### creative

adj. relating to or involving the use of skill and original and unusual ideas to create something

# imply

v. to indicate the truth or existence of something without referring to it

synonym: hint, indicate, denote

(1) **imply** a strong correlation, (2) **imply** the presence of alien

The salespeople speak in technical terms to **imply** that they are more knowledgeable than the customer.

#### couch

 a piece of furniture made for sitting, usually with a back and armrests, designed to seat more than one person

synonym: sofa, settee, divan

I love to relax on the **couch** and watch movies on the weekends.

### extract

n. a short passage taken from a book, piece of music, etc.; a substance obtained from something through a specific process; (verb) to obtain from something or to remove something by effort or force

synonym: excerpt, quote, distillation

destroy

 to ruin or damage severely or completely; to eradicate or eliminate completely

### economical

- adj. providing a satisfactory return on the money, time, or effort; not using more money, fuel, etc. than necessarysynonym: frugal, thrifty, parsimonious

#### contest

- a competition in which people compete for supremacy in a sport or other activity; a struggle between rivals

# unproductive

adj. not producing or able to produce very much or desired results

synonym: fruitless, ineffective, idle

### context

 the circumstances, facts, or conditions that surround a particular event, situation, or statement and that give it meaning

synonym: background, setting, environment

(1) historical context, (2) legal context

It's important to understand the **context** of a situation before making a decision.

### crisis

 a time of great disagreement, confusion, or danger when problems must be resolved or critical decisions must be taken

*synonym*: concern, problem, emergency

(1) financial **crisis**, (2) **crisis** management

The Chinese word for **crisis** comprises two characters, one for danger and the other for opportunity.

# depression

 a mental condition in which a person feels very unhappy and without hope for the future; a severe recession in an economy or market

synonym: recession, slump, despair

(1) the Great **Depression**, (2) the root problem of her **depression** 

**Depression** symptoms might include a decrease in appetite and weight loss.

# productivity

n. the state or quality of being productive; the rate at which a company or individual produces goods or services, often measured in terms of output per unit of input, such as labor, capital, or time

synonym: efficiency, output, performance

(1) **productivity** growth, (2) improved **productivity**She increased her **productivity** by planning out her tasks for the day.

# dynamic

adj. having a lot of energy, ideas, and enthusiasm, and a strong personality; of or relating to dynamics (= the branch of physics and engineering concerned with the forces that cause motions of bodies)

synonym: energetic, active, vital

# efficiently

adv. in a way that produces maximum output with minimum effort or expense

synonym: expeditiously, skillfully, ably

(1) **efficiently** combined, (2) develop software more **efficiently** 

We can resolve support requests quickly and **efficiently** by utilization of Al.

# problematic

*adj.* full of difficulties; difficult to deal with or solve *synonym*: inappropriate, inconvenient, worrisome

(1) a problematic situation, (2) seems to be highly

# problematic

Direct democracy is effective in quickly resolving **problematic** situations within a community.

relate

 to establish a connection or association between two or more things; to narrate or tell about an event, experience, or relationship; to empathize or feel sympathy with someone or something

# mortgage

 a loan secured by the collateral of a specific property, such as a house, that is repaid over a set period of time with interest; the legal agreement governing this loan

### foreclosure

### debate

# profession

an occupation or vocation requiring advanced education or specialized training

# argue

to express differing opinions or points of view, often in a heated or contentious manner; to present a case or reasoning to persuade or convince others

synonym: debate, dispute, quarrel

# capture

to catch a person or an animal and confine them in an area which they cannot escape

synonym: catch, arrest, imprison

synonym: farming, husbandry, agribusiness

### labor

n. productive work, especially physical work done for wages; the people who do manual or physical work in a country or company for wage; (verb) to work hard or to strive and make an effort to reach a goal

# spreadsheet

- a computer program that is used for displaying and dealing with numbers by arranging them in rows and columns
- a spreadsheet program,

### tableau

 a group of people or objects arranged in a scene that represents a story or a specific situation; a tableau vivant is a live representation of a picture or scene, often used in theater or dance

#### movement

### merchant

a person who buys and sells a large number of goods, especially one who imports and exports goods

# proprietor

a person who owns and runs a business, especially a hotel, a shop, or a company

*synonym*: owner, keeper, possessor

- welcoming. a sum of money charged for a particular service
- (1) **fee** calculation, (2) service **fee** The lawyer's **fee** for the case was \$10,000.

asset

something or someone that is useful or valuable quality, skill, etc.; valuable property

synonym: aid, resource, equity

synonym: charge, cost, expense

(1) frozen assets, (2) liquid assets of the company A sense of humor is an invaluable **asset** in this job.

sterile

adj. free from living microorganisms, especially bacteria, fungi, and viruses; incapable of reproducing

synonym: clean, germ-free, hygienic

Surgeons must use **sterile** instruments to prevent infection during an operation.

### landlord

a person or organization that rents a room, a house, an office, etc.

synonym: lessor, owner, proprietor

### simulate

scenario

a description of possible actions or events in the future;
 a written outline of a play, film, or literary work

### invest

v. to put money, effort, time, etc. into something to make a profit or achieve a result

# siphon

 a tube or conduit used to transfer liquids, usually from a higher to a lower level, by means of atmospheric pressure, gravity, or vacuum; a device used to extract a liquid from a container

#### revolution

synonym: country, state, sovereign entity

# opposed

adj. being completely different from something or disagreeing strongly with something

synonym: anti, averse, hostile

(1) two **opposed** characters, (2) absolutely **opposed** to abortion

# specialize

 to become an expert in a specific career field, study, or business

synonym: narrow down, particularize

(1) **specialize** in child care, (2) **specialize** in market research

The restaurant has chefs who specialize in beef.

### fellow

adj. someone who has the same job or interests as you, or is in the same class, profession, or situation as you

synonym: buddy, mate, affiliate

(1) junior **fellow**, (2) nice **fellow** 

He is the kind of **fellow** who only works for his success.

# definitely

*adv.* without any question and beyond doubt; clearly *synonym*: absolutely, certainly, indeed

(1) **definitely** become a problem, (2) say **definitely** The paper is **definitely** worth reading thoroughly.

# shopkeeper

 a person who owns or manages a shop, especially a small local business

*synonym*: merchant, storekeeper, retailer

(1) local shopkeeper, (2) general shopkeeper

The elderly **shopkeeper** greeted customers and helped them find what they sought.

### opera

 a drama set to music, in which the words are sung rather than spoken

synonym: musical, operetta, oratorio

(1) ballad opera, (2) opera performance

She loves going to the **opera** house and hearing the beautiful music.

# struggle

v. to make a great effort to do something when it is difficult, or there are a lot of problems; to use force or violence to break away from restraint or constriction

synonym: toil, strive, compete

# wage

- n. a particular amount of money that somebody earns, usually every week or every month, for work or servicessynonym: payment, compensation, salary

*n.* the way two persons or groups of people feel and act toward one another

# bargain

an agreement between two parties regarding the terms of a purchase or a transaction; a deal or a negotiation that results in a product or a service being acquired for a lower price than usual or expected

### neoclassical

# logic

 a way of thinking or reasoning conducted or evaluated by strict validity principles; the study of correct reasoning or good arguments

synonym: reasoning, reason, ratiocination

# objective

a goal, aim, or purpose that is intended or sought after; a goal that is based on facts, evidence, or unbiased reasoning rather than personal opinions, feelings, or beliefs; (adjective) of or relating something that is based on facts and not influenced by personal feelings or biases

synonym: goal, purpose, aim

(1) **objective** assessment, (2) financial **objective**The study's main **objective** is to identify risk factors for heart disease.

# subjective

 adj. based on a personal perspective or feeling rather than an unbiased or objective view; influenced by personal opinions, interpretations, or feelings

synonym: personal, individual, experiential

(1) **subjective** opinion, (2) **subjective** interpretation The concept of time is **subjective** and can feel longer or shorter depending on the situation.

### individual

- n. a single person or thing, as distinct from a groupsynonym: person, being, self

### decision

 n. the act or process of making up someone's mind about something; a choice or judgment reached after considering options

 a well-known phrase that expresses a general or fundamental truth, principle, or rule for behavior

### leisure

 the freedom provided by the absence of pressures or responsibilities

synonym: relaxation, rest, downtime

#### consume

v. to spend something, especially fuel, energy, or time, in a large amount

*synonym*: absorb, ingest, use up

### utility

 n. the state or quality of being useful or convenient; the service, such as electric power or water or transportation, provided by a public

synonym: usefulness, practicality, utility

(1) utility costs, (2) marginal utility

proxy

 a person or entity that is authorized to act on behalf of another person or entity

synonym: surrogate, representative, agent

(1) healthcare **proxy**, (2) **proxy** server

firm

adj. resolute or unwavering in decision-making or action; strong or secure in structure, make, or composition; reliable, trustworthy, or dependable; (noun) a business or company

profit

money that is earned in business or by selling things after deducting the costs involved

aggregate

 a collection or sum of different things often used to describe a total or combination of items

synonym: total, sum, whole

(1) data aggregate, (2) an aggregate of people

The **aggregate** amount of money raised for the charity was over a million dollars.

fancy

v. to want to do or have something; (noun) something that many people believe but that is false, or that does not exist; imagination or fantasy

synonym: imagine, visualize, (noun) fantasy

(1) **fancy** a cup of coffee, (2) a flight of **fancy** I don't **fancy** acting in such an important role.

### supple

adj. flexible and easy to bend or move; gracefully agile; adaptable or responsive to change or new ideas

synonym: flexible, pliable, bendable

The ballerina's **supple** movements left the audience mesmerized.

#### curve

 a bend or angle in a line or surface that deviates from a straight or flat path; a gradual or smooth change in direction or shape

synonym: bend, arc, turn

# equilibrium

a state in which opposing forces or influences are balanced

synonym: balance, stability, harmony

### **Newtonian**

adj. relating to Sir Isaac Newton or his laws of motion and universal gravitation

# reproductive

# exchange
