#### crisis

#### coronavirus

# unprecedented

#### collaboration

 the act or situation of working together to create or produce something

# discovery

 the act or process of finding information, a place, or an object, or learning about something that was previously not known

# catalyst

# smartphone

#### ancient

adj. relating to the long ago, particularly the historical period preceding the fall of the Western Roman Empire; very old

# augment

to increase the size, extent, quantity, etc. of something by adding something to it

# smartglass

a type of glass or transparent material that incorporates digital or electronic features, such as displays, sensors, or cameras, often used in the context of smart homes, wearable devices, or other IoT applications

synonym: smart windows, intelligent glass, dynamic glass

## desktop

#### wrist

 a specific sphere of influence or control; a specific field of knowledge or expertise

synonym: territory, realm, sphere

#### medical

adj. relating to the treatment of illness or injuries; relating to the practice of medicine

synonym: health, disease, treatment

#### converge

#### interface

# biology

- the scientific study of life and the natural processes of living things

#### robotic

- adj. of or relating to mechanical robots; (robotics) the interdisciplinary branch of computer science and engineering with the practical use of robots
- synonym: automated, mechanical, laborsaving

  The surgeon removed the tumor using **robotic** video assistance.

#### surgery

- medical treatment of injuries or diseases involving an incision with instruments and often removing or replacing some parts of the body; the branch of medical science that treats disease or injury by operative procedures

   had undergone heart surgery years before.

# digiceuticals

- n. digital health technologies or apps that are designed to improve health outcomes or prevent illness in a way that is similar to pharmaceutical drugs or other medical treatments
- synonym: digital therapeutics, app-based therapeutics, digital medicine

#### telemedicine

the remote diagnosis and treatment of patients using telecommunications technology, such as video conferencing, phone calls, or messaging services synonym: remote healthcare, online medicine, virtual care

# radiology

the branch of medicine that uses medical imaging technologies such as X-rays, CT scans, MRIs, and ultrasound to diagnose and treat diseases and injuries

#### industrious

# disrupt

to prevent or stop something, especially an event, activity, or process, from continuing in the usual way by causing a problem or disturbance

#### industrial

#### stick

# electrocardiogram

 a test that uses electrodes placed on the chest, arms, and legs to record the electrical signals of the heart and create a graph that shows the heart's rhythm and activity

synonym: ECG, heart monitor, cardiac monitor

The hospital invested in state-of-the-art **electrocardiogram** machines to improve patient care.

# pandemic

 an outbreak of a disease that affects many people over a very wide area

*synonym*: outbreak

(1) flu pandemic, (2) global pandemic

They fear a pandemic of a new type of virus.

# rely

v. to require a specific thing or the assistance and support of someone or something to continue, run properly, or succeed.

synonym: depend, count, lean

(1) **rely** on convenience stores, (2) **rely** entirely on him Babies heavily **rely** on others for food.

#### core

- n. the most essential or fundamental part of somethingsynonym: center, basis, heart
- (1) the **core** of an apple, (2) **core** business activity
  These gas nebulas are merely newborn galactic **cores**.

#### mask

v. to conceal something; (noun) a covering that you wear over your face to hide it

synonym: disguise, camouflage, conceal

#### distance

n. the amount of space between two points, measured in units such as miles, meters, or kilometers; the extent, scope, or range between two things, such as distance or emotional distance

#### advance

#### mindset

 the established set of attitudes or fixed ideas held by someone

#### intermittent

# episodic

#### obtain

#### clinic

 a building or hospital department where people can go for medical care or advice, especially of a particular condition

react

#### stroke

n. a medical condition in which poor blood flow to the brain causes cell death; the act of swinging or striking at a ball with a club, racket, etc.

## crowdsourcing

- the practice of obtaining needed services, ideas, or content by enlisting the services of a large number of people, either paid or unpaid, typically via the internet

# digital

- the complete set or sequence of genes of a human, n. animal, plant, or other living things

#### app
