synonym: belittled, marginalized, disadvantaged

(1) feel **underrepresented**, (2) **underrepresented** data **Underrepresented** communities need more support and resources to achieve equity.

#### contort

v. to (cause something to) twist and press out of its natural or normal shape

*synonym*: deform, disfigure, distort

(1) contort my limbs, (2) contort the face

He **contorted** his smile with anger coming from his gut.

#### distort

v. to change something's shape, appearance, or sound so that it appears weird or unclear

synonym: fudge, deform, contort

(1) **distort** the facts, (2) **distort** the economy

Economists contend that taxes **distort** consumer behavior in general.

## elaboration

 the act of adding more details, information, or explanation to something; the development or expansion of an idea, plan, or project

synonym: complexity, detail, refinement

(1) elaboration of details, (2) literary elaboration

The professor's **elaboration** helped the students better understand the concept.

#### guise

n. the outward appearance or aspect of someone or something, especially in a way that is different from usual or concealing the true nature

synonym: appearance, pretense, masquerade

(1) in the **guise** of a woman, (2) under the **guise** of friendship

They operated an illegal business under the **guise** of an employment agency.

#### overlook

v. to fail to notice something; to watch over someone; to provide a view from above

synonym: disregard, look down, supervise

(1) **overlook** a street, (2) **overlook** that fact

We cannot **overlook** an opportunity for great success.

#### undeserved

adj. not warranted, justified, or earned; unjustifiable or unfair synonym: undue, improper, needless

(1) receive **undeserved** honor, (2) **undeserved** status He received an **undeserved** reputation as a coward.

## allege

v. to claim or assert that something is true without providing proof or evidence

synonym: claim, assert, state

(1) allege abuse, (2) allege wrongdoing

The prosecution **alleged** that the defendant was guilty of the crime.

# palatable

adj. having a pleasant or acceptable taste; pleasing or agreeable to the mind or senses; easily tolerated or accepted

synonym: delicious, tasty, flavorful

(1) palatable food, (2) palatable solution

I'm usually a picky eater, but the seafood at this restaurant was surprisingly **palatable**.

# ageism

 discrimination or prejudice against individuals or groups based solely on their age, particularly against older people

synonym: age discrimination, age bias, age prejudice

(1) ageism in society, (2) fight against ageism

Many people experience **ageism** in the workplace, particularly as they get older.

#### ableism

 discrimination or prejudice against people with disabilities; the belief that non-disabled individuals are superior to those with disabilities

synonym: discrimination, bias, prejudice

(1) **ableism** awareness, (2) **ableism** discrimination Many people with disabilities face **ableism** daily in the workplace or public spaces.

# homophobia

n. a strong fear, aversion, or hostility towards people who are homosexual or towards homosexuality itself; discrimination or prejudice against lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and questioning (LGBTQ) individuals based on their sexual orientation or gender identity

synonym: prejudice, discrimination, bigotry

(1) **homophobia** awareness, (2) **homophobia** in sports The politician's remarks about same-sex marriage revealed his deep-seated **homophobia**.

# xenophobia

- n. extreme fear or hatred of people from other countriessynonym: fear, hatred, aversion
- (1) suffer from **xenophobia**, (2) linguistic **xenophobia**The **xenophobia** in society makes it hard for immigrants to assimilate and integrate.

# rampant

 adj. (especially of something bad or unwelcome) flourishing or spreading everywhere in a way that cannot be controlled

synonym: prevalent, dense, uncontrolled

(1) **rampant** growth of weeds, (2) **rampant** corruption In an overly protective industry, violations of the ethics rules tend to be **rampant**.

rev

 a measure of the rate at which an engine or motor rotates, often expressed in revolutions per minute (RPM); (verb) to increase the number of rotations per minute

*synonym*: revolution, RPM, speed

He stepped on the gas pedal, and the engine released a loud **rev**.

# brainstorming

- a group activity or business method in which a group of people meet and think about something at the same time to solve a problem or to create good ideas
- (1) **brainstorming** session, (2) do a **brainstorming** about a new product

Many companies employ **brainstorming** as a good way of generating innovative ideas.

#### agreeable

adj. pleasant and enjoyable

synonym: affable, amiable, cooperative

(1) **agreeable** weather, (2) **agreeable** to the plan We spent a most **agreeable** couple of days.

#### aback

adv. to be very surprised or shocked by somebody or something

synonym: surprised, astounded, shocked

(1) flat aback, (2) aback shock

The sudden news of the merger took me **aback**.

## pivotal

adj. relating to or acting as a pivot or central point; crucial or essential to the success or outcome of something

synonym: crucial, essential, important

(1) pivotal moment, (2) pivotal role

The CEO's decision was **pivotal** in the success of the company's expansion plans.

#### excite

# riveting

#### constrict

#### offend

#### futile

# nonbinary

- adj. someone who does not identify as a man or a woman;not relating to, composed of, or including only two thingssynonym: pluralistic, polyphyletic

  More and more people in various countries believe that the policymaker should change the marriage rules for **nonbinary** people.

sect

 a group of people who follow a particular religious or philosophical belief system, especially one that is regarded as outside the norm or mainstream

synonym: group, faction, cult

The minority **sect** believed in a set of unconventional religious practices.

straighten

bigotry
