sneak

 to go somewhere, or take someone or something somewhere secretly or stealthily; to steal or do something secretly or stealthily

synonym: creep, tiptoe, smuggle

(1) **sneak** a cigarette, (2) **sneak** out of danger The children tried to **sneak** out and eat the candy.

luncheon

 a formal midday meal or banquet, typically one held in honor of a person or occasion

synonym: lunch, midday meal, dejeuner

(1) **luncheon** meeting, (2) **luncheon** appointment I'm attending a business **luncheon** tomorrow to meet with potential clients.

impasto

n. a painting technique in which paint is applied thickly and heavily so that brushstrokes are visible and the resulting surface has texture and depth

synonym: thick paint, paste, mixture

(1) **impasto** painting, (2) bold **impasto** strokes

The painter used a thick **impasto** technique to create a textured canvas.

futile

adj. incapable of producing any useful result; pointless *synonym*: useless, worthless, ineffective

(1) **futile** talk, (2) make a **futile** protest It was **futile** to try and fix the broken vase, as it was too badly damaged.

unseen

adj. not seen or noticed; not perceived synonym: invisible, hidden, undercover

testament

a thing that proves the existence or truth of something else

synonym: proof, testimony, testimonial

Christ

synonym: Savior, Jesus Christ, Jesus

reconnect
