### glare

# origami

 the Japanese art or practice of folding paper into decorative shapes and figures

synonym: paper folding, paper art

#### crane

 a large, tall machine used for moving heavy objects by suspending them from a beam or hook

synonym: hoist, derrick, winch

(1) **crane** operator, (2) **crane** construction

The construction workers used a **crane** to lift the heavy beams.

#### unfold

v. to open up or spread out something that is folded or rolled up; to reveal or disclose something that was previously hidden or unknown

synonym: open, spread out, expose

(1) **unfold** the story, (2) **unfold** the stroller

The mystery **unfolded** as the detectives gathered more clues.

#### concave

adj. curving inward like the inside of a bowl synonym: hollow, indented, sunken

(1) a concave lens, (2) concave surface

The bowl was **concave** and held the water perfectly.

#### convex

adj. having a surface or outline that curves outward, like the exterior of a ball; having a shape that bulges or curves outward

synonym: curved, arched, bulging

(1) convex mirror, (2) convex surface

The magnifying glass had a **convex** shape, allowing for a better view of the specimen.

#### crease

 a line or mark made by folding or wrinkling a surface or material; a slight ridge or fold in fabric or paper caused by pressing or folding

synonym: fold, wrinkle, ridge

(1) crease in fabric, (2) deep crease

The shirt had a noticeable **crease** along the sleeve from being folded.

### blueprint

 a photographic print of an early plan for a building or machine

synonym: draft, prototype, sketch

(1) **blueprint** for economic reform, (2) architect's **blueprint** A business plan is a **blueprint** for your success.

### foldable

adj. able to be bent or folded without breaking; designed to fold up into a more compact shape for storage or

# transportation

synonym: foldaway, collapsible, portable

(1) foldable bike, (2) foldable table

The airline allows passengers to bring a **foldable** stroller on board.

#### clockwise

adv. in a circular direction that follows the course of a clock's hands or in a direction that is considered to be forward or positive

synonym: rightward, deasil

(1) rotate clockwise, (2) move clockwise

We need to turn the knob **clockwise** to lock the door.

#### counterclockwise

adv. in a direction opposite to the rotation of a clock's hands or opposite to the usual direction of movement or flow synonym: anticlockwise, reversely

(1) move **counterclockwise**, (2) swirl **counterclockwise**The carousel rotates **counterclockwise** at a slow pace.

#### penetrate

v. to pass into or through something, often by overcoming resistance

synonym: pierce, stab, go through

(1) **penetrate** a cell, (2) **penetrate** quickly into the skin Western ideology slowly **penetrates** through the eastern countries.

# appendage

 a part attached to the main body or structure, often with a specific function or purpose; a limb or other body part that projects outward from the main body

synonym: extension, limb, attachment

spiny appendage, (2) mechanical appendage
 The spider's appendage allowed it to climb up the wall easily.

## sculpt

v. to create a work of art by carving, casting, or other shaping techniques

synonym: carve, mold, shape

(1) **sculpt** an image, (2) **sculpt** prototype

He spent hours every day **sculpting** figures out of clay.

## scorpion

 a small creature similar to an insect with a segmented body, a pair of pincers, and a long, thin tail that ends in a venomous sting

synonym: arachnid, stinger

(1) **scorpion** fish, (2) poisonous **scorpion** 

The **scorpion's** venom can be lethal to humans.

#### tessellation

 a pattern consisting of a repeated geometric shape or motif that covers a surface entirely without any gaps or overlaps

synonym: tiling, mosaic, pattern

(1) geometric **tessellation**, (2) **tessellation** pattern

The **tessellation** on the floor created a beautiful pattern with interlocking shapes.

# microscopic

adj. tiny; exceedingly precise and detail-oriented; of or used in microscopy

synonym: infinitesimal, tiny, atomic

(1) **microscopic** inquiry, (2) **microscopic** analysis Inspectors noticed **microscopic** cracks in the submarine's hull.

#### stent

- a small tube or wire mesh device that is used to keep an artery or other body opening open after surgery or other medical procedures
- (1) cardiac **stent**, (2) remove a **stent**

The doctor inserted a **stent** into the patient's artery to keep it open.

#### graft

a transplanted portion of tissue or skin, often taken from one part of the body and used to repair or replace damaged or missing tissue in another part; a corrupt or illegal means of acquiring wealth or power through illicit or unethical methods *synonym*: transplant, implantation, bribery

(1) graft surgery, (2) anti- graft law

The patient's skin **graft** procedure was successful, and he was released from the hospital.

# airbag

 a safety device designed to inflate rapidly in the event of a collision, protecting the occupants of a vehicle and reducing the risk of injury or death

synonym: air cushion, safety bag, crash bag

(1) defective airbag, (2) airbag deployment

The **airbag** system in the car saved the driver's life in a severe crash.

#### nanostructure

- a structure that falls in between microscopic and molecular in size
- (1) **nanostructure** material, (2) three-dimensional **nanostructure**

This feature of the material is a result of its nanostructure.
