smartphone

inventory

- a complete list of all the items or goods held in stock by a business or organization; the act of making such a list
 synonym: stock, supplies, goods
- (1) inventory control, (2) annual inventory

The store manager took **inventory** of the products on the shelves to know what needed restocking.

retail

 the sale of goods or services to consumers, especially in small quantities, either directly to the end customer or through retail outlets

synonym: sales, trade, commerce

ultimate

adj. furthest or highest in degree or order synonym: highest, maximum, foremost

transformation

 a complete change in form, nature, or appearance of someone or something

commonplace

adj. occurring very often; lacking originality or interest synonym: ordinary, routine, mundane

stake

 a share or financial investment in something such as a business; a wooden or metal post set up to mark something

synonym: share, interest, post

start-up

- n. a newly established company or business
- start-up business, (2) early-stage start-up
 Our company's services are targeted at start-up executives.

uramati

mood

roll

v. to move in a particular direction by turning over and over or from side to side

synonym: spin, swirl, wheel

(1) roll a ball, (2) roll down his cheeks

He was exhausted and **rolled** into bed as soon as he got home.

cloak

n. a type of loose, outer garment worn over the shoulders and fastened at the neck, often with a hood; something that covers or conceals something else; a mask or disguise

synonym: cape, mantle, shroud

(1) cloak room, (2) hooded cloak

The magician seemed to disappear when he threw his **cloak** over himself.

cycle

 an interval during which a recurring sequence of events occurs; a bicycle or motorcycle

synonym: revolution, rotation, bike

(1) the **cycle** of the seasons, (2) go to the workplace by **cycle**

The food chain causes a material **cycle**.

hypomania

n. a mood state characterized by intense feelings of joy or excitement, increased energy, talkativeness, and impulsivity, but at a less severe level than full mania, often associated with bipolar disorder and other mental health conditions

synonym: mania, frenzy, excitement

(1) **hypomania** symptoms, (2) **hypomania** disorder People with bipolar disorder may experience periods of **hypomania**, characterized by an elevated mood but less severe than full-blown mania.

misunderstand

- v. to interpret or understand something in the wrong way synonym: misinterpret, misperceive, misapprehend

dilute

v. to make a substance less concentrated by adding a liquid or another substance to it

synonym: weaken, thin, reduce

telltale

 adj. revealing or betraying information or evidence; serving as a sign or indicator of something

synonym: revealing, indicative, suggestive

psychosis

 a serious mental disorder characterized by a disconnection from reality, often including hallucinations, delusions, and a lack of insight into one's condition

(1) **psychosis** treatment, (2) drug-induced **psychosis**He was diagnosed with **psychosis** and was hospitalized for treatment.

creative

adj. relating to or involving the use of skill and original and unusual ideas to create something

synonym: imaginative, innovative, inventive

(1) creative writing, (2) barren of creative spirit

All the supervisor has to do is assign tasks that make his subordinates more **creative**.

ideate

 to conceive of and develop an idea or concept in one's mind, often as part of a creative process or a problem-solving effort

synonym: conceive, think up, brainstorm

(1) ideate solutions, (2) ideate process

The team met to **ideate** new marketing strategies for the upcoming product launch.

alternate

adj. occurring or existing one after the other regularly synonym: substitute, back up, equivalent

alternate choice, (2) every alternate year
 The cleaning lady comes on alternate Wednesdays.

devastating

adj. causing a great deal of destruction or damagesynonym: destructive, annihilative, disastrous

(1) have **devastating** effects, (2) treat this **devastating** disease

This typhoon was the most **devastating** in years.

severe

 adj. extremely serious or bad in feeling, manner, or strict and harsh; extremely strong or vigorous

synonym: harsh, relentless, powerful

(1) **severe** heat, (2) a **severe** case of pneumonia

The senator received **severe** criticism from his opponent.

cataleptic

adj. characterized by a state of extreme rigidity or immobility, often accompanied by a loss of consciousness or awareness; of or relating to a condition in which a person or animal appears to be in a state of suspended animation

synonym: trancelike, immobile, rigid

(1) cataleptic seizure, (2) cataleptic rigidity

The patient's **cataleptic** state made diagnosing her condition difficult for the doctors.

disappear

- v. to cease to exist or be visiblesynonym: fade, evaporate, vanish
- (1) **disappear** without a trace, (2) **disappear** after a week They watched the train **disappear** into the distance.

desirous

adj. having a strong feeling of wanting or wishing for something; characterized by a desire or longing

synonym: eager, longing, covetous

(1) desirous look, (2) desirous of success

She was **desirous** of a peaceful life in the countryside.

amplify

- v. to enhance something, particularly sound or brightness synonym: intensify, boost, argument
- (1) **amplify** a signal, (2) **amplify** the effect

gut

n. the long tube in the body of a person or animal through which food passes when it leaves the stomach; the mental strength or bravery required to do something difficult or unpleasant

synonym: belly, abdomen, courage

divorce

n. the legal dissolution of a marriage

synonym: separation, dissolution, breakup

madden

v. to make someone extremely angry or irritated, often to the point of losing control or rationality; to become irrational or frenzied with anger or frustration

The slow internet connection **maddened** him as he tried to stream his favorite show.

flee

v. to leave by running away, especially out of fear or danger

synonym: exit, escape, run away

shiny

adj. reflecting light and having a bright and smooth surface synonym: polished, glossy, lustrous

synonym: divert, preoccupy, confuse

synonym: fury, anger, outrage

howl

v. to make a prolonged, loud, mournful cry or noise, typically as a signal of distress, pain, or an intense emotion; to express one's strong feelings or emotions in a loud and unrestrained manner; (noun) a long, loud, mournful sound made by a person or an animal, often in response to pain, fear, or sadness
