#### sebaceous

#### structure

#### enzyme

- a substance produced by a living organism that acts as a catalyst to bring about a specific biochemical reaction

#### release

#### barrier

#### detect

v. to find or recognize something, especially something difficult to see, hear, etc.

### appetite

 a natural desire or craving for food or drink; a strong desire or liking for something

#### colonize

v. to establish a colony in or on a specific place; to settle or occupy in large numbers

#### extent

### susceptible

#### genetic

adj. of or relating to genes (= parts of the DNA in cells) or the science of genes

### predisposition

- a tendency or inclination to a particular behavior or condition, often due to genetic or environmental factors

#### permeable

- adj. capable of being penetrated, passed through, or absorbed; allowing liquids, gases, or other substances to pass through a surface or material, often with easesynonym: porous, absorbent, permeative

### investigate

#### communicate

#### immune

adj. protected against a particular disease or toxin due to the presence of specific antibodies or sensitized white blood cells

#### molecule

 a group of two or more atoms held together by attractive forces known as chemical bonds

synonym: particle, element, atom

### oxylipin

- a type of molecule derived from the oxidation of fatty acids, with a variety of functions in inflammation, immune response, and other physiological processes
   synonym: eicosanoid, oxigenated fatty acid, lipid mediator
- (1) **oxylipin** metabolism, (2) **oxylipin** signaling Fish oil is rich in **oxylipins** that have anti-inflammatory effects.

### regulate

 to control something, especially by means of rules or laws

synonym: control, restrain, handle

#### inhibit

to prevent something, such as an action, process, etc., from happening or make it less likely to happen than normal

synonym: deter, hinder, impede

(1) inhibit desires, (2) inhibit tumor growth Excessive parental interference may inhibit children's eagerness to learn.

#### inflame

to cause very strong feelings such as anger or excitement in a person or a group of people

synonym: agitate, arouse, enrage

(1) **inflame** skin, (2) **inflame** his passion Her eyes **inflamed** with crying.

#### boost

- to improve, raise, or increase something synonym: raise, advance, promote
- (1) **boost** the economy, (2) **boost** flexibility The new service helped **boost** net income by 10%.

#### develop

to grow or expand; to improve or refine through a ν. process of progress and refinement, often to achieve greater sophistication or complexity; to elaborate or add detail to something that is in the process of being created

synonym: evolve, progress, advance

### hypothesize

#### uncomfortable

adj. providing or feeling physical discomfort or slight pain synonym: comfortless, discomforting, painful

His abusive words made me uncomfortable.

#### embarrass

- v. to cause someone to feel awkward, worried, or ashamed synonym: disconcert, unsettle, agitate
- (1) **embarrass** political enemy, (2) **embarrass** my project He looked for an opportunity to **embarrass** that actor in public.

#### reliable

adj. worthy of being relied on; trustworthy synonym: dependable, trustworthy, dedicated

### contagious

adj. able to be passed on to others through contact or proximity, especially by infection or diseasesynonym: infectious, transmissible, communicable

#### threat

 a strong indication or likelihood of harm, danger, or adverse consequences; an expression of intent to inflict harm or injury on someone or something, often made as a means of coercion or intimidation

synonym: menace, danger, hazard

(1) economic **threat**, (2) environmental **threat**The **threat** of severe weather prompted the city to issue an evacuation warning.

#### excel

- v. to be extremely good at or proficient in doing something synonym: outdo, shine, surpass

#### defend

v. to protect someone or something from attack, criticism, danger, etc.

synonym: protect, guard, support

(1) **defend** my country, (2) **defend** against a threat International law allows each nation to **defend** itself when its rights and interests are illegally violated.

#### territory

- n. an area under the control of a ruler or statesynonym: domain, region, realm

### staphylococcus

 (also staph) a type of bacteria that can cause various types of infections in humans, including skin infections, pneumonia, and food poisoning

synonym: bacteria, microbe, germ

aureus

a type of bacteria, particularly the species
 Staphylococcus aureus, that can cause a range of infections in humans and animals, often resistant to antibiotics and can be difficult to treat; (adjective, "golden" or "of gold" in Latin) relating to something that is gold-colored or has properties similar to gold

synonym: (adjective) golden

#### mystery
