one of the earth's large landmasses; (adjective)
 abstaining from your feelings, especially your desire to have sex

courage

 the ability to face danger, difficulty, uncertainty, or pain without being overcome by fear or despair; the quality of being brave or courageous

synonym: bravery, valor, fearlessness

(1) mental **courage**, (2) inspire **courage**It takes a lot of **courage** to stand up for what you believe is right.

involve

v. to include or affect someone or something as a necessary part of something else

synonym: implicate, include, engage

(1) **involve** a lot of paperwork, (2) **involve** a high degree of risk

The investigation **involves** several government agencies and is expected to take several months.

balance

 a condition in which everything has the same weight or force; something left after other parts have been taken away

synonym: equilibrium, counterpoise, remainder

(1) the **balance** of power, (2) asset on the company's **balance** sheet

Try to keep a **balance** between work and off.

bravery

- courage in the face of danger n. synonym: courage, valor, heroism
- (1) bravery against the enemy, (2) bravery under fire His **bravery** in the face of danger saved the lives of his comrades.

magic

beliefs and actions employed to influence supernatural beings and forces; any art or performance that invokes supernatural powers

synonym: fascination, illusion, wizardry

(1) a magic spell, (2) she is magic

He performed **magic** tricks with sophisticated moves.

fancy

to want to do or have something; (noun) something that ν. many people believe but that is false, or that does not exist; imagination or fantasy

synonym: imagine, visualize, (noun) fantasy

wheelchair

- a chair fitted with large wheels for use as a means of transport by a person who is unable to walk
- (1) electric-powered wheelchair, (2) wheelchair accessibility

This library rents out various types of folding wheelchairs for visitors.

inexplicable

adj. unable to be explained, understood, or accounted for; mysterious or puzzling

synonym: incomprehensible, mysterious, unaccountable

inexplicable.

diagnose

to determine or distinguish the nature of a problem or an illness through a careful analysis

synonym: identify, analyze, interpret

recessive

adj. of or relating to the state of the economy declines; (of a gene) controlling a characteristic that is expressed only when a dominant allele is not present

synonym: latent, dormant, hidden

The **recessive** gene for blue eyes is only expressed when both parents carry the gene.

genetic

adj. of or relating to genes (= parts of the DNA in cells) or the science of genes

synonym: hereditary, genetical, inborn

hereditary

adj. passed down from one generation to another through inheritance

synonym: inherited, transmitted, genetic

inclusive

adj. including much or everything, and especially including stated limits; not excluding any of the people, things, ideas, etc. involved in something

as part of its inclusive policy.

myopathy

 a disease or disorder that affects the muscles, typically causing weakness, pain, or degeneration of muscle tissue

progressive

adj. relating to or supporting development or advancement, especially social or political one

disease

 a disorder or illness that affects the body or mind, often characterized by specific symptoms or abnormal functioning of organs or systems

synonym: illness, ailment, affliction

The doctor diagnosed him with a rare **disease** that had no known cure.

statistics

- n. the discipline that concerns the collection, organization, analysis, interpretation, and presentation of data

onset

n. the beginning or early stages of unpleasant something; a military attack

synonym: beginning, attack, commencement

typical

adj. having the usual characteristics or traits of a specific group of things

synonym: characteristic, usual, distinctive

quadriplegia

- *n.* paralysis of all four limbs and the torso, usually resulting from injury to the spinal cord in the neck region

frightening

chronic

adj. being long-lasting and recurrent or characterized by long suffering; habitual

disability

- a physical or mental condition that makes it difficult for someone to do some things that other people do
- synonym: impairment, disadvantage, restriction
- (1) a **disability** pension, (2) a learning **disability**Listening to music at a high volume may lead to a hearing **disability**.

progression

 the act or process of changing to the next stage or phase or moving forward

synonym: advancement, development, evolution

dishearten

- v. to cause someone to lose hope, confidence, or enthusiasm; to discourage or demoralizesynonym: discourage, dismay, demoralize

ambition

ignore

- v. to intentionally not listen or pay attention to synonym: neglect, disregard, shun
- (1) **ignore** her advice, (2) **ignore** a ban Since independence, the area has been completely **ignored**.

decide

- v. to make up someone's mind about something; to come to a conclusion or judgment after considering options synonym: choose, determine, settle
- (1) **decide** a question, (2) **decide** on a course of action She couldn't **decide** whether to order the pizza or the pasta for dinner.

nation

 a large organized community of people living in a particular country or region and having a particular culture

synonym: country, state, sovereign entity

(1) **nation-state**, (2) a seafaring **nation**The **nation** of Japan is known for its unique culture and advanced technology.

recover

- v. to return to a former condition, health, mind, or strength synonym: come back, convalesce, heal
- (1) **recover** a loss, (2) **recover** approval ratings She is still **recovering** from a shot to her shoulder.

brutal

adj. harsh or cruel

synonym: harsh, cruel, barbarous

(1) brutal bully, (2) brutal honesty

The brutal attack left the victim with serious injuries.

declare

v. to say, state, or announce something clearly, officially, or publicly

synonym: announce, state, affirm

(1) **declare** independence, (2) **declare** my love Foreign goods from abroad must be **declared** to customs when entering a country.

employer

 a person or organization that pays workers to work for them

synonym: boss, owner, company

(1) illegal **employer**, (2) **employer** responsibility
An **employer's** attitude toward its employees significantly impacts their productivity.

polio

 an acute infectious disease caused by a virus that attacks nerve cells in the spinal cord and brain, leading to paralysis, muscle weakness, and potentially lifelong disability

synonym: poliomyelitis, infantile paralysis

(1) polio epidemic, (2) polio eradication

The **polio** vaccine development is regarded as one of the greatest medical achievements of the 20th century.

overhear

 to hear what other people are saying without intending to and their knowledge

synonym: catch, eavesdrop

(1) happen to **overhear** a conversation, (2) accidentally **overheard** their talk

She was inside at the time and **overheard** the conversation.

survive

- v. to live or exist despite a dangerous event or period synonym: endure, persist, stay
- (1) **survive** a blizzard, (2) **survive** a plane crash These birds can only **survive** in temperate climates.

limp

- adj. having no strength or energy; walking with difficulty because of pain, injury, or disability in one's leg or foot synonym: unsteady, weak, faltering
- (1) **limp** handshake, (2) **limp** hair

The steak was so undercooked that it was almost raw and had a **limp** texture.

intern

 to put someone in prison, especially for political or military reasons; (noun) a student or trainee who works, sometimes for free, to get work experience or to fulfill qualification criteria

synonym: apprentice, trainee, student

(1) intern civilians, (2) medical intern

The navy **interned** ships of defeated nations.

severity

- n. the quality or condition of being severe, strict, or harshsynonym: harshness, rigidity, austerity

function

n. the purpose or use of an object, system, or process; a particular activity or operation that is designed to serve a specific purpose; a mathematical concept that describes a relationship between two sets of values, called the input and output sets; (verb) to operate or work in a specific way, or to perform a particular task or purpose

synonym: purpose, mapping, job

(1) function properly, (2) immune function

increasingly

adv. more and more

synonym: more and more, progressively

pursue

synonym: seek, hunt, chase

appoint

focal

adj. relating to an important or central point or area; sharp or precise in focus or detail

synonym: central, main, primary

devastating

adj. causing a great deal of destruction or damagesynonym: destructive, annihilative, disastrous

earthquake

- a sudden and violent shaking of the ground caused by the movement of rock beneath the earth's surface
- synonym: seismic activity, tremor, temblor
- (1) an **earthquake** zone, (2) an **earthquake-proof**The violent **earthquake** caused widespread damage and injuries throughout the region.

brace

 a device, typically one of a pair, for holding something in position or for strengthening an object; (verb) to support or hold steady and make steadfast

synonym: support, clamp, (verb) strengthen

(1) **brace** for impact, (2) **brace** my energies

She wore a **brace** on her leg to support her injured ankle.

adventure

 a journey or a series of events that is unusual, exciting, or dangerous

synonym: experience, happening, incident

grand	adj. important and large in size, scope, or extent synonym: impressive, great, ambitious

 a thing that blocks one's way or prevents or hinders progress

synonym: hindrance, barrier, block

(1) an **obstacle** to progress, (2) **obstacle** avoidance The **obstacle** course was challenging but fun.

necessarily

adv. in an essential manner; in such a way as could not be otherwise

synonym: inevitable, certainly, automatically

not necessarily a problem, (2) necessarily true
 This accident was something that happened necessarily.

immediately

adv. now or without delay

synonym: directly, instantly, promptly

(1) **immediately** recall a product, (2) write him an answer **immediately**

A suspension order from the court is effective **immediately**.

assume

v. to think or accept something to be true without having proof of it; to take or begin to have power; to begin to exhibit a specific quality or appearance

synonym: guess, presume, suppose

(1) **assume** a lousy attitude to his boss, (2) **assume** an

important role

The following example **assumes** that the capacity of each battery is the same.

decision

 the act or process of making up someone's mind about something; a choice or judgment reached after considering options

synonym: choice, determination, judgment

(1) decision authority, (2) a selfish decision

She was struggling to make a **decision** between two job offers.

commitment

 a promise or firm decision to do something or to behave in a certain way

synonym: burden, obligation, promise

(1) a **commitment** to an alliance, (2) meet his **commitments**

His business **commitments** took him to the United States.

toss

- v. to throw something carelessly with a light motion synonym: throw, sway
- (1) **toss** a coin, (2) **toss** the bottle into a trash can It would be best if you **tossed** out all those old magazines.

undertake

v. to do or begin to do something, such as an enterprise or responsibility

synonym: assume, take on, embark

(1) **undertake** an enterprise, (2) **undertake** routine duties Young people in this country should **undertake** military duties.

expedition

- n. a journey or voyage for a specific purposesynonym: journey, trip, voyage
- (1) **expedition** team, (2) a polar **expedition**The **expedition** to the Amazon jungle was both exciting and challenging.

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horseback

- the back of a horse; the act of riding on a horse synonym: equestrian, horse riding, mounted
- (1) horseback trek, (2) horseback adventure We went on a scenic trail ride on horseback through the mountains.

raft

- a flat structure, usually made of logs or planks, that can be used for transport or as a platform for swimmer synonym: flatboat, boat, barge
- (1) a **raft** for carrying horses, (2) a life **raft** The rubber **raft** was swept out to sea.

crew

a group of people who work together, especially on a ship or airplane

synonym: team, group, squad

(1) the film **crew**, (2) the **crew** of a fishing boat The ship's **crew** worked hard to repair the damaged sails before the next storm hit.

tow

to pull or haul something along by means of a rope, chain, or other devices, typically using a vehicle as the source of power

synonym: haul, drag, pull

(1) tow a disabled vehicle, (2) tow a boat I had to **tow** my car to the mechanic after it broke down.

spoil

to ruin the taste, appearance, or quality of something; to become or cause something to become rotten or bad

synonym: rot, decay, deteriorate

(1) **spoil** a person's sport, (2) **spoil** the surprise If you leave the milk out of the refrigerator for too long, it will spoil.

alert

to warn or arouse to a sense of danger; (adjective) paying close attention or being in a state of readiness for action

synonym: warn, inform, (adjective) vigilant

(1) **alert** consumers to the dangers, (2) **alert** system The company's cybersecurity team **alerted** the CEO to potential threats.

manifest

v. to show something such as feeling, attitude, quality, etc. clearly through signs or actions

synonym: exhibit, make plain, demonstrate

manifest as the word, (2) manifest displeasure
 The Prime Minister manifested his regret for his neighbors

mustang

- a small, hardy breed of horse found in the American
 West that typically has a stocky build, short mane, and a wild or untamed temperament
- (1) a group of **mustangs**, (2) saddle up his trusty **mustang** The wild **mustang** galloped across the open plains, its mane flowing in the wind.

sheriff

- n. (in the US) a government official who is responsible for keeping law and order within a particular county or town synonym: officer, enforcer
- sheriff court, (2) deputy sheriff
 The sheriff kept establishing order in the town.

impressive

adj. arousing admiration due to size, quality, or skill *synonym*: impactful, remarkable, exceptional

(1) **impressive** performances, (2) an **impressive** array of facts

The budget reduction was an **impressive** feat for our nation.

shock

 a strong feeling or physical reaction to a sudden and unexpected event or experience, especially something unpleasant

synonym: amazement, surprise, stunner

(1) death from shock, (2) shock-resistantHe got an electric shock at work.

ounce

n. a unit of weight equal to approximately 28 grams

(1) **ounce** weight, (2) have an **ounce** of confidence One **ounce** of gold is worth much money.

embark

ν. to go on board a ship or plane; to set out on an enterprise or subject of study; to start something

synonym: enter, undertake, commence

(1) **embark** on a trip, (2) **embark** on a foolish adventure We **embarked** on a new project.

compose

v. to write music, poetry, or formal writing; to constitute or make up a whole, or a specified part of it

synonym: compile, constitute, build

(1) **compose** an essay, (2) **compose** my thoughts

The structure is **composed** of three main components.

disaster

n. an unexpected event or series of events that cause widespread damage, destruction, or loss of life
 synonym: catastrophe, calamity, tragedy

(1) global **disaster**, (2) **disaster** recovery

The **disaster** response team worked around the clock to aid those affected by the earthquake.

strike

- v. to wallop somebody or something with the hand, fist, or weapon; to have an emotional or cognitive impact uponsynonym: hit, impact, influence
- strike up a conversation, (2) strike a blow
 we strike to achieve more wages and safer working conditions.

upright

adj. perpendicular to a horizontal surface or line; (adverb) in a vertical position

synonym: vertical, perpendicular, plumb

(1) **upright** posture, (2) sit **upright** in a chair The bookcase was **upright** against the wall.

saddle

- n. a seat for a rider on the back of a horse or other animal; (verb) to burden someone with responsibility or tasksynonym: seat, perch, mount
- (1) bestride a **saddle**, (2) **saddle** his company with so much debt

He put the **saddle** on the horse before going for a ride.

oversize

adj. larger than the normal or standard size synonym: large, big, excessive

(1) oversize tire, (2) oversize bag

The **oversize** jacket was too big for her, but she still wore it because she liked the style.

fling

- v. to throw or push something or someone with force or recklessness, especially because you are angry
- synonym: throw, dump, hurl
- (1) **fling** a stream of abuse, (2) **fling** a door open forcefully He was provoked to **fling** the draft on the floor.

smack

- v. to hit something or someone with force, often making a loud noise; to deliver a sharp criticism or rebukesynonym: hit, slap, strike
- (1) **smack** on the lips, (2) **smack** his knee The baseball player **smacked** the ball out of the park, securing a home run.

panic

 a sudden strong feeling of fear that cannot be controlled and prevents reasonable thought and action

synonym: confusion, hysteria, consternation

(1) a panic reaction, (2) panic buying

The participation of oil-producing countries in the war caused **panic** in the financial markets.

fierce

adj. severe and violent in a way that is frightening synonym: ferocious, convulsive, forceful

(1) fierce competition, (2) a fierce animal

The **fierce** thunders echoed across the plain.

dismount

v. to get off or down from a horse, bicycle, or other transportation devices; to physically descend from a height or perch

synonym: get off, alight, disembark

(1) **dismount** a ladder, (2) **dismount** the bike

She stumbled as she tried to **dismount** from her horse.

halfway

adj. in or at a point midway or an equal distance between two points

synonym: middle, median, center

(1) **halfway** through my journey, (2) **halfway** decent job The famous restaurant stands **halfway** up the hill.

helmet

a protective covering for the head, worn for safety or as part of a uniform or ceremonial dress

synonym: headgear, head protector, safety hat

(1) helmet size, (2) safety helmet

The worker survived the impact because they were wearing sturdy **helmets**.

bump

v. to hit or knock against something hard, often with a dull sound; to meet with by accident

synonym: collide, hit, jolt

(1) **bump** against a wall, (2) **bump** up prices

She accidentally **bumped** into him in the crowded room.

protruding

adj. sticking out or projecting from a surface; extending beyond a boundary or limit

synonym: jutting, sticking out, protrusion

(1) **protruding** object, (2) **protruding** tongue

The construction worker wore a hard hat to protect his head from **protruding** beams or wires.

forehead

n. the part of the face above the eyebrows and below the hairline; the upper part of the face that extends from the

eyes to the hairline

synonym: brow, frontal bone, temple

(1) forehead wrinkles, (2) kiss on the forehead

The athlete had sweat dripping down her **forehead** after the

intense workout.

gear

a toothed wheel that engages another toothed mechanism to change the speed or direction of transmitted motion; a set of tools, equipment, or other items for a particular purpose

synonym: equipment, tools, apparatus

(1) sports **gear**, (2) a **gear** change lever

She checked her **gear** before embarking on the hike.

swelling

an abnormal local enlargement of a part of your body, mainly because of illness or injury

synonym: bulge, bump, inflammation

(1) **swelling** of the ankle, (2) hard **swelling** on the body After intensive icing by the trainer, the **swelling** went down.

outward

adj. relating to the external appearance or surface of something; visible

synonym: external, surface, exterior

(1) an outward journey, (2) outward cheerfulness The **outward** appearance of the building was impressive, but the inside was in dire need of repairs.

drain

- to empty or dry something by removing the liquid from it synonym: draw off, bleed
- (1) **drain** water from the swamp, (2) **drain** excess liquid Push the button and let the water **drain** away.

fantastic

adj. extremely good; excellent

synonym: incredible, unbelievable, marvelous

(1) a fantastic dress, (2) absolutely fantastic event The new amusement park ride was **fantastic**, with twists, turns, and drops that left riders screaming with excitement.

amazing

adj. extremely surprising, especially in a way that you like or admire

synonym: exceptional, extraordinary, wonderful

(1) **amazing** advances, (2) the most **amazing** feeling The golfer recorded an **amazing** distance.

documentary

 a film or a radio or television program that gives facts and information about a subject; of or derived from official documents
