violent

adj. involving or caused by physical force or aggression against someone or something

climate

n. the weather in a particular location averaged over some long period

synonym: atmosphere, weather, environment

represent

planet

 any of the nine large celestial bodies that circle in the solar system; any celestial body that revolves around a star

menopause

 the natural cessation of menstruation and fertility in women, typically occurring between the ages of 45 and 55

synonym: climacteric, midlife transition

useless

adj. not serving any useful purpose; having no practical result

redefine

accomplish

v. to finish or achieve something successfully

synonym: achieve, complete, execute

spectrum

 an ordered array of colors into which a light beam can be split

synonym: range, scale, spread

(1) a broad **spectrum** of opinion, (2) infrared **spectrum** This device displayed the speech **spectrum** spectrographically.

brave

adj. showing courage or fearlessness in the face of danger, difficulty, or adversity

synonym: courageous, valiant, heroic

(1) brave soldier, (2) brave decision

The **brave** firefighter rescued the family from the burning building.

define

 to state or explain precisely the nature, scope, or meaning of something

synonym: characterize, depict, express

(1) **define** a word, (2) **define** my position

To advance this discussion, we must **define** "success" rigorously.

rural

adj. of or relating to the countryside synonym: agrarian, country, rustic

(1) rural accents, (2) people in rural areas

Many **rural** areas are still impoverished.

influence

n. the ability to affect someone's or something's character, growth, or behavior, or the effect itself

synonym: power, leverage, effect

(1) **influence** a child's future, (2) **influence** the daily life The former emperor had a particular **influence** even after he abdicated.

curiosity

- n. a strong desire to know or learn about somethingsynonym: interest, inquisitiveness, novelty
- (1) boundless **curiosity**, (2) satisfy my intellectual **curiosity** We are motivated by **curiosity** rather than necessity.

segregate

v. to separate or set apart from others, often based on race, gender, or some other characteristic

synonym: isolate, separate, divide

glimpse

 a brief or partial view; the act of seeing something or someone for a very short time or only partly

synonym: glance, peek, sighting

reel

 a cylinder on which film, wire, or other flexible materials that can be wound

synonym: spool, bobbin, winder

grade

n. a particular level of quality, size, importance, etc.

synonym: score, rate, degree

heel

n. the rounded back part of the foot below the ankle; someone who is morally reprehensible; (verb) to follow someone or something

synonym: hindfoot

coordinated

adj. effectively arranged or organized so that all the parts work smoothly or systematically together

synonym: collective, unified, cooperative

(1) in a **coordinated** manner, (2) **coordinated** robot system For greater efficiency, our efforts must be better **coordinated**.

grateful

adj. feeling or showing an appreciation of kindness; thankful synonym: thankful, appreciative, indebted

mentor

- a person who helps and advises a younger or less experienced person over time, usually at work or school synonym: adviser, coach, tutor
- (1) mentor for life, (2) fashion mentorAs a mentor, he helped me realize my career.

scholarship

 a grant or payment made to support a student's education usually awarded based on academic or other achievements

synonym: grant, award, stipend

(1) a **scholarship** association, (2) college **scholarship** She received a full **scholarship** to study abroad.

movement

 a group of people working together to achieve a shared goal, especially a political, social, or artistic one; the process of moving or being moved, physically or figuratively

synonym: motion, progression, action

(1) a circular **movement**, (2) **movement** of troops

The **movement** of the dancers on stage was graceful and elegant.

enthusiasm

 a strong feeling of excitement and interest in a particular subject or cause and an eagerness to become involved in it

synonym: eagerness, zeal, willingness

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(1) unflagging **enthusiasm**, (2) lose **enthusiasm** We are tackling the development for updates with **enthusiasm**.

discovery

 the act or process of finding information, a place, or an object, or learning about something that was previously not known

synonym: finding, uncovering, detection

(1) a scientific **discovery**, (2) the great **discovery** of the century

Her research team made an important **discovery**.

newfound

adj. newly discovered or acquired synonym: afresh, new, recently discovered

(1) a **newfound** mine, (2) **newfound** freedom
With his **newfound** wealth, he could travel the world and indulge in his passions.

ferment

v. to experience a chemical change or action that results in the production of alcohol or effervescence of gases; (noun) a state of agitated activity or change, especially in the context of social or political movements

synonym: ripen, simmer, (noun) agitation

(1) **ferment** sugar into ethanol, (2) political **ferment**The dough was left to **ferment** overnight to give the bread its distinctive flavor.

feminism

n. the belief in and advocacy of equal rights, opportunities, and treatment for all genders, particularly women, and the recognition of the systematic and cultural oppression of women in society

synonym: women's rights, gender equality

(1) radical **feminism**, (2) liberal **feminism**

She is a strong advocate for **feminism** and works tirelessly for women's rights.

conflict

n. a strong disagreement, argument, or a violent clash between two opposing groups or individuals

synonym: clash, discord, competition

(1) the **conflict** between good and evil, (2) the longstanding **conflict**

He and I often had **conflicts**, not only in personality but also in ideology.

embedded

adj. fixed firmly into the surface of something synonym: ingrained, implanted, inserted

protest

a strong expression of disagreement, disapproval, or opposition

synonym: objection, disapproval, challenge

(1) hold a protest, (2) a silent protest

He left the party in **protest** at its radical political stance.

march

v. to walk militarily with stiff, regular steps

synonym: parade

(1) march against the war, (2) march east

The troops marched shoulder-to-shoulder.

colleague

 one of a group of a coworker, especially in a profession or a business

synonym: coworker, associate, fellow

collaborate with colleagues,
 former colleague
 decided to seek counseling on the advice of my colleague.

mount

 to increase, go up, or advance gradually or continuously; to prepare and supply with the necessary equipment for execution or performance; to ride on something or someone

synonym: climb, increase, get on

(1) mount a hill, (2) mount a counterattack

They **mounted** pictures on the paper in preparation for the birthday card.

excuse

 a reason or explanation, either true or invented, given to justify a fault or defend your behavior; (verb) to make someone free from blame or clear from guilt synonym: apology, justification, reason

(1) excuse for inaction, (2) perfect excuse

He quickly fabricated an **excuse** for not attending the meeting.

compromise

to settle a problem or disagreement by mutual concession

synonym: agree, settle, negotiate

(1) **compromise** the matter, (2) cannot **compromise** anymore

They never **compromised** on development despite the lack of funds.

warn

v. to make someone aware of potential danger or difficulty, particularly one that may occur in the future

synonym: alert, caution, admonish

(1) warn a reckless driver, (2) warned me of the plan I attempted to warn him, but he ignored me.

opportune

adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purpose

synonym: suitable, timely, practical

(1) **opportune** occasion, (2) an **opportune** remark The phone rang at the most **opportune** time.

breakthrough

 a sudden, dramatic, and important discovery or development that helps to improve a situation or provide an answer to a problem

synonym: advance, progress, innovation

(1) **breakthrough** in the negotiations, (2) **breakthrough** discovery

A technique called deep learning has led to **breakthroughs** in AI.

harassment

n. the act of repeatedly annoying, tormenting, or persecuting someone in a way that is threatening or unwelcome, often relating to issues of race, gender, or other identities

synonym: bullying, persecution, intimidation

(1) sexual **harassment**, (2) emotional **harassment**The company has a zero-tolerance policy for **harassment** in the workplace.

consultant

- n. a person who provides professional or expert advicesynonym: expert, advisor, specialist
- (1) **consultant** firm, (2) chief **consultant**We hired a management **consultant** to help us improve our business strategy.

hire

- v. to give somebody a jobsynonym: employ, engage, lease
- (1) **hire** a guide, (2) **hire** a car by the hour We should always be prepared to **hire** talented recruits.

blond

 adj. of a light, yellowish-brown or golden color, typically describing hair color; (also spelled "blonde") a female with such hair color

synonym: blonde, light-haired

(1) blond fuzz, (2) ash- blond ringlet

She is a natural **blond** and doesn't need to dye her hair.

neckline

- n. the shape or style of the opening at the top of a garment that surrounds the neck, such as a shirt or dresssynonym: collarbone, neckband
- (1) low **neckline**, (2) strapless **neckline**The elegant dress featured a plunging **neckline** that accentuated the wearer's collarbone.

ugly

adj. unattractive in appearance; unpleasant to look at synonym: unattractive, unsightly, repulsive

anchor

n. a device, typically made of metal, that is used to moor a ship or boat in a particular place, typically by being dropped to the seabed; a central cohesive source of support and stability

synonym: mainstay, ballast, backbone

(1) anchor bolt, (2) anchor weight

The ship dropped **anchor** in the bay.

suit

 a set of clothes that are made from the same material; a claim or complaint that a person or organization can file in court against another party; (verb) to be fit or acceptable for

synonym: clothes, lawsuit, (verb) fit

(1) suit and tie restaurant, (2) suit at law

Six suits are awaiting trial or verdict.

scarf

 a piece of cloth worn around the neck or head for warmth, cleanliness, fashion, or religious reasons

synonym: shawl, wrap, kerchief

(1) knit a scarf, (2) dotted scarf

She wrapped a **scarf** around her neck to keep warm.

judge

 a person who makes decisions in a court of law; (verb) to determine the result of or form a critical opinion of something

synonym: arbiter, justice, (verb) deduce

(1) judge a competition, (2) an associate judge

The strict **judge** ruled in favor of the plaintiff in the case.

gender

n. the range of characteristics of femininity and masculinity and differentiating between them, especially when considering social and cultural differences rather than differences in biology

synonym: sexuality

(1) **gender-blind** policies, (2) dual **gender**

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Cultural norms strongly influence **gender** expectations.

lens

n. a transparent optical device with curved sides, used in an optical instrument that makes objects seem larger, smaller, clearer, etc.; (metaphor) the basic thoughts or mindsets through which someone sees or understands the environment or situation

synonym: glass

(1) a convex **lens**, (2) a **lens** with a wide angle The photographer took this photo using a telephoto **lens**.

struggle

v. to make a great effort to do something when it is difficult, or there are a lot of problems; to use force or violence to break away from restraint or constriction

synonym: toil, strive, compete

(1) **struggle** against discrimination, (2) **struggle** to get the job

He could not **struggle** against temptation.

balance

 a condition in which everything has the same weight or force; something left after other parts have been taken away

synonym: equilibrium, counterpoise, remainder

(1) the **balance** of power, (2) asset on the company's **balance** sheet

Try to keep a balance between work and off.

entirely

adv. completely

synonym: completely, fully, totally

(1) **entirely** satisfied with the meal, (2) he was **entirely** to blame

Later, his claim was found to be **entirely** false.

advocate

 a person who supports or suggests an idea, development, or way of doing something

synonym: proponent, exponent, promoter

(1) an advocate of disarmament, (2) public education

advocates

Advocates of abolishing the death penalty often argue that the alternative heaviest sentence should be life in prison.

feminist

adj. describing a belief in and advocacy for achieving gender equality in social, political, and economic spheres; advocating for the rights and empowerment of women; (noun) a person who believes in and advocates for gender equality between men and women

synonym: egalitarian

(1) **feminist** movement, (2) **feminist** perspective The **feminist** ideals of inclusivity and diversity are important in creating a more just and equal world.

acknowledge

v. to accept or admit the existence, reality, or truth of something; to accept that someone or something has a particular authority or quality; to express obligation, thanks, or gratitude for someone's help, commitment, etc.;

synonym: accept, agree, declare

(1) **acknowledge** the deed, (2) **acknowledge** his help He never **acknowledged** his fault.

privilege

 a special right or advantage that only one person or group of people has, usually because they are rich and powerful in a society

synonym: benefit, authorization, advantage

(1) a breach of **privilege**, (2) **privilege** of membership In the Middle Ages, the right to hunt in the wild was the **privilege** of royalty and nobility.

empower

- v. to give someone the power or authority to do something synonym: authorize, endow, entitle
- (1) **empower** my life, (2) **empower** the secretary to do the same

The company **empowered** employees to buy low-price items without approval to achieve efficient purchasing.

claim

to assert that something is true; to demand or request something as one's own; to lay legal or moral right to something; (noun) a demand or assertion of a right or something that one believes to be true

synonym: assert, declare, maintain

(1) claim responsibility, (2) false claim

He wants to **claim** ownership of the abandoned property.

brilliant

adj. extremely clever, skilled, or impressive synonym: luminous, intelligent, clever

(1) **brilliant** idea, (2) **brilliant** performance

The more **brilliant** you are, the more people around you look at you with envy and jealousy.

congressperson

a person who belongs to a congress, especially a member of the US House of Representatives; congressman (congressperson is used to avoid gender discrimination)

synonym: lawmaker, politician, representative

(1) hawkish congressperson, (2) former congressperson The term of a **congressperson** is two years.

journalist

a person who collects and writes news stories or articles n. for newspapers, magazines, radio, television, or other online media

synonym: reporter, newsperson, press

- (1) a China-based journalist, (2) journalist on a magazine Foreign TV crews and journalists can go as they please in various locations during the Olympics.
- to challenge or dare someone to do something; to resist or disobey a rule, decision, etc.

synonym: challenge, resist, disobey

(1) **defy** gravity, (2) **defy** authority

She tried to **defy** her parents by moving to the city against their wishes.

defy

wage

- n. a particular amount of money that somebody earns, usually every week or every month, for work or services
 synonym: payment, compensation, salary
- (1) unpaid **wages**, (2) increase in the minimum **wage** His **wages** continued to rise as his skills improved.

healing

 the process of becoming or making somebody or something well again

synonym: recovery, recuperation, convalescence

(1) natural **healing** ability, (2) part of the **healing** process Each ancient tribe has its **healing** traditions.

transform

v. to change in outward structure or looks;

synonym: alter, convert, change

(1) **transform** an education system, (2) **transform** heat into power

My father's death transformed my life completely.

survivor

n. a person who remains alive after an event in which others have died

synonym: subsister

(1) ovarian cancer **survivor**, (2) a single **survivor**The shipwreck **survivor** was rescued after floating in the ocean for three days.

assault

 a violent physical attack; the crime of forcing someone to submit to sexual intercourse against their will

synonym: assault, attack, raid

(1) **assault** aircraft, (2) victim of sexual **assault** We got caught up in an **assault** case.

summit

 the highest point of a mountain or hill; a meeting of heads of state or government to discuss important issues

synonym: peak, top, crest

(1) reach the **summit**, (2) **summit** talks

The climbers reached the mountain's **summit** after a long and challenging journey.

observe

v. to watch or notice something carefully, often to gather information or insights; to take note of something or someone; to celebrate or commemorate a special event or occasion

synonym: watch, monitor, scrutinize

(1) **observe** a tradition, (2) **observe** wildlife

It is important to **observe** safety procedures in the workplace to prevent accidents.

spotlight

a beam of light used to illuminate a particular area or person

synonym: limelight, stage light, highlight

(1) spotlight effect, (2) spotlight moment

The singer was in the **spotlight** as she performed her hit song.

negotiation

 the process of discussing and reaching an agreement with others

synonym: bargaining, dialogue, haggling

(1) negotiation process, (2) negotiation skills

The **negotiation** between the two countries was a delicate and complex process.

dismantle

v. to take apart or demolish (a structure, machine, system, or the like); to strip off fittings or equipment

synonym: take apart, demolish, take down

(1) **dismantle** a machine, (2) **dismantle** a system

The old building had to be **dismantled** because it was structurally unsound.

barrier

 a fence or other obstruction that makes it hard to move or get in; any condition that makes it difficult to make progress or to achieve an objective

synonym: border, barricade, fence

(1) cost barrier, (2) information barrier

The police placed a **barrier** across the street to halt traffic.

agitate

 to disturb or upset someone's emotions, peace, or tranquility; to stir or shake something up, often to mix or dissolve it

synonym: disturb, unsettle, ruffle

(1) agitate a mixture, (2) agitate for independence

The loud noise from the construction site next door continued to **agitate** the residents of the apartment building.

representation

 the act of speaking, acting, or being present on behalf of someone officially; a statement of facts and reasons made in appealing or protesting

synonym: delegacy, manifestation, expression

(1) sales representation, (2) binary representation

A person who has been declared incompetent should have legal **representation**.

promote

 to encourage or persuade people to like, buy, use, do, or support something; to raise someone to a higher position or rank

synonym: boost, raise, advertise

(1) **promote** a better relationship, (2) **promote** bad behavior The government should do more to **promote** sustainable agribusiness.

affirmative

adj. indicating agreement, support, or confirmation; positive or assertive in tone

synonym: positive, confirming, approving

(1) **affirmative** decision, (2) **affirmative** action

The teacher gave an **affirmative** nod to let the student know they had answered the question correctly.

president

 the leader of a republic, for example, the US; the person in charge of the organization such as a company, university, club, etc. synonym: leader, CEO, chairperson

(1) **president** emeritus, (2) vice- **president** for finance The club **president** does not have absolute power.

announce

v. to make something known or officially inform people about something
