs in the chest that people and some animals use for breathing

 thread or filament used to make a vegetable tissue, mineral material, or textile

synonym: yarn, thread, wool

# typical

### brand

#### decide

v. to make up someone's mind about something; to come to a conclusion or judgment after considering options

synonym: choose, determine, settle

### quitter

 a person who gives up easily or does not have the determination to finish what they have started

synonym: coward, deserter, surrender

(1) easy quitter, (2) serial quitter

tar

 a thick, sticky substance that is dark in color and is commonly used for road surfacing or as a material for roofing; a common byproduct of burning coal or wood
