seedling

 a young plant that has just germinated and has not yet developed leaves or true roots

synonym: sapling, sprout, shoot

hillside

 the sloping side of a hill or mountain; a landscape feature characterized by a natural gradient or incline

synonym: slope, incline

The hikers were stunned by the beautiful wildflowers on the **hillside**.

mangrove

- a tropical coastal tree or shrub that grows in saline soil and has prop roots that help to stabilize it

steward

a person responsible for the management and care of another's property or for the supervision of the domestic staff of a large household or organization; a person in charge of arranging for the supply of food to a college, club, etc. synonym: caretaker, manager, custodian
