frightening

adj. causing fear or alarm, or very surprising and alarming synonym: scary, terrifying, alarming

sniff

 to inhale audibly through the nose, often to detect or identify a smell; to draw in air through the nostrils with a quick, audible intake of breath

synonym: smell, inhale, scent

(1) **sniff** the air, (2) **sniff** the perfume

The dog stopped to **sniff** around the tree, looking for something interesting.

cousin

1. the child of your aunt or uncle

synonym: relative

(1) cross- **cousin** marriage, (2) **cousin's** family I used to play with my younger male **cousins** when I was a little girl.

## grave

n. a place where a dead body is buried, typically marked by a headstone or other memorial; a very serious, solemn, or important matter; (verb) to carve, cut, or etch a design, inscription, or mark onto a hard surface, such as stone or metal; (adjective) serious, solemn, or weighty in nature

synonym: tomb, crypt, sepulcher

(1) **grave** an image, (2) **grave** mistake Many innocent civilians were killed and buried in mass **graves** outside the city during the war.

### wicked

adj. morally bad or evil synonym: evil, sinful, nefarious

(1) wicked thoughts, (2) wicked grinThe wicked witch cast a spell on the kingdom.

#### pretension

 the act of claiming or asserting something, especially without good reason or without evidence; an unfounded or excessive claim or ambition

*synonym*: presumption, pretense, affectation

(1) **pretension** to authority, (2) baseless **pretension**His **pretensions** of being a gourmet were quickly exposed when he could not identify basic herbs and spices.

hypocrisy

the practice of engaging in the same behavior or activity for which one criticizes another or the practice of claiming to have moral standards or beliefs to which one's behavior does not conform

synonym: insincerity, dissembling, duplicity

(1) without **hypocrisy**, (2) self-serving **hypocrisy**The commentaries often criticized the government's political **hypocrisy**.

#### reckless

adj. marked by a lack of care about danger and the likely results of your actions

synonym: impetuous, irresponsible, thoughtless

(1) **reckless** driving, (2) in a **reckless** manner **Reckless** youth makes rueful age.

#### reform

 the act of improving or correcting something that is wrong or bad; a change made to correct a flaw or problem

synonym: change, modify, improve

(1) economic **reform**, (2) **reform** movement

The government is proposing a **reform** to the healthcare system to make it more accessible and affordable for all citizens.

## quixotic

 adj. exceedingly idealistic or unrealistic; marked by extravagantly chivalrous pursuits and romantic ideals; impractical or unworkable

synonym: idealistic, impractical, unrealistic

(1) quixotic adventure, (2) quixotic dream

The politician's **quixotic** campaign promise to end all poverty was met with skepticism.

#### snare

n. a trap or device used to catch animals by means of a noose or wire loop; a type of drum consisting of a head stretched over a hollow shell, usually played with drumsticks

*synonym*: trap, noose, entanglement

(1) snare drum, (2) fall into a snare

The thief was caught in a **snare** set by the police.

#### sensible

 adj. having good sense or judgment; reasonable; practical; marked by a perception of the importance or seriousness of something

synonym: reasonable, practical, pragmatic

(1) **sensible** decision, (2) **sensible** approach

It's **sensible** to wear a helmet when riding a bike.

#### rehearse

v. to practice or repeat something, such as a performance, speech, or action, to prepare for an event or to improve one's skills; to go through the motions of a planned activity before executing it

synonym: practice, recite, drill

(1) rehearse an opera, (2) rehearse a speech

The actors needed to **rehearse** their lines before the performance.

heel

n. the rounded back part of the foot below the ankle;
 someone who is morally reprehensible; (verb) to follow someone or something

*synonym*: hindfoot

(1) **heel** bone, (2) **heel** wrestler

She wore high **heels** to the party.

### introduction

n. a preliminary explanation or remarks given before the start of a text, performance, or event; the act of bringing something new into existence or introducing something to a wider audience or new market

synonym: initiation, preamble, prologue

(1) introduction education, (2) self-introduction

The **introduction** to the new class was informative and engaging.

queer

adj. strange or odd, typically in an interesting or attractive way

synonym: strange, odd, unusual

(1) queer money, (2) queer fashion

The behavior of the clown at the party was quite queer.

## identity

n. the fact of being who or what somebody or something is; the features, emotions, or ideas that distinguish persons from one another

synonym: character, personality, individuality

(1) mistaken **identity**, (2) **identity** as an individual The terrorist's **identity** remains unknown.

#### maneuver

 a motion or combination of moves that requires skill and care; a clever strategy, activity, or movement intended to give someone an advantage

synonym: gimmick, trick, action

(1) political **maneuvers**, (2) made a great **maneuver** In this class, we learn the basic **maneuver** of the plane.

## perception

n. a belief, opinion, or image you have based on how you regard, understand, or interpret something; the ability to see, hear, or notice something through the senses

synonym: understanding, idea, awareness

## sincere

adj. (of a person, feelings, or behavior) open and genuine;not deceitful

irony

 the expression of one's meaning by using language that usually signifies the opposite, typically for humorous or rhetorical effect

synonym: sarcasm, cynicism, wit

The **irony** of the situation is that he won the lottery on the day he lost his job.

#### kitsch

 art, objects, or design considered to be tasteless and overly sentimental, often produced to appeal to popular or commercial taste rather than for artistic value

synonym: schlock, sentimentality

(1) kitsch art, (2) kitsch decor

The garden gnome statue is cheesy **kitsch**, but some people love that style.

## thorough

adj. done completely; significantly careful and accurate synonym: complete, comprehensive, meticulous

(1) **thorough** investigation, (2) provide **thorough** analysis A **thorough** brushing helps to keep your mouth fresh.

#### misunderstand

- v. to interpret or understand something in the wrong way synonym: misinterpret, misperceive, misapprehend
- (1) **misunderstand** each other, (2) **misunderstand** entirely about her

You should not **misunderstand** the meaning of freedom.

#### attend

- v. to be present at an event, to go to a place synonym: go, be present, accompany

#### educator

## importance

#### earnest

adj. characterized by sincere and severe conviction or effort;
 showing a deep and a genuine sense of purpose or commitment

synonym: sincere, serious, genuine

(1) **earnest** attempt, (2) **earnest** conversation

He spoke in an **earnest** tone, expressing his genuine concern for the safety of everyone involved.

#### scared

adj. afraid or frightened

synonym: frightened, fearful, dreading

### wrap

 to cover or enclose something entirely with paper, cloth, or other material

synonym: surround, cover, bandage

(1) wrap a fish in foil, (2) wrap up a meeting

**Wrap** the bandage tightly around the injured arm.

## awful

adj. causing fear, dread, or terror; very bad or unpleasant synonym: terrible, appalling, horrible

(1) an awful error, (2) do awful damage

I regretted making an **awful** mistake in my final exam.

#### awkward

adj. making you feel uncomfortable or embarrassed; causing inconvenience or difficulty

synonym: embarrassing, discomfiting, clumsy

(1) an awkward expression, (2) an awkward date

The **awkward** design of the interface made the operation difficult.

## gender

n. the range of characteristics of femininity and masculinity and differentiating between them, especially when considering social and cultural differences rather than differences in biology

synonym: sexuality

(1) **gender-blind** policies, (2) dual **gender** 

Cultural norms strongly influence **gender** expectations.

#### obvious

adj. easy to see, discover or understand synonym: apparent, conspicuous, evident

#### screw

v. to turn something, such as a bolt, with a driver or wrench to tighten or loosen it; (noun) a cylindrical rod with a helical ridge used to fasten things together

#### memorize

## disrupt

#### loose

#### communicate

 to share or exchange information with others by speaking, writing, moving your body, or using other signals

synonym: convey, share, transmit

- (2) communicate well with my advisor

Dolphins use sound to communicate with each other.

## degree

 a unit of measurement for angles, temperature, or level of proficiency or achievement; a rank or level of academic or professional attainment

synonym: level, qualification, diploma

(1) bachelor's **degree**, (2) **degree** centigrade

She received her **degree** in psychology from the university.

#### butler

 a male servant in charge of serving food and drinks and taking care of household duties

synonym: valet, majordomo, manservant

(1) butler service, (2) household butler

The personal **butler** announced that dinner was ready, and the guests went to the dining room.

#### fanatic

adj. characterized by excessive enthusiasm or zeal;
 displaying irrational or extreme devotion to a cause,
 ideology, or person, often to the point of intolerance or extremism

synonym: zealous, extremist, passionate

(1) fanatic about germs, (2) fanatic devotion

The **fanatic** supporters of the sports team traveled across the country to watch the match.

## binary

- n. a system of numbers that uses only two digits, 0 and 1synonym: twofold, double
- (1) a **binary** number, (2) trading in **binary** options

  A **binary** star is a system in which two stars revolve around each other.

#### costume

- n. a set of clothes worn by an actor in a play or film or by a person representing a particular character or occupationsynonym: attire, garb, outfit
- (1) **costume** party, (2) **costume** change She wore a beautiful **costume** for the play.

## constantly

adv. all the time

synonym: continuously, always, frequently

(1) a **constantly** innovative enterprise, (2) a **constantly** varying mind

## colleague

 one of a group of a coworker, especially in a profession or a business

synonym: coworker, associate, fellow

#### fluid

- n. a substance that can flow and is not solid
- synonym: liquid, aqua, sap
- (1) plenty of fluids, (2) fluid assets

#### carefree

#### semester

- one of the periods that the school or university divided into, especially in the US and Australia; a half-year term

## roughly

adv. approximately but not precisely; with a violent manner synonym: approximately, more or less, around

(1) **roughly** explain my idea, (2) **roughly** speaking Five miles is **roughly** similar to eight kilometers.

## embody

 to represent or exemplify something; to give tangible form to an abstract idea

synonym: represent, exemplify, personify

(1) **embody** my goal, (2) **embody** a spirit of charity

The company's new products **embody** the values of innovation and sustainability.

#### delicious

adj. exceptionally pleasing to taste or smell synonym: appetizing, mouthwatering, delectable

delicious breeze, (2) variety of delicious foods
 We could grill the meat in a delicious way.

## fraternity

 a group of people, especially men, who are associated with each other through a common interest or occupation

synonym: brotherhood, association, society

(1) the medical **fraternity**, (2) **fraternity** party My college students join a **fraternity** to make connections and build a sense of community.

## forgiveness

- n. the act of stopping feeling angry or resentful towards someone for a mistake or offense with compassionsynonym: pardon, amnesty, compassion

## snapback

- n. a type of hat with a flat brim that can be adjusted to snap into place at different angles; any clothing or accessory that goes out of style but then comes back into fashion after a period of time

## baggy

rev

 a measure of the rate at which an engine or motor rotates, often expressed in revolutions per minute (RPM); (verb) to increase the number of rotations per minute

He stepped on the gas pedal, and the engine released a loud **rev**.

lax

adj. not strict or severe; relaxed or lenient

synonym: loose, slack, relaxed

The **lax** security measures allowed the thief to enter the building easily.

jaw

 n. either of the two bones at the bottom of the face that moves when you open your mouth; (verb) talk socially without exchanging too much information

synonym: mouth, (verb) chitchat

(1) snatch victory from the **jaws** of defeat, (2) **jaw** muscle He dropped his **jaw** at the unexpected sight.

astound

- v. to surprise or shock someone with wonder very much synonym: amaze, astonish, surprise

#### fluctuate

 to rise and fall irregularly or unexpectedly; to vary or change often and unpredictably

synonym: vary, oscillate, sway

adj. furthest or highest in degree or order synonym: highest, maximum, foremost

#### silent

adj. without any or little soundsynonym: quiet, hushed, mute

(1) **silent** reading, (2) give **silent** consent

The politician remained **silent** despite intense media scrutiny.

lull

 a period of calm or quiet; a temporary cessation of activity, noise, or music; a soothing sound or movement that induces sleep or relaxation

*synonym*: calm, stillness, tranquility

(1) **Iull** in the battle, (2) the **Iull** before the storm

The waves crashing against the shore had a soothing **Iull** on the listeners.

## whisper

v. to speak very quietly to somebody using the breath rather than the voice so that only those close to you can hear you

synonym: murmur, rumor, mutter

(1) answer in a **whisper**, (2) the **whisper** of the leaves He took me aside and **whispered** in my ear.

#### construct

v. to build or create something; to assemble or combine different parts to form something whole

synonym: build, assemble, create

(1) **construct** a 3D image, (2) **construct** a dam

He **constructs** hypotheses that no mathematician has ever imagined before.

## comedy

a genre of dramatic entertainment that aims to amuse and provoke laughter by depicting amusing or ludicrous situations, characters, or events; the use of humor, wit, and satire in writing, films, and other forms of entertainment

synonym: humor, farce, satire

(1) comedy series, (2) romantic comedyI love going to see live comedy shows with my friends.

## delivery

n. the act of taking or sending something to a destination;the bringing of a baby during childbirth

synonym: sending, transporting, bringing

(1) an easy **delivery**, (2) special **delivery** 

The **delivery** truck arrived with the packages.

#### renowned

adj. famous and respected for great achievements, qualities, etc.

synonym: noted, prominent, acclaimed

a renowned artist, (2) renowned as a novelist
 This area is renowned for its hot springs.

#### scholar

 professor; a person who studies a topic in considerable depth, particularly in a university

synonym: professor, pupil, learner

(1) **scholar** in international politics, (2) noted **scholar** You won't have to pay college tuition if you're a **scholar**.

## seminal

adj. highly original, influential, or innovative; containing the seeds or beginnings of future development or growth; (of medicine) of or relating to semen or the male reproductive system

synonym: influential, groundbreaking, original

(1) **seminal** research, (2) **seminal** duct

The book was a **seminal** work in psychology, influencing generations of researchers.

## staple

adj. essential, crucial, or regularly used synonym: essential, fundamental, pivotal

(1) staple commodities, (2) staple crop

Rice and beans are a staple food in many cultures.

## undergraduate

 a student who is studying for their first degree at a university or other higher education institution

*synonym*: college student, freshman

(1) engineering **undergraduate**, (2) **undergraduate** course The class was composed of both **undergraduate** and graduate students.

### liberal

adj. willing to respect or allow many different types of beliefs or behavior; open-minded

*synonym*: broad, free, large-minded

(1) a **liberal** arts college, (2) under **liberal** conditions He is **liberal** in his thoughts.

#### institutionalize

v. to establish or make something a part of an institution (= a place such as a university, hospital, etc.)

synonym: formalize, establish, regularize

(1) **institutionalize** a system, (2) **institutionalize** customary laws

The new policy aims to **institutionalize** the use of renewable energy sources.

#### moreover

 adv. indicating that what follows is an additional or supplementary point; furthermore; in addition to what has been said before

synonym: furthermore, besides, in addition

(1) **moreover**, she decided to go, (2) but **moreover**, they work well together

The company is environmentally conscious, and **moreover**, it uses sustainable materials in its products.

## essay

- n. a short piece of writing on a particular topic, usually written by a student as a port of a course of study
- synonym: paper, commentary, report
- (1) score the SAT **essays**, (2) thoughtful **essay**The Chief editor checks all **essays** for plagiarism with software.

#### claim

v. to assert that something is true; to demand or request something as one's own; to lay legal or moral right to something; (noun) a demand or assertion of a right or something that one believes to be true

synonym: assert, declare, maintain

(1) claim responsibility, (2) false claim

He wants to **claim** ownership of the abandoned property.

## repetition

- n. the act of doing or saying something many timessynonym: duplication, iteration, recurrence
- (1) **repetition** of the word, (2) habitual **repetition Repetition** is the mother of all learning.

## recognizable

adj. easy to become aware of or identify synonym: noticeable, perceptible, definite

(1) to a **recognizable** degree, (2) **recognizable** landmark His car was easily **recognizable** in the parking lot.

## script

a written text of a film, play, broadcast, or speech;
 something written by hand

synonym: writing, penmanship, article

(1) a hand **script**, (2) the **script** of a play

The archaeologist found a hieratic Egyptian **script** on a stone monument.

## reproduce

v. to make a copy of something such as a picture, piece of text, music, etc.; to produce offspring through a sexual or asexual process

synonym: duplicate, breed, imitate

(1) **reproduce** the painting, (2) **reproduce** by myself By dividing and creating copies of themselves, bacteria **reproduce**.

## attempt

 an act or effort of trying to do something, especially something difficult

synonym: endeavor, effort, try

(1) the **attempt** to rescue the hostages, (2) a reckless **attempt** 

The third attempt was far more successful.

#### masculine

adj. having characteristics or an appearance that are usually regarded as typical or appropriate for men

synonym: male, mannish, manly

(1) wear masculine attire, (2) masculine beauty

Her allure lies in her **masculine** rather than feminine beauty.

#### suave

 adj. smoothly polite or refined in manner; graceful and elegant in appearance or behavior; charmingly confident and sophisticated

synonym: smooth, polished, charming

(1) **suave** appearance, (2) **suave** charm

The **suave** gentleman in the suit charmed his way into the job interview.

#### feminine

adj. relating to women; having the features or appearance often associated with women

synonym: womanly, womanlike, femalelike

add a feminine touch, (2) the sacred feminine
 The dress mixes sophisticated lines with an appealing floral

design for a classically feminine style.

### achieve

v. to successfully complete a task or goal, often through hard work, perseverance, and dedication; to attain or accomplish something that one has set out to do

*synonym*: accomplish, attain, reach

(1) achieve success, (2) achieve milestones

I will work hard to **achieve** my goals and realize my dreams.

#### cast

 to cause light or shadow to appear on a surface; to assing or choose someone such as an actor or representative, especially by selection process

*synonym*: throw, project, select

(1) cast a ballot, (2) cast a charming eye

This accident **cast** a dark shadow over their lives.

## simultaneously

adv. at the same time

synonym: concurrently, coincidently, together

(1) **simultaneously** affected, (2) take several inputs **simultaneously** 

Two students answered the teacher's question **simultaneously**.

## rocky

adj. full of or abounding in rocks; of, relating to, or made of rock

synonym: stony, boulder-strewn, rough

(1) rocky terrain, (2) rocky relationship

The **rocky** road made it difficult to drive on.

#### horror

 intense fear or disgust, especially at something shocking or terrifying

synonym: fear, terror, dread

(1) horror movie, (2) horror-struck look

The stories of war crimes filled her with horror.

### orchard

a piece of land that is planted with fruit trees, such as apples, pears, or cherries

synonym: grove, plantation, fruit garden

(1) local apple orchard, (2) orchard tree

The farmer owns an **orchard** where he grows apples, pears, and plums.

#### rehearsal

n. a practice session, usually for a performance or presentation, during which people prepare and fine-tune their performance, often with the help of feedback from others; the act of rehearsing
