sham

eventually

adv. finally, particularly after a long time or a lot of struggle, complications, and so on

synonym: finally, someday, ultimately

thorough

adj. done completely; significantly careful and accurate synonym: complete, comprehensive, meticulous

delight

n. a feeling of great pleasure or happiness

*synonym*: pleasure, joy, satisfaction

#### suit

### jealousy

### straight

adj. extending or moving in one direction without bending or curving; having no deviations

#### intimate

adj. having a very close friendship, personal

synonym: close, tight, friendly

#### gesture

a movement of the hands, head, or face that express a particular meaning

synonym: motion, expression, gesticulation

(1) **gesture** of goodwill, (2) hand **gesture**

lean

adj. having a noticeably small amount of body fat; (verb) to bend or move from a straight to a sloping posture

synonym: skinny, slender, (verb) slant

(1) a **lean** horse, (2) **lean** athletic figure

**Lean** operational improvements often lead to better environmental performance.

tuck

v. to push a stray piece of clothing or material into a particular area or position, especially to make it more orderly or comfortable

synonym: insert, wrap, pinch

(1) **tuck** a baby in the blanket, (2) **tuck** into another cigarette

You should **tuck** your shirt into your trousers.

#### unconscious

adj. in the state of lacking awareness and the capacity for sensory perception, especially as the result of a head injury or illness

synonym: comatose, paralyzed, senseless

peer

- n. a person who has the same age, status, or abilitysynonym: fellow, associate, counterpart

discuss

 to talk about or examine in detail through conversation or debate; to exchange ideas, opinions, or information on a particular topic

synonym: talk about, converse, debate

#### waist

 the part of the human body between the ribs and hips or the corresponding part in other animals

synonym: midriff, torso, abdomen

#### consequence

 the outcome of a particular action or event, especially relative to an individual

synonym: result, impact, outcome

(1) unintended **consequences**, (2) the **consequence** of an argument

These economic activities had disastrous environmental consequences.

#### amusement

the state or experience of finding something humorous or entertaining

synonym: entertainment, diversion, fun

#### bunch

n. a grouping of several similar things which are growing or fastened together

The **thoughtless** actions of the students caused damage to the school property.

### weigh

v. to have a particular weight; to carefully evaluate things before making a conclusion

*synonym*: consider, cogitate, count

#### stroll

to walk somewhere in a slow, relaxed way and with no apparent aim

synonym: amble, roam, mope

norm

- *n.* something that is regarded as usual, typical, or standard *synonym*: criterion, mean, standard
- (1) norm of action, (2) cultural norm

The systems we have developed has accepted as industry **norms**.

#### carefree

adj. without worries or concerns; free from anxiety, responsibility, or constraints

synonym: light-hearted, careloose, easygoing

(1) carefree attitude, (2) carefree vacation

I miss the **carefree** days of my childhood when I didn't have to worry about anything.

#### constantly

adv. all the time

synonym: continuously, always, frequently

(1) a **constantly** innovative enterprise, (2) a **constantly** varying mind

The mobile application industry is **constantly** changing.

scan

pave

 to examine something hastily, with the eyes or with a machine, to get information

synonym: look over, scrutinize, browse

- (1) **scan** the face of the man, (2) **scan** a document into PDF She stood on the podium and **scanned** an audience.
- to cover something with a hard, flat material such as stones, bricks, or concrete, to make it suitable for travel or use

synonym: surface, coat, cover

(1) **pave** a new path, (2) **pave** a smoother road They **paved** the courtyard with bricks, giving it a more polished appearance.

silent

adj. without any or little sound synonym: quiet, hushed, mute

(1) silent reading, (2) give silent consent

The politician remained **silent** despite intense media scrutiny.

defiant

adj. showing bold resistance or disobedience to authority, rules, or norms

synonym: rebellious, disobedient, insubordinate

(1) a defiant attitude, (2) defiant eye

The **defiant** student refused to follow the teacher's instructions and continued to talk during class.

defiance

 behavior characterized by an open refusal to obey someone or something

synonym: disobedience, disregard, confrontation

(1) fierce defiance, (2) adopt an attitude of defiance

ruin

- v. to damage, spoil, or demolish something; (noun) an unrecoverable state of devastation and destruction,
- synonym: bankrupt, demolish, destroy

He knocked over the red wine and ruined the tablecloth.

poke

- v. to push or prod with a sharp object or the finger synonym: prod, jab, push

spat

n. a minor quarrel or dispute, often one that is short-lived or insignificant; a sudden burst of activity or energy; a young oyster, clam, or other bivalves that has recently attached itself to a surface in its natural habitat

synonym: argument, disagreement, oyster

split

v. to divide, or to make something divide into two or more parts, especially along a particular line

react

- v. to take action in response to something synonym: respond, reply, oppose
- (1) **react** at a high temperature, (2) **react** against his way of thinking

wander

 to walk around slowly or to a place, often without any clear purpose or direction synonym: ramble, roam, stroll

(1) **wander** alone in a strange country, (2) **wander** far from home

I often wander around the park for half an hour.

posh

 adj. elegant, fashionable, or luxurious, often to an excessive or ostentatious degree; associated with the upper classes or a high level of social status

synonym: elegant, fancy, luxurious

(1) **posh** district, (2) **posh** restaurant

The CEO's office was decorated in a **posh** and elegant style.

depart

- v. to go away or leave, especially to start a journey synonym: go away, leave, vacate
- (1) arrive and **depart** on time, (2) **depart** from the faith We **departed** before the temperature fell below zero.

observe

v. to watch or notice something carefully, often to gather information or insights; to take note of something or someone; to celebrate or commemorate a special event or occasion

synonym: watch, monitor, scrutinize

(1) observe a tradition, (2) observe wildlife

It is important to **observe** safety procedures in the workplace to prevent accidents.

homophobia

n. a strong fear, aversion, or hostility towards people who are homosexual or towards homosexuality itself; discrimination or prejudice against lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and questioning (LGBTQ) individuals based on their sexual orientation or gender identity

synonym: prejudice, discrimination, bigotry

(1) **homophobia** awareness, (2) **homophobia** in sports The politician's remarks about same-sex marriage revealed his deep-seated **homophobia**.

#### ridicule

n. speech or behavior that makes fun of or mocks someone or something; teasing, sarcasm, or scornful remarks that are intended to belittle or humiliate; (verb) to mock, criticize, or make fun of someone or something in a scornful or derisive way

synonym: derision, mockery, satire

(1) public **ridicule**, (2) **ridicule** at his expense The **ridicule** from his classmates made him feel embarrassed and ashamed.

scorn

 a feeling of contempt or disdain for someone or something seen as unworthy or inferior; an expression of contempt or ridicule

synonym: contempt, disdain, disrespect

(1) treat with scorn,(2) expression of scornThe politician responded to the heckler with a look of scorn.

blessing

 a gift or favor from a higher power or force; an act or expression of approval, encouragement, or gratitude; something that brings happiness or good fortune

synonym: favor, benediction, boon

(1) count your **blessings**, (2) bestowed **blessings**Receiving support from his friends was a great **blessing** in his time of need.

imprison

v. to confine a person to a prison, a detention facility, or a place of involuntary confinement

execute

v. to kill someone, especially as a legal punishment; to carry out or perform an action, duty, etc.

### adjustment

n. a small change or movement made to something to improve it and achieve the desired resultsynonym: alteration, adaptation, modification

### background

 the details of a person's social heritage, such as family, vocational or educational experience; past information that is essential to understanding a situation or problem

synonym: ground, experience, backdrop

(1) a **background** color, (2) a criminal **background**The company's hiring criteria emphasize personality, not a person's **background**.

#### constant

*adj.* happening repeatedly or all the time *synonym*: ceaseless, stable, unchanging

(1) a **constant** wind, (2) a **constant** temperature **Constant** dropping wears away the stone.

### malign

 to speak or write about someone or something in a harmful or critical way; (adjective) evil or harmful in nature or influence

synonym: defame, vilify, (adjective) evil

(1) **malign** influence, (2) **malign** the politician in the media. The article **maligned** the company's reputation with false accusations.

#### presence

 the fact or state that someone or something exists, occurs, or is present

synonym: existence, actuality, fact

(1) the evidence of the **presence**, (2) his majestic **presence**The path to a solid online **presence** necessitates a high technical ability.

#### assimilate

v. to take in and understand information or ideas; to integrate

synonym: absorb, incorporate, integrate

(1) **assimilate** into society, (2) **assimilate** a language The immigrant struggled to **assimilate** into the new culture.

### complain

 to say dissatisfaction or annoyance about something or somebody

synonym: gripe, claim, denounce

(1) **complain** about a job, (2) call and **complain** frequently Our users are often **complaining** about the slow application.

### competition

 a situation in which someone is attempting to beat or outperform another

synonym: contest, match, fight

(1) the first round of the **competition**, (2) intraspecific **competition** 

Global **competition** is rising in virtually every industry.

#### infuse

v. to fill something with a particular quality, feeling, or influence; to imbue

synonym: instill, fill, permeate

(1) **infuse** with spirit, (2) **infuse** life with meaning She **infused** fresh herbs into the soup for added flavor.

### drip

v. to fall in drops or make it fall in drops; (noun) liquid or moisture that falls in drops

synonym: drop, drizzle, trickle

(1) **drip** liquid, (2) **drip** from the vicious wound Water is **dripping** from the faucet.

#### absorb

v. to take in a fluid or other substance gradually

*synonym*: consume, soak, ingest

(1) **absorb** energy, (2) **absorb** a shock

The sponge **absorbs** water well.

### slight

adj. very small in degree or amount

synonym: feeble, nuanced, subtle

(1) feel a **slight** concern, (2) **slight** increase

We made **slight** modifications to reflect the views of both sides.

#### intimidation

n. the act of instilling fear or anxiety in someone, often to make them feel inferior or submissive; the use of threats or coercion to deter someone from taking a certain course of action

synonym: frightening, bullying, harassment

(1) act of **intimidation**, (2) fear of **intimidation**Using **intimidation** tactics in the workplace is unacceptable and should not be tolerated.

#### sneer

v. to show contempt or ridicule for someone or something through a facial expression or tone of voice; (noun) a contemptuous or scornful smile or remark

synonym: mock, deride, ridicule

(1) **sneer** openly at him, (2) **sneer** hatefully She **sneered** at his attempts to impress her.

### occasionally

adv. now and then; sometimes but not oftensynonym: periodically, sometimes, from time to time

(1) **occasionally** dine with friends, (2) **occasionally** change the routine

She still **occasionally** writes a short romance novel.

### intrinsically

adv. from the inherent nature or quality of something or arising from within

synonym: inherently, essentially, fundamentally

(1) **intrinsically** motivated, (2) **intrinsically** valuable The kindness of strangers is **intrinsically** rewarding, even when no reward is expected.

disorder

 an untidy state or a lack of organization; a physical condition or illness that causes problems with how a section of the body or brain functions

synonym: chaos, disturbance, disease

(1) the files are in complete **disorder**, (2) people with bipolar **disorder** 

The doctor prescribed some medicine for the mental **disorder**.

#### celibate

adj. abstaining from sexual relations, typically for religious reasons; unmarried or single

synonym: abstinent, unmarried, chaste

(1) celibate life, (2) celibate priest

As a monk, he took a vow of **celibate** and refrained from any romantic relationships.

### pulpit

 a raised platform or lectern in a church or synagogue from which a member of the clergy delivers a sermon or religious address

*synonym*: soapbox, podium, lectern

(1) church **pulpit**, (2) standing at the **pulpit** 

The preacher delivered a sermon from the **pulpit**, inspiring the congregation.

#### scrawl

v. to write or draw something in a careless or untidy way, often with difficulty or haste

synonym: scribble, scratch, squiggle

scrawl my signature, (2) scrawl a message
 She quickly scrawled her phone number on paper before

running out the door.

### graffiti

*n.* writing or drawings scribbled, scratched, or sprayed illicitly on a wall or other surface in a public place

synonym: street art, tagging, vandalism

(1) graffiti art, (2) graffiti tag

The city spent a lot of money cleaning up the **graffiti** on the buildings downtown.

#### steel

 a strong metal alloy made up of iron with typically a few tenths of a percent of carbon used for making things that need a strong structure *synonym*: iron

(1) magnetic steel, (2) steel beam

This bridge is the third largest **steel** bridge in the world.

#### talent

 a natural ability to be good at something; someone who has a natural ability to be good at something

synonym: endowment, aptitude, capability

(1) a person of diverse **talents**, (2) raw **talent**Numerous great professional sports **talents** have come from this city.

### prefer

v. to like, choose, or want one thing or person better than another

synonym: choose, like, favor

(1) **prefer** physics to chemistry, (2) **prefer** a window seat The birds **prefer** open water areas with reeds around them.

#### harbor

 an area of water next to the coast where ships and boats are protected from rough water by piers, jetties, and other artificial structures; (verb) keep in one's possession

synonym: port, dock, pier

(1) a sheltered **harbor**, (2) **harbor** a resentment The tsunami swamped every boat in the **harbor**.

### animosity

 strong hostility or hatred towards someone or something, often resulting in conflict or ill-will

synonym: enmity, hostility, bitterness

(1) personal **animosity**, (2) deep-seated **animosity**The **animosity** between the two political parties has only grown stronger over the years.

### discomfort

 a feeling of being uncomfortable physically or mentally or being embarrassed; a slight pain

synonym: affliction, despair, ache

(1) endure **discomfort** and pain, (2) **discomfort** in the abdomen

He felt no **discomfort** as the dentist drilled his deadened tooth.

#### relation

the way two persons or groups of people feel and act toward one another

*synonym*: association, linkage, connection

(1) **relation** between cause and effect, (2) **relation** of inclusion

The industrial **relations** laws were passed with little to no alteration.

curl

to form or make something form into a curved or spiral shape; (noun) a round shape formed by a series of concentric circles

synonym: coil, curve, spiral

- (1) **curl** around street corners, (2) a **curl** of smoke The cat **curled** into a ball and went to sleep.
- to color a textile or hair by immersing it in a colored liquid or substance

synonym: color, tint, stain

(1) **dye** a T-shirt red, (2) **dye** patterns She **dyed** her hair purple for a change.

glean

to collect information, knowledge, etc., in small amounts and often with difficulty; to gather, as natural products

synonym: cull, collect, extract

(1) **glean** important information, (2) **glean** the fields He carefully interviewed the victims and tried to **glean** the details of the culprit.

### courtyard

an open space surrounded by buildings or walls, often in the center of a building or group of buildings

synonym: patio, garden, atrium

(1) quiet courtyard, (2) spacious courtyard

The hotel's beautiful **courtyard** was the perfect spot for a

#### church

 a building or institution dedicated to religious worship or activities; a Christian religious organization or denomination

synonym: chapel, cathedral, synagogue

(1) church bell, (2) small church

The **church** on the corner is hosting a free community meal tonight.

#### coronation

- n. a ceremony at which a person becomes king or queen synonym: crowning, enthronement, investiture
- (1) **coronation** ceremony, (2) the **coronation** robes The **coronation** of the new king was a grand event.

#### uncomfortable

adj. providing or feeling physical discomfort or slight pain synonym: comfortless, discomforting, painful

(1) an **uncomfortable** silence, (2) with an **uncomfortable** face

His abusive words made me uncomfortable.

### ordinary

- adj. not different, exceptional, or unexpected in any way, especially in quality, ability, size, or degreesynonym: mundane, prosaic, average
- (1) an **ordinary** school, (2) **ordinary** annual revenue The **ordinary** session of the Diet opened.

### annoying

adj. making someone feel slightly angrysynonym: aggravating, bothersome, irksome

(1) **annoying** banner ad, (2) **annoying** habit The phone call is an **annoying** interruption.

#### sake

- n. purpose; reason for wanting something donesynonym: purpose, reason, interest
- (1) for your own **sake**, (2) for the **sake** of argument He got a new job for the **sake** of his family.

#### decorate

v. to add beauty or distinction to something by the addition of ornament, art, etc

*synonym*: adorn, embellish, beautify

(1) decorate a wall, (2) decorate for Christmas

They **decorated** the room with balloons and streamers for the birthday party.

#### entirely

adv. completely

synonym: completely, fully, totally

(1) **entirely** satisfied with the meal, (2) he was **entirely** to blame

Later, his claim was found to be entirely false.

#### manifest

v. to show something such as feeling, attitude, quality, etc. clearly through signs or actions

synonym: exhibit, make plain, demonstrate

(1) manifest as the word, (2) manifest displeasure

The Prime Minister manifested his regret for his neighbors

### attempt

 an act or effort of trying to do something, especially something difficult

synonym: endeavor, effort, try

### phobia

an extreme or irrational fear of a particular object,
 person, situation, or activity; a type of anxiety disorder

synonym: fear, dread, terror

(1) **phobia** treatment, (2) social **phobia** 

She has a **phobia** of spiders and always avoids them.

#### cower

 to crouch or curl up in fear or apprehension; to shrink or recoil from something threatening, usually physically or mentally

synonym: crouch, tremble, cringe

(1) **cower** in fear, (2) **cower** under pressure

The actress **cowered** in humiliation as the audience booed her performance.

#### **lesbian**

a woman who is attracted romantically and sexually to other women

synonym: gay woman, female homosexual, tribade

(1) **lesbian** love, (2) **lesbian** relationship

The **lesbian** couple was denied the right to marry due to the conservative laws in their state.

#### bisexual

adj. attracted to both men and women; capable of having a romantic or sexual attraction to both men and women

synonym: bi, pansexual, omnisexual

(1) **bisexual** orientation, (2) **bisexual** lifestyle

She described herself as **bisexual**, having been in relationships with male and female partners.

#### brave

adj. showing courage or fearlessness in the face of danger, difficulty, or adversity

synonym: courageous, valiant, heroic

(1) brave soldier, (2) brave decision

The **brave** firefighter rescued the family from the burning building.

#### irrational

adj. not based on, or not using reason or clear thinking;(mathematics) a real number that cannot be expressed as the ratio of two integers

synonym: illogical, ludicrous, senseless

(1) an **irrational** request, (2) **irrational** numbers They continued to endure **irrational** treatment by the dictatorship.

#### fetch

v. to go and bring back something or someone; to retrieve or obtain something

synonym: retrieve, bring, get

(1) fetch the mail, (2) fetch a ball

#### tide

 the cyclical rise and fall of sea level caused by the moon's gravitational pull

synonym: ripple, surge, swell

(1) tide cycle, (2) ride the tide of change

### parallel

 adj. being everywhere equidistant and not intersecting; of or relating to the simultaneous performance of multiple operations

synonym: aligned, side-by-side, similar

(1) a parallel case, (2) parallel processing

He walked a road **parallel** to the railroad.

### argument

 a set of statements or reasons used to support or refute a proposition or theory; a verbal or physical fight or dispute

synonym: debate, discourse, discussion

(1) a blazing **argument**, (2) the **argument** against capital punishment

The **argument** between the two sides over the proposed policy was heated.

#### decriminalize

v. to eliminate or reduce the criminal penalties associated with an act or behavior; to make legal or permissible something that was previously outlawed or punishable by law

synonym: legalize, decriminalization, depenalize

(1) **decriminalize** abortion, (2) **decriminalize** public drunkenness

Many activists are pushing for laws to **decriminalize** marijuana use.

#### homosexual
