### hexagon

The honeycomb structure of a beehive is made up of **hexagons**.

### dungeon

a room or cell in which prisoners are held, especially underground

synonym: prison, cell, lockup

(1) medieval dungeon, (2) a murky dungeon

The prisoner has been languishing for years in the castle dungeon.

#### reinvent

v. to change something so drastically that it looks to be completely new

synonym: recreate, remake, revive

(1) **reinvent** local dishes, (2) **reinvent** our life They have tried to **reinvent** their grocery stores.

#### enslave

v. to make someone a slave; to deprive someone of their freedom of choice or action

synonym: coerce, deprive, imprison

(1) **enslave** poor peasants, (2) **enslave** indigenous people Her beauty **enslaved** me completely.

#### recreate

v. to make something that existed previously happen or appear to exist again

synonym: renovate, vivify, revive

(1) **recreate** a single country, (2) **recreate** the feeling of the 1920s

She **recreated** the atmosphere of the pre-war age with her stage setting.

#### dastard

n. a dishonorable or despicable coward

synonym: coward, chicken, cad

(1) you **dastard**, (2) the **dastard's** way of thinking You cannot criticize him as an arrogant **dastard**.

### dangle

v. to hang or swing loosely, especially in a way that suggests instability or lack of support; to tempt or tantalize by holding out the prospect of something desirable but uncertain

synonym: swing, hang, drape

(1) dangle a carrot, (2) dangle a pendant

The earring on her earlobe would **dangle** as she moved her head.

#### divisible

adj. able to be divided into parts, usually with nothing left over

*synonym*: separable, splittable, partitionable

(1) a **divisible** number, (2) exactly **divisible** 

The class was divided into groups of four, with each group being **divisible** by two.

rev

 a measure of the rate at which an engine or motor rotates, often expressed in revolutions per minute (RPM); (verb) to increase the number of rotations per minute

synonym: revolution, RPM, speed

(1) low- rev engine, (2) rev up the crowd

He stepped on the gas pedal, and the engine released a loud **rev**.

### ingenuity

*n*. the quality of inventing things or solving problems in clever new ways

synonym: creativity, invention, originality

(1) the infinite **ingenuity** of man, (2) abound in **ingenuity** Creativity and **ingenuity** are often brought about by extreme concentration.
