#### unfold

v. to open up or spread out something that is folded or rolled up; to reveal or disclose something that was previously hidden or unknown

synonym: open, spread out, expose

(1) **unfold** the story, (2) **unfold** the stroller The mystery **unfolded** as the detectives gathered more clues.

## displace

v. to force someone or something to leave their home or place of origin, especially as a result of conflict, natural disaster, or manipulation

synonym: evict, exile, remove

(1) **displace** workers, (2) **displace** the explosive power The construction of the new dam will **displace** hundreds of families living downstream.

## microcredit

n. small loans, typically less than \$50,000, given to individuals or groups, particularly those who lack access to traditional banking services, to start or expand small businesses or other income-generating activities

synonym: microfinance, microloan, small loan

- (1) **microcredit** lender, (2) **microcredit** program

  The government has established a **microcredit** scheme to stimulate entrepreneurship and create job opportunities.
- n. the existing state or condition of something, especially in relation to a particular situation or issue

synonym: status, condition, state

(1) status **quo** politician, (2) **quo** warranto
The company has been successful in maintaining the status **quo**.

## opportune

adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purpose

synonym: suitable, timely, practical

- (1) **opportune** occasion, (2) an **opportune** remark The phone rang at the most **opportune** time.
- v. to affect a person, an animal, or a plant with a disease-causing organism

synonym: pollute, contaminate, affect

## infect

(1) **infect** other animal species, (2) **infect** a computer with a virus

Children often **infect** parents with this head cold.

## epicenter

n. the point on the earth's surface directly above the focus of an earthquake

synonym: ground zero, focus, center

(1) the **epicenter** of the sports world, (2) **epicenter** magnitude

The **epicenter** of the earthquake was located deep beneath the earth's surface.

## mango

 tropical fruit with smooth, juicy flesh and a large, hard seed in the middle

synonym: fruit, tropical fruit

(1) ripe mango, (2) fresh mango

She cut the **mango** into small pieces and added them to the salad.

## loudspeaker

 an electronic device that amplifies sound, typically used to address a large audience or to play music or other audio content in public areas

synonym: speaker, loudhailer, megaphone

(1) wireless **loudspeaker**, (2) **loudspeaker** system

The teacher spoke through the **loudspeaker** so that every student could hear the announcement.

#### slum

 a heavily populated urban area characterized by poor, run-down housing and infrastructure, often associated with poverty and social neglect

synonym: shantytown, slumdwellings, ghetto

(1) slum area, (2) slum dwellers

The government needs to invest more in affordable housing options to reduce the number of people living in **slums**.

## chlorine

 a chemical element with the symbol CI and atomic number 17, a greenish-yellow gas that is highly reactive and used in a variety of applications, including as a bleach and disinfectant

synonym: element, greenish-yellow gas, bleach

(1) chlorine gas, (2) chlorine tablet

Some people are sensitive to the smell of **chlorine** and experience headaches or respiratory irritation.

## plum

- a small, sweet fruit with juicy flesh and a hard stone in the middle; a desirable or highly valued object, person, or position
- (1) plum pudding, (2) plum harvest

The farmer proudly displayed his basket of freshly picked **plums** at the market.

### botanical

- adj. relating to the study or science of plants; of, pertaining to, made from, or derived from plants
- synonym: botanic, plant-based, herbal
- (1) **botanical** extract, (2) **botanical** illustrations

  The **botanical** gardens were filled with exotic plants from all around the world.

#### hillside

- n. the sloping side of a hill or mountain; a landscape feature characterized by a natural gradient or inclinesynonym: slope, incline
- (1) **hillside** landscape, (2) **hillside** vineyard

  The hikers were stunned by the beautiful wildflowers on the **hillside**.

### pristine

- adj. new and completely free from dirt or contaminationsynonym: chaste, pure, immaculate
- (1) **pristine** beach, (2) maintain the **pristine** condition It is terrific to camp in **pristine** nature.

## firewood

*n.* wood used as fuel for fires, particularly for heating, cooking, or other purposes

synonym: fire logs, fire sticks, kindling

chop firewood, (2) stacks of firewood
 My neighbor gave me some extra firewood from their own supply.

## typhoid

 a severe bacterial infection that is typically spread through contaminated food or water; symptoms include fever, headache, muscle aches, and gastrointestinal problems

synonym: typhus, enteric fever

typhoid outbreak, (2) typhoid vaccination
 The doctor prescribed antibiotics to treat her typhoid symptoms.

## dysentery

- a disease of the bowels characterized by severe and bloody diarrhea (= frequent and watery bowel movements)
- (1) amoebic **dysentery**, (2) **dysentery** epidemic In some communities of the country, **dysentery** was the leading cause of death.

#### excite

- v. to make someone feel suddenly enthusiastic or eager synonym: thrill, exhilarate, animate
- (1) **excite** the crowd, (2) **excite** rebellion The news of her promotion **excited** her.

#### cleanliness

 the state of being clean or free from dirt, dust, or foreign substances; the practice of maintaining good hygiene and cleanliness

synonym: neatness, hygiene, sanitation

(1) **cleanliness** standards, (2) **cleanliness** of the kitchen We must prioritize our workplace's **cleanliness** for our employees' safety.

app

 n. (abbreviation for application) software designed to run on smartphones and other mobile devices or inside a web browser on a PC

synonym: application, software
