### mathematics

### calculator

### supercomputer

#### universe

#### instantaneous

adj. occurring or happening immediately or without delay; taking place in an instant or moment

synonym: immediate, prompt, rapid

- an arrangement of objects or people side by side in a row line

#### fiction

- (1) stuff of science **fiction**, (2) non- **fiction** bestseller Truth is stranger than **fiction**.

#### crazy

- adj. stupid or not sensible; very angry synonym: insane, absurd, bizarre

#### harness

v. to control and exploit the power of something, especially natural resources that produce energy; (noun) a set of

#### weird

*adj.* extraordinary, unexpected, or difficult to explain *synonym*: bizarre, creepy, peculiar

### wacky

*adj.* funny in a slightly odd, peculiar, irregular way *synonym*: absurd, eccentric, ludicrous

### revolutionary

adj. relating to or characterized by a complete or dramatic change

synonym: radical, innovative, groundbreaking

(1) **revolutionary** change, (2) enforce **revolutionary** justice The **revolutionary** leader inspired others to join the fight for freedom and democracy.

#### useless

adj. not serving any useful purpose; having no practical result

synonym: ineffectual, unhelpful, worthless

### comparison

 the consideration or examination of the similarities between two or more people or things

*synonym*: equivalence, analogy, contrast

caloric basis

#### abacus

 a counting device consisting of a frame with rods or wires on which beads or stones are moved to perform arithmetic calculations

*synonym*: bead frame, counting frame

bead

### process

synonym: procedure, method, system

tackle

climate

pandemic

 an outbreak of a disease that affects many people over a very wide area

### intelligence

#### incredible

### misery
