fingertip

- *n*. the end or tip of a finger

strategy

 a detailed plan of action designed to achieve a long-term or overall goal.

synonym: approach, procedure, scenario

silo

n. a tall, cylindrical structure, usually made of concrete or steel, that is used for storing grain, feed, or other dry materials; a system or structure that is isolated or separate from others

echo

 a sound heard after being reflected off a surface, such as a wall or a cliff

chamber

 a large room used for a formal, public, or particular purpose; one of the parts of a parliament

socialist

adj. relating to or supporting socialism (= the idea that the wealth and resources of a society should be shared among all members rather than being concentrated in the hands of a small group of individuals or corporations) synonym: communistic, Marxist, socialist

He is a progressive **socialist** and believes in the equal distribution of wealth.

bootstrap

row

an arrangement of objects or people side by side in a line

firsthand

adv. from the source; directly; (adjective) received directly from a source

synonym: direct

mentor

 a person who helps and advises a younger or less experienced person over time, usually at work or school synonym: adviser, coach, tutor

inspiration

 something that motivates or encourages someone to create or achieve something, or a feeling of excitement or creativity

synonym: motivation, drive, encouragement

oxymoron

 a figure of speech that combines contradictory terms, such as "jumbo shrimp" or "deafening silence"

synonym: contradiction in terms, paradox, self-contradiction

"Awfully good" is an **oxymoron** that can be used to describe something that's both bad and good simultaneously.

convention

 a large formal assembly of people who do a particular job or have a similar interest or of a political party; something regarded as a normative example

synonym: meeting, conference, congress

(1) **convention** center, (2) political **convention** They met at biennial **conventions**.

dignity

 the quality of being worthy of esteem or respect; high office or rank or station

synonym: grace, elegance, nobility

(1) respect for human **dignity**, (2) retain everyone's **dignity**. The failure destroyed his trust and personal **dignity**.

racist

adj. characterized by or showing discrimination or prejudice against people of other races; (noun) a person with a prejudiced belief that one racial group is superior to others

synonym: discriminatory, prejudiced, bigoted

The **racist** comments made by the politician caused widespread condemnation.

discriminating

adj. having or showing the ability to judge or discern, typically by distinguishing differences or making careful and considered choices; selective in a discerning way; showing refined taste or awareness of quality

colleague

fiscal

incentive
