### dart

 a simple drawing depicting a humorous or critical situation, often accompanied by a caption

### upset

adj. causing or marked by anxiety, uneasiness, trouble, or grief; (verb) to make someone anxious, unhappy, or angry

### bewilder

v. to confuse or puzzle someone; to cause someone to become lost or disoriented in thought or perception

#### odd

adj. strange or unexpected; not divisible by two

### authentic

adj. known to be real and what people say it is; not a fake or copy

### belong

### perspective

a confident attitude toward something; a particular style of thinking about something

diversity

 the quality or fact of many different types of things or people being included in something; a range of different things or people

synonym: variety, multiplicity, variousness

### strength

 the quality or state of being physically, or sometimes mentally, strong

### underrepresented

#### contort

### professionalism

### distort

### elaboration

### compete

### compromise

to settle a problem or disagreement by mutual concession

synonym: agree, settle, negotiate

*n.* a thing given in acknowledgment of service, hard work, achievement, etc.

*synonym*: compensation, gratuity, bonus

### definition

 a concise explanation of the meaning of a word, phrase, or symbol

synonym: description, connotation, meaning

### allege

 to claim or assert that something is true without providing proof or evidence

synonym: claim, assert, state

(1) allege abuse, (2) allege wrongdoing

The prosecution **alleged** that the defendant was guilty of the crime.

#### sustain

v. to supply enough of what somebody or something needs to survive or exist; to accept as valid

*synonym*: maintain, nurture, support

She struggled to **sustain** the children's reading habits.

### palatable

 adj. having a pleasant or acceptable taste; pleasing or agreeable to the mind or senses; easily tolerated or accepted

was surprisingly palatable.

### proxy

 a person or entity that is authorized to act on behalf of another person or entity

synonym: surrogate, representative, agent

She voted by **proxy** because she was unable to attend in person.

### mask

v. to conceal something; (noun) a covering that you wear over your face to hide it

*synonym*: disguise, camouflage, conceal

mask body odor, (2) an oxygen mask

### ageism

 discrimination or prejudice against individuals or groups based solely on their age, particularly against older people

synonym: age discrimination, age bias, age prejudice

(1) **ageism** in society, (2) fight against **ageism** Many people experience **ageism** in the workplace, particularly as they get older.

ableism

 discrimination or prejudice against people with disabilities; the belief that non-disabled individuals are superior to those with disabilities

synonym: discrimination, bias, prejudice

(1) **ableism** awareness, (2) **ableism** discrimination Many people with disabilities face **ableism** daily in the workplace or public spaces.

### homophobia

n. a strong fear, aversion, or hostility towards people who are homosexual or towards homosexuality itself; discrimination or prejudice against lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and questioning (LGBTQ) individuals based on their sexual orientation or gender identity

synonym:

prejudice, discrimination, bigotry

(1) **homophobia** awareness, (2) **homophobia** in sports The politician's remarks about same-sex marriage revealed his deep-seated **homophobia**.

### xenophobia

- n. extreme fear or hatred of people from other countriessynonym: fear, hatred, aversion
- (1) suffer from **xenophobia**, (2) linguistic **xenophobia**The **xenophobia** in society makes it hard for immigrants to assimilate and integrate.

### rampant

 adj. (especially of something bad or unwelcome) flourishing or spreading everywhere in a way that cannot be controlled

*synonym*: prevalent, dense, uncontrolled

(1) **rampant** growth of weeds, (2) **rampant** corruption In an overly protective industry, violations of the ethics rules tend to be **rampant**.

examine

v. to study or consider a person or object attentively and thoroughly to learn something about them

synonym: study, probe, analyze

- a measure of the rate at which an engine or motor rotates, often expressed in revolutions per minute (RPM); (verb) to increase the number of rotations per minute

### firm

adj. resolute or unwavering in decision-making or action;

### brainstorming

### schedule

 a list of planned activities, tasks, or things that must be completed showing when they are intended to happen or be done

#### enthusiastic

- adj. having or showing great excitement, interest, or eagerness; energetic or passionate about somethingsynonym: ardent, fervent, crazy
- (1) **enthusiastic** football fan, (2) **enthusiastic** audience She was **enthusiastic** about starting her new job.

### contribution

n. the act of giving something, especially money, to a particular cause or organization; a voluntary gift as of money or service or ideas made to some worthwhile cause

synonym: donation, gift, offering

His **contribution** to the charity was a generous donation of money.

### agreeable

adj. pleasant and enjoyable

synonym: affable, amiable, cooperative

### aback

adv. to be very surprised or shocked by somebody or something

synonym: surprised, astounded, shocked

(1) flat aback, (2) aback shock

### pivotal

 adj. relating to or acting as a pivot or central point; crucial or essential to the success or outcome of something

synonym: crucial, essential, important

(1) pivotal moment, (2) pivotal role

The CEO's decision was **pivotal** in the success of the company's expansion plans.

### excite

- v. to make someone feel suddenly enthusiastic or eager
- synonym: thrill, exhilarate, animate
- (1) excite the crowd, (2) excite rebellion

The news of her promotion excited her.

id

a part of the psyche that represents the unconscious desires and instincts of an individual; in psychoanalytic theory, it is believed to be the most basic and primal part of the human psyche; (also ID, short for identification) a document or card that proves a person's identity, such as a driver's license, passport, or national ID card

synonym: identity, ego, persona

(1) the **id** ego, (2) **ID** card

I forgot my **ID** at home and needed it to enter the club.

### colleague

 one of a group of a coworker, especially in a profession or a business

synonym: coworker, associate, fellow

#### reserve

### riveting

 adj. deeply engaging or captivating; capable of keeping one's attention focused or fixed

### opt

- v. to make a choice from a range of possibilities synonym: choose, select, pick

### constrict

- v. to make something narrow or tight, often restricting movement or flow; to become narrow or tightersynonym: squeeze, compress, tighten

#### consistent

adj. always behaving or happening in the same way, or having the same thoughts, standards, etc.

*synonym*: coherent, constant, compatible

#### framework

 the structural components of a building or object that support its weight and give it form; the underlying structure of a system, concept, or text

*synonym*: structure, scheme, foundation

### deny

v. to state that one refuses to admit the existence or truth of something

synonym: refute, reject, repudiate

- adamantly deny killing, (2) deny the allegations
   still denying stealing the money from the cash register.
- reverse v. to change something's direction, order, position, decision, etc., to the opposite one; (adjective) directed or

moving toward the rear

synonym: overturn, shift, switch

(1) **reverse** the trend, (2) **reverse** the order The restaurant **reversed** a ban on smoking.

### victim

 a person who has been harmed, injured, or otherwise negatively affected by a particular action, circumstance, or event

synonym: prey, target, sufferer

(1) **victim** support, (2) **victim** compensation

The **victim** of the crime deserves justice and support to recover from the trauma.

#### offend

- v. to cause someone to feel upset, angry, or annoyed synonym: insult, hurt, anger
- (1) **offend** his sensibilities, (2) **offend** a customer His rude comments **offended** many people at the party.

#### sensitive
