#### thermos

 a container designed to keep its contents at a constant temperature, usually by having a vacuum-insulated double wall

synonym: vacuum flask, insulated bottle

### discreet

### kimchi

### discontent

- dissatisfaction or unhappiness with a situation or condition; a feeling of displeasure or disapproval
- synonym: dissatisfaction, unrest, displeasure
- (1) political **discontent**, (2) widespread **discontent**The worker's **discontent** with their wages led to a strike.

### puzzled

- adj. confused or uncertain because you do not understand something
- synonym: confused, perplexed, bewildered
- (1) **puzzled** expression, (2) **puzzled** by the question She was **puzzled** by the strange behavior of her cat.

### jealousy

- a feeling of resentment or bitterness towards someone because they have something that you desire
- synonym: envy, covetousness, resentment
- (1) **jealousy** feeling towards another person, (2) burn with **jealousy**

His **jealousy** of his brother's success caused a rift in their relationship.

#### recess

- a period of time when the members of a parliament,
   committee, etc., are adjourned; a short break in a trial in court
- synonym: break, interval, pause
- (1) a court **recess**, (2) during noon **recess**The company decided to take a **recess** and reconvene the meeting later that day.

### **laminate**

- a material made by bonding together two or more layers of different materials, often used in furniture or flooring
   synonym: veneer, coating, layer
- (1) laminate flooring, (2) laminate table

The countertop in my kitchen is made of durable **laminate** material.

### yell

v. to shout in a sudden and loud way

synonym: shout, scream, cry

(1) **yell** for help, (2) **yell** as loud as we can

When I asked my father for more money, he became furious and **yelled** at me.

### tremble

v. to shake slightly in a way that you cannot control, for example, because you are frightened, angry, or excited, or because of illness

synonym: shiver, flutter, quaver

(1) **tremble** in fear, (2) **tremble** violently with emotion When I heard the news, my whole body **trembled** with excitement.

### reprimand

 to express severe disapproval of someone, typically in a formal statement or action; (noun) a rebuke or scolding given to someone, especially by an authority figure, for a mistake or misbehavior

synonym: rebuke, admonition, scolding

(1) **reprimand** me for staying out too late, (2) official **reprimand** 

The teacher **reprimanded** the student for cheating on the test.

### bruise

 a mark caused by a blow, typically one that is purple or black on the skin

synonym: contusion, injury, wound

(1) livid **bruise**, (2) earlier emotional **bruise** 

She had a **bruise** on her arm from where she fell on the playground.

### opportune

adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purpose

synonym: suitable, timely, practical

(1) **opportune** occasion, (2) an **opportune** remark The phone rang at the most **opportune** time.

### conquer

- v. to bring under control by force or authority synonym: defeat, overpower, subdue
- (1) **conquer** fatal disease, (2) **conquer** the world You must **conquer** your anxiety about driving.

### distract

synonym: divert, preoccupy, confuse

### preach

### slap

### burnout

### understatement

- an expression that describes something as less important or serious than it really is
- synonym: minimization, underplay, underrating
- (1) with a certain **understatement**, (2) master of **understatement**

### swell

v. to become larger or more inflated; to become more intense or important

synonym: expand, increase, inflate

### hoarse

### tingle

 to cause a stinging or prickling sensation; (noun) a feeling of slight numbness or a slight prickling or stinging sensation, typically as a result of cold or excitement

synonym: feel tickled, itch, prickle

### self-reliant
