## persuade

 to convince or induce someone to do something by presenting a reason or argument; to sway or influence someone's decision or opinion

synonym: convince, influence, sway

#### moth

- an insect with wings similar to a butterfly that travels at night and is attracted to light

#### larva

the immature free-living form of insect or an animal,
 which at hatching from the egg, is fundamentally unlike its parent and must metamorphose

synonym: caterpillar, grub, maggot

(1) larva of a butterfly, (2) a moth larva

The butterfly emerged from its **larva** stage.

#### tradition

 a belief, custom, or way of doing something that has been passed down from generation to generation within a group or society

synonym: custom, practice, ritual

(1) a **tradition** of a culture, (2) against **tradition**It is a **tradition** in many families to have a big Thanksgiving dinner with all their relatives.

## disbelief

 the feeling of not being able to believe or accept that something is true or real

synonym: doubt, mistrust, incredulity

(1) **disbelief** in the authority, (2) ask in **disbelief** His reaction was one of complete **disbelief**.

#### urban

adj. relating to or located in a town or citysynonym: metropolitan, civic

(1) **urban** planning, (2) **urban** property owners
Only a small number of **urban** utilities offer sanitation services.

#### educated

adj. having received a high standard of educationsynonym: knowledgeable, erudite, enlightened

(1) educated adult, (2) educated speech

Excellent speech is a characteristic of an **educated** man.

#### broach

v. to introduce a sensitive or difficult subject for discussion; to bring up a topic for consideration or debate; to open or tap a cask, barrel, or container, especially one that contains alcohol or a beverage

synonym: raise, introduce, bring up

(1) broach a cask, (2) broach the subjectI need to broach the topic of restructuring with my boss.

## mighty

adj. very large, powerful, or strong synonym: potent, powerful, robust

(1) **mighty** works, (2) struck a **mighty** blow Only the **mighty** God has the power to brighten this dark land.

## touchy

adj. easily offended or upset, or sensitivesynonym: sensitive, easily offended

touchy subject, (2) a little touchy personality
 touchy situation required careful handling to avoid further conflict.

#### affair

 event, situation, or subject that is significant from a political or public perspective; a secretive or illicit sexual relationship

synonym: matter, incident, fling

(1) current affairs, (2) domestic affairsSome critics say this exhibition will be a big affair.

#### environment

 the natural world such as air, water, and land in which humans, animals, and plants live

synonym: atmosphere, surroundings, climate

environment affairs, (2) chaotic environment
 Every human is responsible for taking care of the Earth's environment.

#### vouch

 to assert or guarantee the truth or accuracy of something; to provide a personal recommendation or endorsement

*synonym*: confirm, validate, attest

(1) **vouch** for the authenticity, (2) **vouch** for the accuracy of the data

I can vouch for her honesty and integrity.

#### delicious

adj. exceptionally pleasing to taste or smell

synonym: appetizing, mouthwatering, delectable

(1) **delicious** breeze, (2) variety of **delicious** foods

We could grill the meat in a **delicious** way.

#### silent

adj. without any or little sound

synonym: quiet, hushed, mute

(1) **silent** reading, (2) give **silent** consent

The politician remained **silent** despite intense media scrutiny.

#### backward

adv. at, to, or toward the direction or place that is behind or rear

synonym: back, rearward, in reverse

(1) walk backward, (2) backward angle

She falls over **backward** when she sees her mother-in-law.

#### nod

 to lower and raise one's head, sometimes several times, as to show approval, agreement, greeting, or confirmation

synonym: respond, acknowledge, greet

(1) **nod** at each other, (2) **nod** courteously

She **nodded** quietly in response to the question.

#### wit

 the ability to say or write things or ideas in a clever and humorous way

*synonym*: humor, comedy, funniness

(1) the wit of man, (2) full of wit

He has the wit to keep talking about this topic.

#### sham

 something that is not as good or true as it seems to be and is intended to deceive people; a person who pretends to be something they are not

*synonym*: bogus, counterfeit, fraudulent

(1) a sham battle, (2) turn out to be all sham

The data he prepared was completely **sham**.

#### inferior

adj. lower in rank, status, or qualitysynonym: lower, subordinate, secondary

(1) an inferior poet, (2) inferior quality

The new employee's work was **inferior** to that of the experienced workers in the team.

#### subhuman

adj. less than human in nature, quality, or dignity; regarded as inferior to or unworthy of being fully human

synonym: inferior, substandard, primitive

(1) **subhuman** conditions, (2) **subhuman** species

The **subhuman** treatment of prisoners at the detention center was shocking and inhumane.

## out-of-the-way

adj. situated far from the main sources of activity or population; remote or secluded

The little cafe was **out-of-the-way** but finding it was worth the extra effort because the food was delicious.

## icky

adj. unpleasant or uncomfortable; causing a feeling of disgust or revulsion

The food left in the fridge for too long had an **icky** smell.

#### insect

- any small creature that has six legs and a body divided into three sections
- (1) **insect** antenna, (2) **insect** biology

These **insects** are more prevalent above a certain latitude.

#### extend

- v. to broaden in scope, range, or area synonym: prolong, lengthen, advance
- (1) **extend** the warranty, (2) **extend** a line Her visit will **extend** from Monday to Friday.

#### mushroom

 a type of fungus that grows on dead or decaying organic matter and typically has a stalk and an umbrella-shaped cap

synonym: fungus, toadstool

(1) **mushroom** spores, (2) **mushroom** cultivation

The **mushroom** risotto was delicious, but I couldn't identify all the mushrooms in it.

cult

 a small religious group, especially one that is not part of a larger religion and that is regarded as outside the norm; followers of an exclusive system of beliefs and practices

synonym: sect, faith, religion

(1) cult members, (2) cult's practices

The **cult** leader promised his followers that they would achieve enlightenment if they followed his teachings.

## omnipresent

- adj. present everywhere at the same time; ubiquitous; pervading or encompassing all things or placessynonym: ubiquitous, pervasive, everywhere
- (1) **omnipresent** influence, (2) **omnipresent** threat The internet has made information access **omnipresent**.

## trigger

- v. to make something happen suddenly; to cause something such as a device, machine, etc. to function synonym: activate, spark, drive
- (1) **trigger** a biochemical response, (2) **trigger** inflation The incident **triggered** a political controversy.

caste

- n. a social class or group, typically determined by birth or occupation, that has a particular status in a societysynonym: class, social group, status group
- military caste, (2) caste-based discrimination
   He was born into a lower caste and faced discrimination throughout his life.

## vegetarian

- a person who does not eat meat or fish, or often any animal products, for health or religious reasons
- (1) eat a **vegetarian** diet, (2) a strict **vegetarian** This restaurant has **vegetarian** dishes as well.

#### schoolmaster

- n. a male teacher, especially one who teaches in a school;a person who is seen as an authority in a particular fieldsynonym: teacher, instructor, educator

## appoint

#### crab

 a sea creature with two large claws and a flattened back (e.g., blue crab or king crab); a sour or grumpy person who is prone to complaining or criticizing

synonym: crustacean, shellfish, crusty

(1) crab cakes, (2) crab legs

I ordered a plate of fresh **crab** at the seafood restaurant.

sin

the offense against a religious or moral law or against
 God

synonym: misdeed, guilt, wrong

(1) forgive a **sin**, (2) **sin** of omission

Some overzealous environmentalists claim celebrities are committing carbon dioxide **sins**.

## government

 the group of people with authority to control a country or state

*synonym*: administration, regime, state

(1) government bureaucracy, (2) government funding

The federal **government** is planning to increase taxes for the next fiscal year.

#### nutrition

 the substances or the process that organisms take into their bodies as food for their growth and health

synonym: alimentation, nourishment, sustenance

(1) **nutrition** condition, (2) **nutrition** intake

This food contains all the **nutrition** your dog requires.

## fluffy

adj. soft and light, often with a texture that resembles feathers or fur

synonym: soft, feathery, puffy

(1) fluffy clouds, (2) fluffy blanket

The kitten had **fluffy** fur that was soft to the touch.

## millet

- a tiny seed of any of several annual cereal types of grass used as food, mainly to manufacture flour and to feed birds and animals
- increasing millet harvests, (2) cooking millet
   The primary crop harvested during autumn is millet.

## nonprofit

adj. not established for commercial profit

*synonym*: charitable

(1) a **nonprofit** organization, (2) **nonprofit** agency Our law firm also focuses on **nonprofit** activities.

#### diet

n. the food and drink that a person, animal, or community eats and drinks regularly; a legislative assembly in certain countries, for example, Japan

*synonym*: food, dietary

(1) eat a vegetarian **diet**, (2) **Diet** approval A balanced **diet** is more important for health than supplements.

#### chart

 a visual display of information such as a diagram, lists of figures, etc.; a map designed to assist navigation by air or sea synonym: diagram, graph, map

(1) a weather chart, (2) a statistical chart

This pie **chart** represents our market share.

## pregnant

adj. having a baby or young animal developing in the uterussynonym: expectant

(1) needs of **pregnant** women, (2) a silence **pregnant** with suspense

She vacated the position when she got **pregnant**.

#### afford

- to have enough money or time to be able to buy or do something
- (1) **afford** to buy a new car, (2) **afford** a high travel cost He cannot **afford** a holiday.

## religion

 a deep conviction in a supernatural power that controls human destiny

synonym: faith, creed, belief

(1) **religion** sociology, (2) freedom of **religion**Their **religion** strictly prohibits them from drinking or gambling.

#### random

adj. made, done, or happening without method, conscious decision, or any regular pattern

synonym: incidental, arbitrary, unanticipated

(1) a random choice, (2) bombs fell at randomTo find drunk drivers, police conduct random tests.

## employee

- n. a person who is hired to work for a business or organization in exchange for wages or salary; a worker synonym: worker, staff, personnel
- (1) **employee** benefits, (2) **employee** evaluation The **employee** handbook outlines the rules and regulations that all employees must follow.

## disappear

- v. to cease to exist or be visible
- synonym: fade, evaporate, vanish
- (1) **disappear** without a trace, (2) **disappear** after a week They watched the train **disappear** into the distance.

#### communal

adj. belonging to or used by a group rather than individuals; for common use

synonym: collaborative, combined, collective

## economy

n. the system by which a country or region produces manages, and distributes goods and services, including the money and finances involved in these activities; (of an airline) the lowest-priced, most basic option for seating in commercial travel

synonym: finance, trade, business

(1) economy of scale, (2) economy class

The **economy** of the country is struggling due to the recent political instability.

# entirely

adv. completely

synonym: completely, fully, totally

(1) **entirely** satisfied with the meal, (2) he was **entirely** to blame

Later, his claim was found to be entirely false.

## staple

adj. essential, crucial, or regularly used synonym: essential, fundamental, pivotal

(1) staple commodities, (2) staple crop

Rice and beans are a **staple** food in many cultures.

## sorghum

- 1. a type of grain grown in tropical countries
- (1) sorghum grain, (2) seeds of sorghum

**Sorghum** is an important food grain in this country.

#### bulb

- a rounded underground storage organ of some plants from which the plant grows; the rounded part of a cylindrical structure; electric lamp consisting of a glass ball
- (1) wet- bulb thermometer, (2) a lily bulb The light **bulb** has burned out.

tub

a large, deep, round container, typically made of metal n. or plastic, used for washing or soaking things, especially clothes or a person's body

synonym: bathtub, bath, basin

legume

a plant of the pea family, whose seed is often edible and used as a source of protein

synonym: bean, pea, lentil

cab

a taxi or other vehicle that can be hired for transportation; the compartment from which a vehicle, such as a train or truck, is driven

synonym: taxi, hack, cabriolet

(1) taxi cab, (2) yellow cab

I hailed a **cab** to take me to the airport.

colossal

- adj. extremely large and impressive synonym: gigantic, huge, enormous
- (1) colossal statue, (2) a colossal success The new building is truly **colossal**, towering over the surrounding buildings.

#### modern

adj. of or belonging to the present time or recent timessynonym: contemporary, stylish, current

(1) **modern** poetry, (2) pre- **modern** agricultural society Their headquarters are in a **modern** skyscraper.

#### stick

to put something, usually a sharp object, into something; to restrict yourself to doing or using one certain thing and not change; (noun) a thin piece of wood or other material

synonym: pierce, adhere, stay

(1) **stick** a key in a lock, (2) fire **stick** 

You **stick** a bill in the change machine, and the coins pop out.

#### wheat

 a cereal plant that is the most important kind grown in temperate countries, the grain of which is ground to make flour for bread, pasta, pastry, etc

synonym: grain, cereal

(1) harvesting wheat, (2) wheat crop

The farmer grew wheat on his land.

#### diabetes

- a medical condition in which the body cannot produce enough insulin to control the glucose levels in the blood
- (1) juvenile **diabetes**, (2) **diabetes** patient My father was tested for **diabetes**.

#### sap

 to gradually weaken or drain strength, energy, or resources; to undermine or impair someone's confidence or morale

synonym: weaken, exhaust, drain

(1) sap flow, (2) sap strength

The disease has **sapped** all his energy, and he can barely get out of bed.

#### shellfish

 water creatures that live in shells, especially one of the types that can be eaten

synonym: clam, mollusk

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# (1) shellfish allergy, (2) edible shellfishShellfish can cause allergic reactions in certain people.

#### mollusk

n. a soft-bodied invertebrate with no internal skeleton, such as a snail, clam, or octopus

synonym: oyster, clam, snail

As a child, I loved collecting seashells and had many mollusks.

## endangered

adj. at risk of extinction because it is facing significant threats

*synonym*: at risk, threatened, vulnerable

(1) **endangered** species, (2) **endangered** ecosystem The government has implemented policies to protect the habitat of **endangered** animals.

#### surround

- v. to be all around something or somebody synonym: encircle, encompass, envelop
- (1) **surround** a town, (2) a stone wall **surrounds** the palace On three sides, mountains **surround** the settlement.

## complexity

 n. the state or quality of being complicated or intricate and difficult to understand

synonym: intricacy, sophistication, elaboration

(1) cognitive **complexity**, (2) **complexity** theory

The project's **complexity** made it difficult for the team to complete it on time.

## ecology

- the study of the relationships between living organisms, including humans, and their physical environment
- (1) science of **ecology**, (2) the **ecology** of the island Many companies are now enthusiastically embracing the knowledge of **ecology** for sustainable development.

## phenomenon

something that exists and can be perceptible, especially one that is not fully understood

*synonym*: marvel, wonder, splendor

(1) natural **phenomenon**, (2) historical **phenomenon** A rainbow is a natural **phenomenon**.

#### crucial

adj. extremely vital or necessary

synonym: essential, pivotal, vital

(1) **crucial** information, (2) a **crucial** issue for women The revitalization of technology companies is **crucial** to the country's growth.

## cognitive

*adj.* of or relating to mental processes of understanding *synonym*: perceivable, mind, mental

(1) improve **cognitive** function, (2) research on **cognitive** psychology

His **cognitive** faculties were getting worse because of a lack of sleep.

#### dissonance

- n. a lack of harmony or agreement between people or things; a harsh or discordant combination of soundssynonym: conflict, disharmony, disagreement
- (1) cognitive **dissonance**, (2) musical **dissonance**The **dissonance** between the two melodies created a sense of tension in the music.

#### distort

v. to change something's shape, appearance, or sound so that it appears weird or unclear

synonym: fudge, deform, contort

(1) distort the facts, (2) distort the economy

Economists contend that taxes **distort** consumer behavior in general.

#### versatile

adj. able to do many things in different fields; having many talents

synonym: adaptable, protean, universal

(1) provide a **versatile** solution, (2) a **versatile** writer He's a **versatile** actor who has acted in various parts.

## abundantly

adv. in large quantities; plentifullysynonym: plentifully, copiously, lavishly

(1) **abundantly** clear, (2) **abundantly** available The policy change resulted in an **abundantly** positive outcome for the company.

## spare

adj. additional to what is necessary for ordinary use; (verb) to give time, money, space, etc. to someonesynonym: extra, excess, (verb) afford

(1) **spare** parts, (2) **spare** cost

I made plans to spend my spare time beneficially.

## recognize

v. to acknowledge or realize something or someone; to identify, remember, or become aware of something that was previously known or encountered

synonym: acknowledge, identify, admit

(1) **recognize** talent, (2) **recognize** achievement It's important to **recognize** your strengths and weaknesses.

liquor

- n. an alcoholic beverage that is distilled rather than fermented, such as whiskey or gin; alcohol, in general synonym: alcohol, spirits, booze
- (1) liquor store, (2) craft liquor

She poured a glass of her favorite **liquor** and enjoyed it slowly.

#### arrest

v. to take into custody

*synonym*: capture, detain, imprison

(1) arrest the thief, (2) arrest the progress

A police officer has the authority to **arrest** a criminal.

dirt

 soil, dust, or any substance that makes a surface not clean; the part of the earth's surface consisting of humus and disintegrated rock synonym: filth, grime, muck

(1) dirt road, (2) dirt track

The garden was filled with **dirt** and needed to be tilled before planting.

#### starve

 to suffer or die from lack of food; to cause someone or something to suffer or die from lack of food; to deprive something of necessary nourishment or sustenance

synonym: famish, hunger

(1) **starve** for a victory, (2) **starve** to death If you don't eat soon, you're going to **starve**.

#### breath

the air that is taken into and expelled from your lungs;
 the process of taking into and expelling air from your lungs

*synonym*: air, puff, whiff

(1) hold your breath, (2) breath of windHe bated his breath when talking about this affair.

#### dual

adj. having two parts, aspects, or elements synonym: twofold, binary, double

(1) dual purpose, (2) dual nationality

This laptop has a **dual-core** processor, making it fast and efficient.

#### narrative

 a story or a description of a series of events or process of telling a story

synonym: the tale, chronology, annals

(1) **narrative** poetry, (2) personal **narrative**The **narrative** handles multiple plot lines and has unpredictable ends.

#### poverty

n. the condition of being extremely poorsynonym: deprivation, destitution, poorness

poverty alleviation, (2) the cycle of poverty
 Many studies have investigated the relationship between

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## poverty and academic achievement.

## heartrending

 adj. causing intense sorrow, grief, or anguish; deeply moving or distressing; capable of eliciting or arousing strong emotional responses

synonym: sad, grievous, poignant

(1) heartrending melody, (2) a heartrending story

The movie's **heartrending** ending left the audience in tears.

## famine

 a severe shortage of food, often caused by drought, war, or economic reasons

synonym: hunger, starvation, drought

(1) famine relief, (2) coal famine

The severe **famine** caused by the drought has left many people without food.

#### starvation

 a severe lack of food that leads to malnutrition and, ultimately, death

synonym: hunger, malnutrition, emaciation

(1) die of **starvation**, (2) **starvation** wages

The drought led to widespread starvation in the region.

#### survive

- v. to live or exist despite a dangerous event or period synonym: endure, persist, stay
- (1) **survive** a blizzard, (2) **survive** a plane crash These birds can only **survive** in temperate climates.

#### trash

n. discarded material, refuse, or waste

synonym: garbage, waste, refuse

(1) trash bin, (2) trash disposal site

The city is taking measures to reduce the amount of **trash** in the streets.

#### edible

*adj.* fit or safe to be eaten; able to be consumed as food *synonym*: esculent, comestible, digestible

(1) non- edible ingredients, (2) edible vegetables

I made sure to pick only **edible** mushrooms for our dinner.

#### stream

*n.* a small, narrow river; a continuous flow of something, such as liquid, gas, people, vehicles, etc.

Jet **streams** are the common name for air currents that form high in the atmosphere.

## overnight

adj. lasting for or occurring during one night; occurring or changing extremely quickly or suddenly; happening or being achieved in a short amount of time

synonym: all-night, sudden, immediate

The **overnight** package delivery arrived at my door this morning.

## snail

 a slow-moving mollusk with a spiral shell that it uses to protect its body

synonym: escargot, slug, whelk

(1) **snail** mail, (2) **snail** pace

The gardener found a **snail** slowly making its way through the lettuce patch.

#### shell

 hard outer covering or case of eggs, nuts, some seeds, and some animals

synonym: ammunition, armor, cover

(1) an egg shell, (2) a mollusk shell

The outermost electron **shell** determines the chemical properties of an atom.

#### trap

 a piece of equipment or hole for catching animals or people; (verb) to catch animals or people and prevent them from escaping

synonym: catch, snare, pinfall

(1) set a trap, (2) trap an animal

The enemy fell right into the **trap**.

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#### scratch

v. to cut or damage the surface of something or the skin with a sharp or pointed object

synonym: claw, rub, scrape

(1) **scratch** off a name, (2) **scratch** my signature Don't **scratch** your mosquito bites.

#### ancestor

- n. a person from whom one is descended; a forefathersynonym: forebear, forefather, progenitor
- (1) **ancestor** language, (2) earliest human **ancestor**My remote **ancestor** immigrated to the United States from Ireland in the 1800s.

## thrive

- v. to grow vigorously; to make steady progresssynonym: bloom, flourish, prosper

#### undo

v. to reverse the effect of an action or event, typically one that is recent or specific

synonym: reverse, retract, revoke

(1) **undo** changes, (2) **undo** a belt

I accidentally deleted the file, so can you undo that action?

#### trend

 a general direction in which something is changing or developing

synonym: direction, movement, tendency

(1) an international **trend**, (2) the **trend** away from television The oil price continued their downward **trend**.

reclaim

 to take back something previously lost, given, or paid, or ask to have it back

synonym: recoup, regain, retake

(1) **reclaim** a competitive position, (2) **reclaim** land from the sea

You may be entitled to **reclaim** some tax.

## lovingly

adv. in a manner showing deep affection or care; with fondness and warmth; in a way that expresses or suggests love

synonym: fondly, affectionately

(1) lovingly crafted, (2) lovingly prepared

She looked at him lovingly and knew he was the one for her.

## rhythm

 a strong regular repeated pattern of sounds, words, or musical notes that are used in music, poetry, and dancing

synonym: beat, cadence, tempo

(1) in samba **rhythm**, (2) irregular heart **rhythm** He beat out a jazz **rhythm** on the cajones.

## forebear

- n. an ancestor or a precursorsynonym: ancestor, predecessor, forefather
- (1) a **forebear** of one of the tribes, (2) **forebear** predecessor His **forebear** was one of the first settlers in the area.

## gratitude

- the quality of being thankful; readiness to show appreciation for and to return kindness
- synonym: appreciation, thankfulness, indebtedness

#### vary

v. to become different in terms of size, shape, etc.

synonym: alter, contrast, differ

#### cultivation
