confluence

integral

adj. necessary to make a whole complete; essential, or fundamental; combining with something else to form a whole; (noun, of mathematics) a fundamental concept in calculus that represents the area under a curve between two points on a graph

aspect

column

twist

flank

sew

escarpment

 a long, steep slope or cliff, typically separating two relatively level or more gently sloping areas, often formed by erosion or faulting

trash

n. discarded material, refuse, or waste

sunshine

symbiosis

algae

- A simple plant that grows in or near water and lacks typical leaves and roots

bacteria

n. single-celled or noncellular spherical or spiral or rod-shaped organisms that exist in large numbers in the air, water, and soil, and also in living and dead creatures and plants, and are often a cause of disease

synonym: microorganism, microbe

wastewater

 water that contains waste substances from homes, farms, factories, etc.

process

chemical

adj. relating to or connected with chemistry;

synonym: chemic, synthetic

coal

 a combustible black or brownish-black sedimentary rock that is found below the ground and burnt to produce heat

synonym: ember

(1) a **coal-fired** ship, (2) construction of new **coal** plants We combust **coal** and other fossil fuels to generate electricity.

purification

 the process of removing impurities, contaminants, or pollutants from something, often through a chemical or physical process; the act of cleansing or purging morally or spiritually

synonym: cleansing, refinement, filtering

The water **purification** system removed all contaminants and made the water safe to drink.

core

- n. the most essential or fundamental part of somethingsynonym: center, basis, heart

downstream

bay

 a part of the coast that is partially enclosed by land; a compartment or section of a ship or building

unbelievable

adj. beyond belief or understanding and extremely surprisingsynonym: unimaginable, incredible, fantastical

infrastructure

 the basic systems, services, or features that are necessary for an organization or country, such as transport and power supplies

synonym: foundation, framework

(1) IT infrastructure, (2) infrastructure cost

Aging societies tend to require huge costs for **infrastructure** maintenance.

struggle

v. to make a great effort to do something when it is difficult, or there are a lot of problems; to use force or violence to break away from restraint or constriction

synonym: toil, strive, compete

(1) **struggle** against discrimination, (2) **struggle** to get the job

He could not **struggle** against temptation.

displace

v. to force someone or something to leave their home or place of origin, especially as a result of conflict, natural disaster, or manipulation

synonym: evict, exile, remove

(1) **displace** workers, (2) **displace** the explosive power The construction of the new dam will **displace** hundreds of families living downstream.

develop

v. to grow or expand; to improve or refine through a process of progress and refinement, often to achieve greater sophistication or complexity; to elaborate or add detail to something that is in the process of being created

synonym: evolve, progress, advance

(1) **develop** a strategy, (2) **develop** a skill We must **develop** a new system to streamline our workflow and increase efficiency.

survive

- v. to live or exist despite a dangerous event or period synonym: endure, persist, stay
- (1) **survive** a blizzard, (2) **survive** a plane crash These birds can only **survive** in temperate climates.

stilted

adj. awkwardly formal or pompous; not natural or sincere synonym: formal, stiff, artificial

(1) **stilted** dialogue, (2) avoid **stilted** phrases

The conversation was **stilted** and awkward as if they didn't know each other very well.

navigate

v. to plan and direct the way that a ship, plane, etc. will travel, often by using a map

synonym: guide, helm, voyage

(1) **navigate** the Pacific, (2) **navigate** through a document Our knowledge helps **navigate** our clients successfully.

dugout

 a partially enclosed area or shelter often dug into the ground or located at ground level behind the benches, used for players or coaches in sports such as baseball, cricket, or field hockey

synonym: bench, shelter, dugout seat

(1) baseball dugout, (2) construction dugout

The baseball players retreated to the **dugout** after the inning was over.

canoe

- a narrow, light boat with pointy ends and no keel that is propelled by a paddle
- (1) canoe race, (2) make a canoe trip

After the accident, the police found an empty canoe.

royal

adj. relating to or belonging to the king or queen or a member of their family

synonym: imperial, noble, aristocratic

(1) a royal palace, (2) prince royal

She is willing to give up her position in the **royal** family to marry him.

mosque

- a Muslim place of worship that usually has a minaret (= slender tower with balconies)

surround

- v. to be all around something or somebody synonym: encircle, encompass, envelop

individual

- n. a single person or thing, as distinct from a group synonym: person, being, self
- (1) a private **individual**, (2) **individual** freedom
 As an **individual**, he had the right to make his own decisions and live his life as he saw fit.

paddock

 a small enclosed field or pasture, especially one used for grazing or exercising horses

synonym: enclosure, pen, corral

(1) paddock fencing, (2) grazing paddock

The horses were kept in the **paddock** while their stalls were being cleaned.

mangrove

- a tropical coastal tree or shrub that grows in saline soil and has prop roots that help to stabilize it

The **mangrove** trees are known for their ability to survive in saltwater and sandy soil.

reef

- a long chain or range of rocks or sand near the ocean's surface

lagoon

multiply

to add a number to itself a specified number of times; to increase or cause to increase very much in number or quantity

synonym: boost, amplify, reproduce

(1) multiply 5 and 6, (2) multiply about hundredfold **Multiply** a number by itself twice.

industrial

adj. of or relating to or resulting from industry synonym: manufacturing, mechanical

(1) beginning of the **industrial** revolution, (2) **industrial** alcohol

Industrial design has become more focused on human nature aspect than ever before.

aquaculture

the cultivation of aquatic organisms such as fish, seaweed, and shellfish for human consumption, as well as for environmental conservation and research purposes

synonym: fish farming, mariculture, hydroponics

- (1) aquaculture industry, (2) sustainable aquaculture Fish farming is a form of **aquaculture** that has recently gained popularity.
- a strong indication or likelihood of harm, danger, or adverse consequences; an expression of intent to inflict harm or injury on someone or something, often made as a means of coercion or intimidation

ecosystem

- all the plants and living creatures in an area and the way they affect each other and the environment

threat

biodiversity

- the number and variety of plants and animals that exist in a particular area or the world and make a balanced environment

crazy

bushfire

 a large outdoor fire that burns out of control, typically in a wildland area, and is often caused by drought, heat, lightning, or human activities

surrounding

adj. that is near or around, or closely encircling something synonym: circumferent, encircling, neighboring

carbon

 a chemical element that can be found in pure form as diamond or graphite, and it is also an essential part of coal and oil and is found in all plants and animals (1) carbon dioxide, (2) carbon emission

Trees absorb **carbon** dioxide and give off oxygen.

emission

n. the act of production or sending out gas, heat, light, etc.synonym: emanation, radiation, discharge

(1) global **emissions** of greenhouse gases, (2) the **emission** of light

There are five distinct **emissions** at five unique wavelengths.

viral

adj. relating to or caused by a virus

fight viral infections, (2) detect a viral code

transmission
