## cognitive

#### emotional

#### degree

 a unit of measurement for angles, temperature, or level of proficiency or achievement; a rank or level of academic or professional attainment

synonym: level, qualification, diploma

She received her **degree** in psychology from the university.

#### wildlife

- animals, birds, insects, etc. that grow independently of people and live in natural conditions
- (1) **wildlife** sanctuary, (2) bird and other **wildlife**The conservation area has an abundance of **wildlife**.

#### context

 the circumstances, facts, or conditions that surround a particular event, situation, or statement and that give it meaning

synonym: background, setting, environment

(1) historical context, (2) legal context

It's important to understand the **context** of a situation before making a decision.

#### reintroduce

 to bring back something that has been previously abolished or discontinued

synonym: bring back, restore, reestablish

(1) **reintroduce** species, (2) **reintroduce** capital punishment

The government is planning to **reintroduce** wolves to the national park to restore the balance of the ecosystem.

collar

 a band of material worn around the neck, typically forming part of a shirt or jacket

synonym: band, neckband

He put on his **collar** and tie before leaving for work.

livestock

farm animals and birds such as cows, sheep, and chickens

synonym: cattle, oxen, herd

haze

 atmospheric moisture, dust, or smoke that makes it less clear; a state of mental confusion caused by lack of clarity

synonym: fog, mist, brume

rub

v. to move one's hand or an object over the surface of something with pressure

synonym: scrub, massage, stroke

bullet

n. a metal projectile that is shot from a gun

synonym: projectile, slug, shot

horn

*synonym*: power, leverage, effect

#### conversion

n. the act or process of changing something from one thing to another; the state of being changed

## agriculture

 the practice or science of cultivating the land or raising stock

synonym: farming, husbandry, agribusiness

- n. the complete disappearance of a species from the earth synonym: disappearance, eradication, annihilation

#### domesticate

#### reroute

#### climate

 the weather in a particular location averaged over some long period

synonym: atmosphere, weather, environment

#### distant

#### polar

## struggle

hunt

## normally

adv. usually; under normal conditions

synonym: commonly, generally, naturally

#### millennium

- n. a span of 1000 years, or the 1000th anniversary (plural: millennia)

ethics

 a branch of philosophy that considers what is morally right and wrong conduct; a set of beliefs about what is morally right and wrong

synonym: morals, principles, moralities

(1) political ethics, (2) ethics of journalism

This scripture provides the code of **ethics** for the religion.

## obligation

 the state of being morally or legally bound to do or pay something synonym: burden, commitment, debt

#### supersede

v. to replace or be replaced by something else, particularly something newer, better, or more effective; to supplant or take over the place or function of another

#### flourish

#### well-fed

 adj. having a plentiful and nutritious diet; being sufficiently nourished, and not experiencing hunger or malnourishment

synonym: well-nourished, satisfied

The **well-fed** cat lay lazily in the sun.

#### nervous

adj. worried and anxious about something; relating to the nerves

synonym: neural, anxious, uneasy

#### impregnate

v. to make a woman or female animal pregnant; to infuse or fill something completely

synonym: fertilize, inseminate, make pregnant

## puppy

## regulate

v. to control something, especially by means of rules or laws

synonym: control, restrain, handle

(1) **regulate** blood sugar levels, (2) **regulate** our conduct We must manage to **regulate** our expenditure.

## nightmare

n. a very frightening or unpleasant dream

synonym: agony, misery, suffering

(1) have a **nightmare**, (2) **nightmare** situation Life as a waiter was a big **nightmare** for him.

#### pregnant

adj. having a baby or young animal developing in the uterus synonym: expectant

(1) needs of **pregnant** women, (2) a silence **pregnant** with suspense

She vacated the position when she got **pregnant**.

## purity

 the state of being undiluted or unmixed with anything else; the state of being free from immorality, especially of a sexual nature

synonym: sinlessness, innocence, cleanliness

(1) the degree of purity,(2) high purityHigher purity requires additional equipment and energy.

## genetic

adj. of or relating to genes (= parts of the DNA in cells) or the science of genes

synonym: hereditary, genetical, inborn

(1) have **genetic** testing, (2) a **genetic** disorder Understanding protein folding is a vital step in deciphering the **genetic** code.

#### deem

- v. to consider or decide something in a particular way synonym: believe, consider, suppose

## autonomy

 the right of an organization, country, or region to govern itself independently

## algorithm

- a set of rules or rigorous instructions typically used to solve a specific problem or to perform a computation synonym: logic, method, rule

#### decide

#### tricky

adj. requiring care and skill because challenging to do or deal with

- a system of money in general use in a particular country synonym: money, tender, cash
- (1) currency exchange, (2) digital currency The **currency** used in this country is the Euro.

## biodiversity

- the number and variety of plants and animals that exist n. in a particular area or the world and make a balanced environment
- (1) biodiversity conservation, (2) loss of biodiversity The country was instrumental in promoting the **biodiversity**

#### treaty.

#### welfare

 the general health, happiness, and prosperous of a person or group

synonym: well-being, benefit, health

(1) child welfare, (2) a welfare state

She struggled for years to survive without welfare.

#### well-being

- n. the state of being happy and healthy and prosperoussynonym: health, welfare, happiness

#### individual

#### threaten

v. to utter intentions of injury or punishment against someone

*synonym*: endanger, terrorize, intimidate

Various artificially induced causes are **threatening** our ecosystem.

#### introduction

n. a preliminary explanation or remarks given before the start of a text, performance, or event; the act of bringing something new into existence or introducing something to a wider audience or new market

synonym: initiation, preamble, prologue

(1) introduction education, (2) self- introduction

The **introduction** to the new class was informative and engaging.

#### predator

- n. an animal whose natural behavior is to prey on otherssynonym: vulture, bloodsucker
- (1) apex **predator**, (2) sexual **predators**

The native South American animals were in danger because of the **predator's** arrival.

#### stoat

- a small carnivorous mammal with a long, slender body and short legs, also known as an ermine or short-tailed weasel

The **stoat's** diet consists mostly of small rodents, such as mice and voles.

#### furry

adj. covered in fur or a furry material; resembling fursynonym: hairy, fuzzy, feathered

## endangered

## humility

the quality or condition of being humble; a low estimate of one's self

synonym: humbleness, modesty, unpretentiousness

(1) develop an attitude of **humility**, (2) lack of **humility** We were filled with **humility** at the sight of the Queen.

## responsible

adj. answerable or accountable for something within one's power, control, or management

synonym: accountable, answerable, liable

(1) **responsible** action, (2) **responsible** for a customer service

She's a **responsible** pet owner who ensures her dog gets enough exercise and a healthy diet.

## expand

v. to increase or to make something greater in size, number, or importance

*synonym*: extend, grow, boost

(1) **expand** a lineup, (2) **expand** agricultural output They hope to **expand** their business worldwide.

## specifically

adv. only associated with or meant for one thingsynonym: especially, particularly, notably

(1) designed specifically for men, (2) for specifically

#### American customers

This ad campaign is aimed **specifically** at young women.

#### suffer

v. to experience pain, distress, or hardship; to undergo or endure something painful or unpleasant

synonym: endure, undergo, tolerate

(1) suffer a setback, (2) suffer bad grades

The older man **suffers** from arthritis and finds it difficult to move around.

#### intuitive

*adj.* obtained through feelings rather than facts or proof *synonym*: involuntary, instinctive, innate

(1) intuitive eating, (2) intuitive judgment

I had an **intuitive** feeling that I might be pregnant.

#### parallel

 adj. being everywhere equidistant and not intersecting; of or relating to the simultaneous performance of multiple operations

synonym: aligned, side-by-side, similar

(1) a parallel case, (2) parallel processing

He walked a road **parallel** to the railroad.

#### discuss

v. to talk about or examine in detail through conversation or debate; to exchange ideas, opinions, or information on a particular topic

synonym: talk about, converse, debate

(1) discuss options, (2) discuss solutions

We need to **discuss** the next steps for the project during our meeting tomorrow.

## complicated

adj. involving a lot of different things or parts in a way that is difficult to understand or analyze

synonym: complex, convoluted, intricate

(1) a **complicated** process, (2) become increasingly **complicated** 

He did **complicated** pen-and-ink drawings in just a few days.

#### taxonomy

n. the classification or scientific study of organisms, including their relationships to each other, based on shared characteristics and traits; a system of organizing and categorizing information in a particular field or subject area

synonym: classification, categorization, hierarchy

(1) **taxonomy** system, (2) biological **taxonomy**The **taxonomy** of insects is incredibly complex due to the huge number of species.

## chimpanzee

a small, very intelligent ape found in west and central
 Africa with black or brown fur

synonym: ape, chimp, pan troglodytes

(1) **chimpanzee** behavior, (2) **chimpanzee** society Many zoos have **chimpanzee** exhibits, allowing visitors to observe these intelligent primates up close.

#### mammal

- any animal of which the female gives birth to live young, not eggs, and feeds her young on milk from her own body
- (1) a primitive **mammal**, (2) a sort of **mammal**Marine **mammal** populations are declining worldwide due to ocean pollution.

#### balance

 a condition in which everything has the same weight or force; something left after other parts have been taken away

synonym: equilibrium, counterpoise, remainder

(1) the **balance** of power, (2) asset on the company's **balance** sheet

Try to keep a **balance** between work and off.

#### intervention

 the action or process of being done to improve or help a circumstance, often they have not been asked to do so

synonym: interference, intercession, treatment

(1) **intervention** by foreign powers, (2) surgical **intervention** 

This **intervention** does not require the patient's consent.

#### op-ed

adj. denoting or relating to a piece of writing or article that expresses the author's opinion or point of view on a particular topic, usually published in a newspaper or magazine on the page opposite the editorial page

synonym: editorial, opinion, column

(1) **op-ed** section, (2) **op-ed** columnist

The **op-ed** piece offered a unique perspective on the political situation.

## sanctuary

 a place of refuge or safety, especially for victims of persecution or abuse

synonym: refuge, safety, haven

(1) an animal **sanctuary**, (2) violate a **sanctuary**The church offered **sanctuary** to refugees fleeing from war-torn countries.

## captivity

*n*. the situation in which a person or animal is kept in prison or a space that they cannot escape from

synonym: confinement, detention, imprisonment

(1) escape from **captivity**, (2) animals in **captivity** in the zoo

Pandas rarely breed in captivity.

rid

v. to make someone or something free of unwanted or unpleasant tasks, objects, or person

synonym: do away with, free, clear

(1) get **rid** of the rats, (2) **rid** the body of waste products We must **rid** ourselves of pollution.

pace

 the speed at which someone or something moves, or the rate at which something happens or changes

synonym: gait, rate, speed

at your own pace, (2) the runner's pace
 The economy is growing at a supercharged pace.

#### repetition

- n. the act of doing or saying something many timessynonym: duplication, iteration, recurrence
- (1) **repetition** of the word, (2) habitual **repetition Repetition** is the mother of all learning.

#### awkward

adj. making you feel uncomfortable or embarrassed; causing inconvenience or difficulty

synonym: embarrassing, discomfiting, clumsy

(1) an **awkward** expression, (2) an **awkward** date
The **awkward** design of the interface made the operation difficult.

#### breed

v. to keep animals for producing offspring in a regulated manner

*synonym*: raise, multiply, reproduce

## legitimate

adj. accordant with or allowed by law; lawful synonym: lawful, honest, fair

#### conservation

 n. the protection of something important, such as the natural environment or artificial structures, especially from the damaging effects of human activity

synonym: preservation, protection, saving

#### ethical

adj. of or relating to principles about what is right and wrong, or the branch of knowledge dealing with these

synonym: honorable, moral, virtuous

#### grandchild

n. a child of someone's son or daughtersynonym: offspring, descendant, progeny

## display

v. to exhibit or show something to others, often to attract attention or demonstrate its features, properties, or value

#### announcement

 a public statement or declaration, often made in writing or through the media, that conveys important information or news

#### gorilla

 a large, powerful, and intelligent primate found in the forests of central Africa, with coarse black or brown fur and a distinctive face

synonym: ape, chimpanzee, orangutan

(1) gorilla habitat, (2) endangered gorilla

The **gorilla** at the zoo impressed visitors with its size and strength.

## jungle

 an area of tropical forest where in which trees and plants grow very thickly

*synonym*: wilderness, forest

(1) middle of the **jungle**, (2) **jungle** exploration This village is still in a dense **jungle**.

#### propose

- v. to make a proposal, declare a plan for somethingsynonym: suggest, offer, recommend
- (1) **propose** the amendment, (2) **propose** changes I want to **propose** a toast in honor of our longstanding relationship.

#### amazing

adj. extremely surprising, especially in a way that you like or admire

synonym: exceptional, extraordinary, wonderful

(1) **amazing** advances, (2) the most **amazing** feeling The golfer recorded an **amazing** distance.

## virtually

adv. almost completely synonym: almost, basically, nearly

(1) **virtually** all countries, (2) **virtually** identical **Virtually** all the parties signed the contract.

#### interact

- v. to communicate or react with somebody synonym: cooperate, combine, collaborate
- (1) **interact** directly with customers, (2) **interact** with one another

He should interact more with his colleagues.

## documentary

 a film or a radio or television program that gives facts and information about a subject; of or derived from official documents

synonym: film, broadcast, doco

(1) a **documentary** film, (2) **documentary** proof He won an award for that short **documentary**.

## ecosystem

- all the plants and living creatures in an area and the way they affect each other and the environment
- (1) marine **ecosystem**, (2) change the **ecosystem**Human conservation efforts often fail unexpectedly because they disturb the balance of the **ecosystem**.

#### diversity

 n. the quality or fact of many different types of things or people being included in something; a range of different things or people

synonym: variety, multiplicity, variousness
