## genetic

adj. of or relating to genes (= parts of the DNA in cells) or the science of genes

## engineer

n. a person whose job is designing, building, or maintaining something such as machines, structures, or software
 synonym: architect, creator, builder

The **engineer** will repair my telephone tomorrow morning.

## competition

 a situation in which someone is attempting to beat or outperform another

synonym: contest, match, fight

(1) the first round of the **competition**, (2) intraspecific **competition** 

Global **competition** is rising in virtually every industry.

# undergraduate

 a student who is studying for their first degree at a university or other higher education institution

*synonym*: college student, freshman

(1) engineering **undergraduate**, (2) **undergraduate** course The class was composed of both **undergraduate** and graduate students.

## daisy

 a wildflower that typically has a yellow disc at the center of a white or pink-and-white flowerhead

synonym: marguerite, bellis, chrysanthemum

(1) daisy chain, (2) lawn daisy

She picked a blue **daisy** from the meadow and placed it in her hair.

#### embroider

to decorate or embellish a fabric or piece of clothing with ornamental or colorful designs using needlework; to add fictitious or exaggerated details to a story or account

synonym: decorate, adorn, embellish

- (1) **embroider** a dress, (2) **embroider** a cushion She chose to **embroider** her initials onto the scarf as a personal touch.
- a sport played on horseback in which two teams try to hit a ball through a goal using long-handled mallets
- polo shirt, (2) polo championship
   watched a thrilling polo match at the club over the weekens

I watched a thrilling **polo** match at the club over the weekend.

## handcuff

polo

n. a pair of metal restraints that are designed to lock around a person's wrists and prevent them from moving their hands freely; (verb) to restrain or restrict the movement of a person by applying handcuffs, typically as part of an arrest or other security-related process

synonym: shackle, bind, restraint

- (1) **handcuff** his wrists, (2) break free from **handcuffs** The police officer put **handcuffs** on the suspect before placing them in the squad car.
- n. the joint between the hand and the forearm; the narrow part of the hand near this joint

synonym: carpus

gesture

wrist

a movement of the hands, head, or face that express a particular meaning

synonym: motion, expression, gesticulation

gesture of goodwill, (2) hand gesture
 She made a facial gesture to express disagreement.

sneak

v. to go somewhere, or take someone or something somewhere secretly or stealthily; to steal or do something secretly or stealthily

synonym: creep, tiptoe, smuggle

(1) **sneak** a cigarette, (2) **sneak** out of danger

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The children tried to **sneak** out and eat the candy.

## glorious

adj. having or deserving great admiration, praise, and honor; having great beauty and splendor

synonym: exquisite, magnificent, majestic

a glorious victory, (2) photo in glorious color
 choose a glorious death rather than a shameful life.

## multicolored

adj. having many colors

synonym: variegated, multihued, multicoloured

multicolored lights, (2) multicolored dress
 The multicolored parrot was a beautiful sight.

#### bacteria

n. single-celled or noncellular spherical or spiral or rod-shaped organisms that exist in large numbers in the air, water, and soil, and also in living and dead creatures and plants, and are often a cause of disease

synonym: microorganism, microbe

(1) pathogenic **bacteria**, (2) harmless **bacteria Bacteria** prevalent in hospitals are often resistant to antibiotics.

#### coli

- a bacterium of the genus Escherichia that is commonly found in the human gut and is used as a model organism in molecular biology and biochemistry
- (1) E. **coli** bacteria strain, (2) **coli** cells

  The study of Escherichia **coli** has led to important advancements in areas such as antibiotic resistance, gut microbiome, and synthetic biology.

#### environment

n. the natural world such as air, water, and land in which humans, animals, and plants live

synonym: atmosphere, surroundings, climate

(1) **environment** affairs, (2) chaotic **environment** Every human is responsible for taking care of the Earth's **environment**.

#### rainbow

 an arch of colors in the sky caused by the refraction and dispersion of sunlight through rain

synonym: spectrum, iridescence, prism

(1) marine **rainbow**, (2) **rainbow** after a storm

She was mesmerized by the **rainbow's** colors.

#### arsenic

 a poisonous chemical element that occurs naturally in some rocks and minerals and is sometimes used in pesticides and wood preservatives

*synonym*: poison, toxin

(1) **arsenic** poisoning, (2) **arsenic** contamination

Exposure to **arsenic** in drinking water can cause serious health problems.

#### strain

 a force or pressure that stretches or pulls something, sometimes causing damage; (biology) a group of organisms within a species that differ in trivial ways from similar groups

synonym: pressure, tension, breed

(1) **strain** our eyes, (2) a **strain** of bacillus

Dictators of the past often had the erroneous idea of a pure racial **strain**.

#### collaborate

to work with someone else to produce or achieve something

*synonym*: cooperate, unite, get together

She agreed to **collaborate** with him in creating new artwork.

#### scenario

a description of possible actions or events in the future;
 a written outline of a play, film, or literary work

synonym: plan, scheme, procedure

(1) the worst case **scenario**, (2) number of different **scenarios** 

The president prepared several possible **scenarios** for an enemy attack.

## probiotic

a substance, typically a live bacterium, that is ingested to provide health benefits, particularly in aiding digestion or strengthening the immune system

synonym: probiotic bacteria, beneficial bacteria, microflora

(1) **probiotic** supplement, (2) **probiotic** yogurt **Probiotic-rich** foods, such as kefir and sauerkraut, can improve digestive health.

#### monitor

to observe, check, and track the progress or quality of something over a period of time

synonym: proctor, check, observe

- (1) monitor an exam, (2) monitor the data carefully They used a special receiver to **monitor** police radio channels.
- the long tube in the body of a person or animal through which food passes when it leaves the stomach; the mental strength or bravery required to do something difficult or unpleasant

synonym: belly, abdomen, courage

He told me a **gut-wrenching** truth about my parent's death.

# holy

adj. of or related to a god, divine power, or a particular religion

synonym: sacred, religious, divine

(1) a holy man, (2) a holy shrine

They gathered to hear the **holy** teachings of the guru.

# genetically

adv. in a way that relates to or is produced by genes (= the units in the cells of a living thing received by an animal or plant from its parents) or heredity

synonym: hereditary, inherited, family-related

(1) genetically inherited traits, (2) genetically manipulated plant

The **genetically** modified crops were resistant to pests and required less water.

gut

## gem

n. a precious or semiprecious stone, usually of high quality and often used as jewelry; something that is considered to be a highly prized and valuable possession or attribute of a person or thing

synonym: jewel, precious stone, diamond

The enga **gement** ring was a precious gem passed down through generations of her family.

## synthetic

 adj. made by combining chemical substances as opposed to being naturally occurring

# biology

- the scientific study of life and the natural processes of living things
- (1) evolutionary **biology**, (2) cell and molecular **biology** In junior high school, we had to dissect a frog in **biology** class.

#### weird

*adj.* extraordinary, unexpected, or difficult to explain *synonym*: bizarre, creepy, peculiar

a weird dress,
 the state of being weird
 a computer has been acting weird recently.

## definitely

adv. without any question and beyond doubt; clearlysynonym: absolutely, certainly, indeed

(1) **definitely** become a problem, (2) say **definitely** The paper is **definitely** worth reading thoroughly.

## oxymoron

a figure of speech that combines contradictory terms, such as "jumbo shrimp" or "deafening silence"

synonym: contradiction in terms, paradox, self-contradiction

(1) **oxymoron** phrase, (2) literary **oxymoron** 

"Awfully good" is an **oxymoron** that can be used to describe something that's both bad and good simultaneously.

## poke

- v. to push or prod with a sharp object or the finger synonym: prod, jab, push
- (1) poke around the desk, (2) poke a fireThey poked fun at each other's jokes, laughing and teasing.

## boundary

- n. a real or imaginary line that marks the limit or extent of something and separates it from other things or placessynonym: border, frontier, limitation
- (1) geographical **boundary**, (2) the **boundary** between reality and fantasy

He wandered the **boundary** between life and death by gunfire.

# technological

adj. based on scientific and industrial progresssynonym: specialized, technical

#### sudoku

n. a logic-based, combinatorial number-placement puzzle that typically consists of a 9x9 grid divided into nine 3x3 sub-grids and requires the solver to fill in each empty square with a number from 1-9, with the constraint that no number can appear more than once in a row, column, or sub-grid

synonym: number puzzle, logic game, brain teaser

spider

 a small, eight-legged creature that spins webs to catch insects as food; a computer program that systematically browses the World Wide Web for purposes of web indexing

synonym: arachnid, wanderer

(1) spider venom, (2) web spider

The **spider** spun an intricate web in the corner of the room.

silk

 a fine, strong, soft, lustrous fiber produced by silkworms in making cocoons and collected to make thread and fabric

synonym: satin, taffeta, velvet

(1) silk road, (2) silk fabric

She wore a **silk** dress to the party.

healing

 the process of becoming or making somebody or something well again

*synonym*: recovery, recuperation, convalescence

(1) natural **healing** ability, (2) part of the **healing** process Each ancient tribe has its **healing** traditions.

concrete

 adj. existing in a physical or material form rather than an abstract one; based on facts rather than ideas or guesses; made of or covered with cement

synonym: actual, factual, hardened

(1) a concrete noun, (2) concrete examples

The president asked for a more concrete plan.

tissue

 an ensemble of similar cells of the animal or plant that together carry out a specific function

*synonym*: structure, texture, anatomy

(1) a facial **tissue**, (2) loss of muscle **tissue** 

The researcher separated the nervous **tissue** for microscopic examinations.

plain

adj. without being decorated in any way; (Noun) a vast expanse of flat land with few trees

synonym: basic, straight, bare

(1) plain answer, (2) delta plain

The lowest lowland region is mostly flat plain.

insult

a remark or action that causes offense or disrespect;
 (verb) to treat, mention, or speak to rudely

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synonym: affront, slight, offense

bunch

 a grouping of several similar things which are growing or fastened together

synonym: group, assemblage, bundle

steel

 a strong metal alloy made up of iron with typically a few tenths of a percent of carbon used for making things that need a strong structure

discipline

n. the practice of training people to obey rules or a code of behavior, using and punishments if these are broken; a region of activity, knowledge, or influence

software

 a set of computer programs and associated documentation and data for doing particular computational jobs

synonym: program, system, operating system

creative

 adj. relating to or involving the use of skill and original and unusual ideas to create something

synonym: imaginative, innovative, inventive

## circuit

 n. (in electrical engineering) an electrical device that provides a path for electrical current to flow; a journey or route around a particular place or area

## conversation

 an informal talk between two or more people to exchange their views, ideas, information, etc.

## economy

n. the system by which a country or region produces manages, and distributes goods and services, including the money and finances involved in these activities; (of an airline) the lowest-priced, most basic option for seating in commercial travel

synonym: finance, trade, business

#### polar

adj. relating to, or close to, the North or South Pole; characterized by complete opposites

synonym: opposing, contrary, contrasting

## expansive

adj. large or wide in extent or scope; friendly and open and willing to talk

*adj.* tending to regrow or restore lost or injured tissue *synonym*: rejuvenating, restorative, healing

## recognize

v. to acknowledge or realize something or someone; to identify, remember, or become aware of something that was previously known or encountered

# squishy

adj. soft and yielding to the touch; easily deformedsynonym: soft, spongy, mushy

# sight

- n. the ability to see; anything that is seensynonym: vision, spectacle, view

synonym: fascination, illusion, wizardry

#### visceral

# unforgettable

adj. impossible to forget

## vision

 n. the ability to think about or see the future with imagination and intelligence; the faculty of being able to see

## frame

- n. a strong border or structure of the wood, metal, etc. that surrounds something such as a picture, door, or window synonym: body, skeleton, scaffolding
- (1) a picture frame,(2) the frame of the policyThe detective looked for fingerprints on the window frame.

#### chrome

 a type of polished metal that is highly reflective and has a mirror-like finish; a web browser developed by Google synonym: metal, alloy, steel

flesh

n. the soft substance composing the body of a person or animal, as opposed to bones and other structures

fiction

norm

 the type of book or story, especially novels, that describes imaginary events and people; anything made up or imagined that is not true

desirable

synonym: understanding, cognition, knowledge

#### microbe

- a tiny living thing that can only be seen with a microscope and that may cause disease
- synonym: germ, microorganism, bacterium

## chapter

- a separate section of a written work usually numbered and titled
- synonym: section, phase, episode
- (1) an introductory **chapter**, (2) **chapter** of a political party The final **chapter** provides a summary of the discussion.

## dissertation

- a long and formal written treatise or discourse, often presenting research or analysis on a particular subject or topic, in support of a degree or academic qualification
- *synonym*: essay, treatise, paper
- dissertation research, (2) doctoral dissertation
   My dissertation topic focuses on the impact of social media on mental health.

#### swab

- a small piece of soft material used by a doctor, nurse, etc., for cleaning a cut or taking a sample from somebody's body for testing; (verb) apply, usually a liquid, to a surface
- synonym: mop, scrub, daub
- (1) alcohol **swab**, (2) cotton **swab**
- He took a **swab** of his ear.

## explore

- v. to travel to or penetrate an area or a country to learn about it; to thoroughly examine a subject or a possibility to learn more about it
- synonym: analyze, delve into, examine
- (1) explore the world, (2) explore our options

The management must **explore** strategies to increase office security.

lab

 a workplace for the conduct of scientific research; a laboratory

*synonym*: workshop, laboratory, research chamber

(1) lab instrument, (2) medical lab

intersection

a point where two or more roads, lines, etc., cross each other

*synonym*: crossroad, junction, hub

transcend

- v. to rise above or go beyond the limits of something synonym: surpass, exceed, overcome

upload

 to transfer digital data or files from a local computer or device to a remote server or network; the act of transferring such data or files

brain

 the organ inside the head that is responsible for one's movement, thought, memory, and feeling

*synonym*: intellect, mind, encephalon

messy

adj. disorganized and untidysynonym: cluttered, disorganized, untidy

symmetry and the state of the s

(1) messy data, (2) messy handling

His **messy** bedroom is always a source of frustration for his mother.

## unpredictable

adj. not capable of being foreseen or calculated; not regular or certain

*synonym*: uncertain, variable, random

(1) dangerously **unpredictable** person, (2) **unpredictable** outcome

The weather in this region is often **unpredictable**, with sudden rainstorms and strong winds.

## tangle

- n. a confused mass of something twisted togethersynonym: knot, snarl, entanglement

## suppose

- v. to think that something is likely to be actual or possible synonym: guess, assume, presume

# purity

 n. the state of being undiluted or unmixed with anything else; the state of being free from immorality, especially of a sexual nature

# prejudice

## embedded

adj. fixed firmly into the surface of somethingsynonym: ingrained, implanted, inserted

## leather

 a material made from the skin of an animal, typically by tanning, and used for clothing, shoes, furniture, and other items

synonym: hide, skin, suede

## progression

 the act or process of changing to the next stage or phase or moving forward

synonym: advancement, development, evolution

(1) **progression** of civilization, (2) **progression** of disease The company has made great strides in its **progression** toward sustainability.

## consequence

n. the outcome of a particular action or event, especially relative to an individual

synonym: result, impact, outcome

(1) unintended **consequences**, (2) the **consequence** of an argument

These economic activities had disastrous environmental **consequences**.

#### define

 to state or explain precisely the nature, scope, or meaning of something

*synonym*: characterize, depict, express

(1) **define** a word, (2) **define** my position

To advance this discussion, we must **define** "success" rigorously.

## sequence

*n.* a series of related events, actions, numbers, etc., which have a particular order

synonym: arrangement, succession, series

(1) the **sequence** of the seasons, (2) the DNA **sequence** We do move forward with those tasks in **sequence** next week.

#### extract

a short passage taken from a book, piece of music, etc.;
 a substance obtained from something through a specific process; (verb) to obtain from something or to remove something by effort or force

*synonym*: excerpt, quote, distillation

- n. someone's right to keep their personal matters and relationships not watched or interrupted by other people synonym: seclusion, aloneness, solitariness

  - n. the weather in a particular location averaged over some long period
