# technological

adj. based on scientific and industrial progress synonym: specialized, technical

# advance

- v. to go or move forward; to develop in a positive way synonym: progress, boost, come along
- (1) **advance** the technology, (2) **advance** a cooperative relationship

Scientific knowledge will **advance** significantly with the power of AI.

#### tweet

- a short, high sound made by a small bird; a message sent using Twitter, the social media application

# pound

- the standard unit of money in the UK; the standard unit of weight equal to 16 ounces

#### chuck

critic

to throw something carelessly or casually; to get rid of something or someone

synonym: toss, throw, discard

### shortfall

the amount by which something falls short of its target or goal; a deficit or shortage in quantity, quality, or standards

synonym: deficit, shortage, insufficiency

#### coronavirus

a large family of viruses that can cause illness in humans and animals, which name comes from the crown-like spikes on the surface of the virus, which can be seen under a microscope, and COVID-19 is caused by a specific type of coronavirus known as SARS-CoV-2

synonym: covid

(1) coronavirus antibody test kit, (2) coronavirus bankruptcy

# paralyze

#### mortality

# complexity

 the state or quality of being complicated or intricate and difficult to understand

synonym: intricacy, sophistication, elaboration

#### climate

n. the weather in a particular location averaged over some long period

synonym: atmosphere, weather, environment

a cold climate, (2) effects of climate change
 Climate and weather have an impact on every part of our lifestyles.

# drought

 a long period of time during which there is very little or no rain, leading to a shortage of water and often causing damage to crops and other vegetation

synonym: dryness, aridity, water shortage

(1) periods of drought, (2) drought conditions

The region has been experiencing a severe **drought**, leading to water shortages and crop failures.

#### avocado

 a pear-shaped fruit with a hard skin and buttery flesh, commonly eaten raw in salads, sandwiches, or as guacamole synonym: alligator pear, butter pear, midshipman's butter

almond

### invasive

insect

- any small creature that has six legs and a body divided into three sections

### panel

#### tradition

 a belief, custom, or way of doing something that has been passed down from generation to generation within a group or society

# controversy

 a lot of discussion and argument about something, often involving strong feelings of anger or disapproval

synonym: disagreement, dispute, argument

They entered into **controversy** with the member of the ruling party.

#### ripe

adj. (of fruit or crops) fully developed and ready to be eaten or harvested

### reinvent

v. to change something so drastically that it looks to be completely new

synonym: recreate, remake, revive

# proclaim

v. to announce or state something publicly and forcefully synonym: announce, declare, trumpet

v. to put money, effort, time, etc. into something to make a profit or achieve a result

*synonym*: fund, sponsor, support

#### sustainable

adj. able to continue or be continued for a long time synonym: continuable, endurable, tolerable

#### advocate

 a person who supports or suggests an idea, development, or way of doing something

synonym: proponent, exponent, promoter

#### bristle

# dynamics

# inevitably

adj. not expensive and able to pay
