crack

insult

a remark or action that causes offense or disrespect; (verb) to treat, mention, or speak to rudely

conversation

an informal talk between two or more people to exchange their views, ideas, information, etc.

hormone

addict

recognize

v. to acknowledge or realize something or someone; to identify, remember, or become aware of something that was previously known or encountered

historic

adj. famous or significant in history, or potentially so *synonym*: memorable, momentous, historical

context

 the circumstances, facts, or conditions that surround a particular event, situation, or statement and that give it

meaning

synonym: background, setting, environment

stonewall

inn

v. to refuse to answer questions or provide information; to delay discussion or decision

synonym: obstruct, block, impede

- (1) **stonewall** the investigation, (2) **stonewall** their attempts The government **stonewalled** the opposition party's efforts to access information about the project.
- a small hotel or lodging establishment typically located in a rural area, often serving food and drink as well as lodging

movement

homophobia

modern

ignore

mainstream
