#### industrious

## horsepower

## negligent

## occupant

 a person who lives or works at a particular place for a long time or who was born there

synonym: denizen, dweller, resident

#### discredit

v. to harm the reputation or credibility of someone or something; to make something appear untrue or unreliable

synonym: disprove, undermine, disgrace

(1) discredit a theory, (2) discredit a witness

The company's unethical practices have **discredited** its brand image in the eyes of consumers.

#### Senate

a legislative body, especially the upper house of a parliament

synonym: upper house, council, assembly

(1) **Senate** hearing, (2) **Senate** Finance Committee

The **Senate** majority leader announced plans to bring the bill to the floor for a vote.

## capitol

 a building that houses a legislative assembly, especially the US Congress

synonym: government building, legislative center

The **capitol** building was a stunning example of classical architecture, with its marble columns and grand dome.

#### avert

v. to prevent something dangerous or undesirable from happening

synonym: discourage, prevent, deter

## receptive

*adj.* willing to listen to or accept new ideas or suggestions *synonym*: open-minded, sensory, sensorial

unfold

 to open up or spread out something that is folded or rolled up; to reveal or disclose something that was previously hidden or unknown

synonym: open, spread out, expose

The mystery **unfolded** as the detectives gathered more clues.

## divulge

v. to reveal or make known something that was previously secret or confidential; to disclose information that was previously concealed or hidden

synonym: reveal, disclose, expose

(1) **divulge** whereabouts, (2) **divulge** information He promised not to **divulge** confidential information to anyone.

## disrupt

v. to prevent or stop something, especially an event, activity, or process, from continuing in the usual way by causing a problem or disturbance

synonym: interrupt, disturb, break into

(1) **disrupt** a well-ordered condition, (2) **disrupt** sleep I'm so sorry to **disrupt** you when you're pretty busy.

## nanoscale

- adj. on a scale that can be measured in nanometres (= one billionth of a meter); on a very small scale

#### medicinal

## mind-boggling

 adj. extremely surprising or overwhelming and, therefore, difficult to understand or imagine

synonym: overwhelming, amazing, astonishing

(1) a **mind-boggling** puzzle, (2) a **mind-boggling** display Educating hundreds of thousands of recruits is a **mind-boggling** task.

#### climax

 the most intense or exciting moment of an event or experience; the point of highest dramatic tension or emotional intensity in a story, plot, or performance synonym: finale, pinnacle, apex

(1) emotional climax, (2) reach a climax

The **climax** of the movie had everyone on the edge of their seats.

#### earnest

adj. characterized by sincere and severe conviction or effort;
 showing a deep and a genuine sense of purpose or commitment

synonym: sincere, serious, genuine

(1) **earnest** attempt, (2) **earnest** conversation He spoke in an **earnest** tone, expressing his genuine concern for the safety of everyone involved.

#### whistleblower

 a person who reveals or reports illegal, unethical, or immoral activities, primarily in the workplace or government, that are not publicly known but harm the public interest or other people

synonym: informant, snitch

#### arouse

#### smoker

## quitter

 a person who gives up easily or does not have the determination to finish what they have started

synonym: coward, deserter, surrender

#### nicotine

 a colorless, oily, poisonous chemical compound found in tobacco leaves, which is highly addictive and acts as a stimulant, affecting the nervous system

#### empower

## vigilance

#### stamina

#### outnumber

## watchdog
