skyscraper

surpass

masonry

n. the art or work of constructing buildings, walls, or other structures from carefully shaped and arranged blocks of stone, brick, or other materials

synonym: brickwork, stonework, bricklaying

(1) masonry wall, (2) masonry restoration

The cathedral's **masonry** sculptures were intricately carved and carefully placed.

countermeasure

- n. an action taken to counter or offset another actionsynonym: response, remedy, antidote
- (1) **countermeasure** strategy, (2) **countermeasure** plan The government implemented several **countermeasures** to combat the spread of the virus.

sway

synonym: swing, oscillate, influence

The politician tried to **sway** public opinion in his favor, but his arguments fell flat.

rethink

synonym: reexplore, review, reconsider

(1) **rethink** a marketing plan, (2) **rethink** the role of the manager

We have to **rethink** our company's product lineup for further growth.

exoskeleton

 a hard, external protective covering or framework that supports and gives shape to the body of an invertebrate animal, such as an insect or crab

synonym: chitin, exocuticle, carapace

(1) exoskeleton suit, (2) robotic exoskeleton

The **exoskeleton** of the crab protects it from predators and environmental changes.

resilient

adj. able to withstand or recover quickly from difficult conditions

synonym: robust, sturdy, tough

(1) a hard and **resilient** steel, (2) **resilient** population

She is a **resilient** person and has always bounced back from setbacks.

brace

 a device, typically one of a pair, for holding something in position or for strengthening an object; (verb) to support or hold steady and make steadfast

synonym: support, clamp, (verb) strengthen

(1) brace for impact, (2) brace my energies

She wore a **brace** on her leg to support her injured ankle.

industrious

adj. hardworking, diligent, and persistent in effort synonym: diligent, hardworking, assiduous

He was known to be very **industrious** and would often work late into the night.

protruding

adj. sticking out or projecting from a surface; extending beyond a boundary or limit

synonym: jutting, sticking out, protrusion

buttress

determinant

 a factor, circumstance, or condition that contributes to the shaping, influencing, or determining of a particular outcome or result

synonym: cause, factor, element

One **determinant** of success is having a positive attitude and a strong work ethic.

monumental

adj. great in importance or influence, size, extent, or solidity;
 massive

synonym: massive, awesome, enormous

(1) **monumental** task, (2) **monumental** sculpture Everyone, even non-scholars, knows Einstein's **monumental** contributions to physics.

calibrate

 to measure or adjust something, typically a machine or device, to ensure accurate functioning or to match a standard or desired level of performance

synonym: adjust, fine-tune

(1) **calibrate** machinery, (2) **calibrate** measurements It's important to **calibrate** the equipment regularly to ensure accurate results.

recede
