# musky

adj. having a strong, earthy smell that is often reminiscent of musk or moss

*synonym*: musty, earthy, pungent

(1) musky aroma, (2) musky perfume

The **musky** scent of the old book filled the air of the dusty library.

# predator

- n. an animal whose natural behavior is to prey on otherssynonym: vulture, bloodsucker
- (1) apex predator, (2) sexual predators

The native South American animals were in danger because of the **predator's** arrival.

# matriarch

 a woman who is the head of a family or social group; a woman who is the founder or dominant member of a group

synonym: leader, head, founder

(1) ruled by a **matriarch**, (2) **matriarch** figure

The **matriarch** of the family was known for her wisdom and guidance.

# devote

- v. to commit or dedicate oneself or one's time, effort, or energy to a particular task or purposesynonym: commit, dedicate, apply
- (1) **devote** all of my energies, (2) **devote** my own life He **devoted** himself to studying the history of ancient civilizations.

# olfactory

adj. relating to the sense of smell; connected with the perception of odors or scents

synonym: olfactive, scent-based, aromatic

(1) olfactory cortex, (2) olfactory memory

The **olfactory** senses play a key role in our taste and flavor perception.

# mammal

 any animal of which the female gives birth to live young, not eggs, and feeds her young on milk from her own body

(1) a primitive **mammal**, (2) a sort of **mammal**Marine **mammal** populations are declining worldwide due to ocean pollution.

#### vomeronasal

adj. relating to a specialized sense organ in certain animals, such as reptiles and mammals, that detects pheromones and other chemical signals related to social behaviors and reproductive activities

synonym: nasal, olfactory

(1) **vomeronasal** neuron, (2) **vomeronasal** response The **vomeronasal** organ is responsible for sensing pheromones in some animals, such as reptiles and mammals.

# lookout

 a person or group of people who are responsible for watching for danger or other potential threats and warning others of their presence

synonym: watchman, sentinel, guard

(1) **lookout** team, (2) on the **lookout** for danger

The **lookout** tower provided a clear view of the surrounding area.

tusk

 a long, pointed tooth, usually found in animals such as elephants, walruses, or wild boars, which protrudes from the mouth and is used as a weapon or for digging

synonym: ivory, tush, horn

(1) **tusk** of an elephant, (2) **tusk-like** tooth

The ivory poacher was arrested for possession of illegal **tusks**.

#### reckon

- v. to think or believe somethingsynonym: regard, imagine, suppose
- (1) hard to **reckon**, (2) **reckon** the company as a rival He **reckons** that corruption was rampant in the regime.

#### dexterous

adj. skilled or proficient in using the hands or body; nimble, clever, or deft

synonym: skillful, nimble, adept

(1) dexterous fingers, (2) dexterous movementsThe dexterous musician played the piano with ease and

precision.

# agile

adj. able to move quickly and easily, often in a way that is graceful and controlled

synonym: nimble, quick, flexible

(1) an **agile** mind, (2) **agile** in his movements

The **agile** development process allowed the team to make changes quickly.

# appendage

 a part attached to the main body or structure, often with a specific function or purpose; a limb or other body part that projects outward from the main body

synonym: extension, limb, attachment

(1) spiny appendage, (2) mechanical appendage

The spider's appendage allowed it to climb up the wall easily.

#### maneuver

 a motion or combination of moves that requires skill and care; a clever strategy, activity, or movement intended to give someone an advantage

synonym: gimmick, trick, action

(1) political **maneuvers**, (2) made a great **maneuver** In this class, we learn the basic **maneuver** of the plane.

# pesky

adj. causing annoyance, irritation, or trouble; persistent in a vexing or troublesome manner

*synonym*: annoying, irritating, bothersome

(1) dealing with **pesky**, (2) **pesky** problem

The **pesky** fly kept buzzing around my head.

#### bellows

 a device consisting of a bag or chamber with flexible sides that is expanded and contracted to draw in air through a valve and then force it out through a tube; a device used to blow air into a fire to make it burn more intensely

synonym: blower, puffer, blaster

(1) bellows pump, (2) blow a bellows

The blacksmith's apprentice operated the **bellows** to maintain the forge's heat.

# infrasonic

adj. relating to sound waves below the range of human hearing, typically below 20 Hz

synonym: inaudible, subsonic

(1) **infrasonic** sensor, (2) **infrasonic** electronic waves **Infrasonic** waves can be used for communication, such as in long-range submarines.

#### rumble

- v. to make a low, heavy continuous sound synonym: roar, growl, grumble
- (1) **rumble** an order, (2) **rumble** down the dirt track The thunder **rumbled** in the distance.

# uneasy

adj. causing or feeling anxiety or discomfortsynonym: anxious, troubled, nervous

(1) have **uneasy** eyes, (2) **uneasy** relationship He was **uneasy** about the situation and didn't know what to do.

# apprehension

n. the act of apprehending or arresting someone; a feeling of anxiety, worry, or uncertainty about something that may happen in the future; understanding or comprehension of something, particularly a complex or abstract concept or idea

synonym: anxiety, worry, unease

(1) criminal **apprehension**, (2) **apprehension** of danger The company's CEO felt a sense of **apprehension** before making the major decision.

# muck

*n*. dense, wet, and dirty matter or waste, often found in soil or on the ground; animal waste

synonym: dirt, mud, droppings

(1) construction muck, (2) muck on clothes

The horses waded through the **muck** in the field after the rainstorm.

#### snorkel

 a tube-like device used for breathing underwater, with one end in the mouth and the other above the surface of the water

synonym: tube, breather

(1) snorkel gear, (2) scuba snorkel

The **snorkel** rental shop provided us with a map of the nearby snorkel sites.

# submerge

ν. to put something under water or to go under water; to bury or hide something deeply or completely

synonym: deluge, drench, dunk

(1) **submerge** in a liquid, (2) **submerge** my head completely

The ship was **submerged** in the ocean for many years before it was finally discovered.

#### contented

 adj. feeling or expressing satisfaction and happiness with one's situation, life, or accomplishments; happy and at peace

synonym: satisfied, fulfilled, pleased

(1) **contented** smile, (2) **contented** customer The sound of the rain on the rooftop made her feel **contented** and relaxed.
