peaceful

adj. not involving violence, conflict, or war

synonym: friendly, pacific, amicable

Plutonium has limited **peaceful** applications.

grizzly

 a large North American bear species, often with greyish or brownish fur; a person who has streaks of grey or white hair

synonym: bear, ursus, bruin

(1) **grizzly** size, (2) **grizzly** encounter

The hiker stumbled upon a **grizzly** bear in the woods and quickly retreated.

cub

 a young of certain carnivorous mammals such as lion, bear, wolf, etc.; an awkward, rude, and inexperienced boy

synonym: young, male child, boy

(1) a tiger cub, (2) the arrival of a cub

The **cub** reporter covered the murder case for the first time.

intense

adj. (especially of a feeling) very strong; extremely sharp or severe

synonym: extreme, fierce, harsh

(1) **intense** heat, (2) develop **intense** itching

That statement by the prime minister drew **intense** international criticism.

awesome

adj. inspiring fear, admiration, or respect; very good, nice, fun, etc.

synonym: miraculous, marvelous, astounding

(1) **awesome** mental faculty, (2) have an **awesome** birthday

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There is a lot of **awesome** nature and food in Hawaii.

rambunctious

- adj. marked by uncontrollable exuberance or high spirits;boisterous and unruly; difficult to control or restrainsynonym: boisterous, rowdy, unruly
- (1) **rambunctious** behavior, (2) **rambunctious** children The **rambunctious** puppies played in the yard until they fell asleep.

adoption

- n. the action or fact of legally taking another's child as one's own; the act of accepting with approvalsynonym: fostering, acceptance, custody
- (1) **adoption** assistance, (2) the **adoption** of a plan
 The **adoption** process can be long and difficult, but it is worth it for the love of a child.

conclude

 to come to an end or close; to reach a judgment or opinion by reasoning

synonym: complete, finish, decide

(1) **conclude** a meeting, (2) **conclude** that he is healthy We **concluded** a cease-fire.

illegal

- adj. not allowed by lawsynonym: banned, prohibited, illicit
- (1) **illegal** drugs, (2) child of **illegal** immigrants The customs agents seized the **illegal** shipment.

murmur

v. to say something very quietly; to complain about somebody or something under one's breath

synonym: burble, gurgle, mutter

(1) **murmur** at low wages, (2) **murmur** a greeting He always **murmurs** at the ill-treatment.

stereotype

- a fixed and unvarying idea or image that people have about what someone or something is like, but which is often not true in reality and may cause hurt and offense
- (1) avoid stereotype, (2) negative stereotypes

Changing **stereotypes** about LGBTQ requires considerable effort.

relative

adj. considered and evaluated through comparison with something else

synonym: comparative, proximate, congeneric

(1) a remote relative, (2) relative factors

Most countries prohibit sexual activity between certain close relatives.

racial

adj. of or related to the race (= classification of humans into groups based on physical traits or social relations)

synonym: ethnic, tribal, ethnical

(1) **racial** prejudice, (2) **racial** and ethnic backgrounds A minor **racial** conflict later led to a civil war.

engaging

adj. attracting, pleasant, or charming

synonym: alluring, interesting, engrossing

(1) **engaging** story, (2) an **engaging** smile She was disbarred for her **engaging** in fraud.

distance

n. the amount of space between two points, measured in units such as miles, meters, or kilometers; the extent, scope, or range between two things, such as distance or emotional distance

synonym: space, gap, span

(1) driving distance, (2) social distance

The marathon runner covered a long **distance** in a short amount of time.

suffer

v. to experience pain, distress, or hardship; to undergo or endure something painful or unpleasant

synonym: endure, undergo, tolerate

agonism

- the theory or practice of engaging in competitive or conflictual relationships or interactions to promote the progress or improve outcomes

medical

adj. relating to the treatment of illness or injuries; relating to the practice of medicine

warlike

 adj. characterized by a tendency toward or readiness for war or aggression; belligerent or hostile in manner

synonym: martial, bellicose, combative

The **warlike** imagery depicted on the temple walls was meant to inspire warriors to fight bravely.

stance

 a way of thinking about something, especially expressed publicly; attitude or position of a standing person or animal

synonym: attitude, standpoint, viewpoint

(1) change her **stance**, (2) the batting **stance**He continued to support her political **stance**.

context

 n. the circumstances, facts, or conditions that surround a particular event, situation, or statement and that give it meaning

synonym: background, setting, environment

(1) historical context, (2) legal context

It's important to understand the **context** of a situation before making a decision.

agon

 a contest or competition, typically one in which participants exert themselves physically or mentally to achieve victory or surpass others

synonym: struggle, conflict, fight

agony

extreme physical or mental pain or suffering, often prolonged or intense

synonym: anguish, torment, suffering

appropriate

adj. suitable or proper in the circumstances; fitting

symptom

 any sensation or change in body or mind that is experienced by a patient and is associated with a particular disease

synonym: sign, manifestation, syndrome

The patient displays a **symptom** of a side effect.

identify

 to recognize someone or something and say or prove who or what they are

synonym: determine, specify, recognize

(1) **identify** handwriting, (2) **identify** gene sequences I will introduce you to how to **identify** the leading causes of the malfunction.

inverse

adj. opposite in order, nature, or effect; reversed; reciprocal *synonym*: opposite, reverse, contrary

(1) **inverse** function, (2) **inverse** matrix

The **inverse** relationship between price and demand is well-known in economics.

disagree

- v. to have or express a different opinion, idea, etc. synonym: discord, oppose, dissent
- (1) **disagree** about a particular issue, (2) **disagree** with a plan

I disagree for reasons already stated above.

recognize

v. to acknowledge or realize something or someone; to identify, remember, or become aware of something that was previously known or encountered

synonym: acknowledge, identify, admit

relation

 the way two persons or groups of people feel and act toward one another

synonym: association, linkage, connection

(1) **relation** between cause and effect, (2) **relation** of inclusion

The industrial **relations** laws were passed with little to no alteration.

conversation

n. an informal talk between two or more people to exchange their views, ideas, information, etc.

synonym: chat, discussion, dialogue

settlement

n. an official agreement that brings an argument to a close; the process of establishing permanent residence in a place.

synonym: agreement, accommodation, colonization

impeach

 to bring formal charges against a public official for misconduct in office

synonym: charge, accuse, claim

bet

v. to risk money on the result of an event or a competition, such as a race or game, to get more money; to have faith or confidence in something

synonym: stake, wager, gamble

strained

adj. tight, tense, or stretched; under pressure or stress; characterized by a lack of ease or naturalness

synonym: tense, tight, forced

tragic

adj. causing great sadness or suffering; very unfortunate synonym: calamitous, disastrous, catastrophic

- a serious topic,

trivial

adj. of little value or importancesynonym: insignificant, minor, unimportant

(1) a **trivial** man, (2) for **trivial** reasons

The problem seemed **trivial** initially, but it became a significant issue.

strategy

 a detailed plan of action designed to achieve a long-term or overall goal.

synonym: approach, procedure, scenario

(1) military strategy,(2) develop a strategyOur plan includes a comprehensive marketing strategy.

cultivate

- v. to prepare and foster land for growing crops or plants synonym: boost, foster, nurture
- (1) **cultivate** a field, (2) **cultivate** relationships University is a great place to **cultivate** our minds and expertise.

deliberately

adv. done in an intentional or slow and careful manner synonym: intentionally, knowingly, willfully

adv. in a planned or intended waysynonym: knowingly, calculatedly, deliberately

soil

approve

cisgender

evangelical

Christ

perception

adj. having or showing a kindly or tender nature; soft and mild

synonym: mild, delicate, soft

faith

gentle

reject

v. to refuse to accept, consider, or use something or someone

synonym: decline, turn down, repudiate

(1) **reject** the proposal, (2) **reject** all imperfect merchandise The company **rejected** the job candidate's application due to a lack of experience.

gender

n. the range of characteristics of femininity and masculinity and differentiating between them, especially when considering social and cultural differences rather than differences in biology

synonym: sexuality

(1) **gender-blind** policies, (2) dual **gender**

Cultural norms strongly influence **gender** expectations.

fluid

- n. a substance that can flow and is not solid synonym: liquid, aqua, sap
- (1) plenty of **fluids**, (2) **fluid** assets

transgender

adj. relating to or denoting a person whose gender identity does not correspond to that person's biological sex assigned at birth

argue

v. to express differing opinions or points of view, often in a heated or contentious manner; to present a case or reasoning to persuade or convince others

synonym: debate, dispute, quarrel

(1) argue a case, (2) argue passionately

The couple began to **argue** over which restaurant to go to for dinner.

convinced

 adj. completely certain about something; having a strong belief or conviction in a particular religion

synonym: confident, positive, indoctrinated

(1) **convinced** of the idea, (2) **convinced** criminal The public is **convinced** that the prime minister has committed fraud.

coequal

adj. being equal in rank, importance, or value

synonym: equal, equivalent, balanced

(1) coequal responsibility, (2) coequal member

The **coequal** partnership between the two companies allowed for a successful merger.

refuse

v. to show that one is not willing to do or accept something synonym: turn down, deny, decline

(1) refuse a request, (2) refuse the company

My initial reaction was to refuse.

prefer

v. to like, choose, or want one thing or person better than another

synonym: choose, like, favor

(1) **prefer** physics to chemistry, (2) **prefer** a window seat The birds **prefer** open water areas with reeds around them.

pronoun

- n. a word that takes the place of a noun in a sentence,such as "he," "she," "they," or "it"
- (1) **pronoun** usage, (2) possessive **pronoun** In English, personal **pronouns** such as "he," "she," and "they" can replace a person's name to avoid repetition.

honor

 high regard or great respect for someone; the quality of having and doing based on a keen sense of morality; (verb) to show respect towards someone

synonym: integrity, virtue, acclaim

(1) womanly honor,(2) honor our ancestorsI claim on my honor that it is true.

clay

 a natural, earthy material that is made up of very small particles of minerals and can be molded when wet and then fired to produce ceramics

synonym: ceramics, pottery, dirt

(1) **clay** animation, (2) soft **clay** ground The sculptor carefully molded the **clay** into the desired shape.

convert

v. to have a talk with someone; (adjective) reversed in order, relation, or action

synonym: alter, remake, transform

(1) **convert** fat into energy, (2) **convert** base 10 to base 16 I want to **convert** my sadness into strength.

absolutely

- *adv.* without restriction or limitation; completely or utterly *synonym*: completely, utterly, definitely
- (1) **absolutely** against, (2) **absolutely** obsessed with the girl

Clay

I am **absolutely** opposed to his idea because of morality.

rigid

adj. extremely strict and difficult to change or adapt; incapable of or resistant to bending

synonym: strict, inflexible, stringent

(1) rigid rules, (2) rigid structure

He was unpopular because of his **rigid** adherence to the rules.

complexity

 the state or quality of being complicated or intricate and difficult to understand

synonym: intricacy, sophistication, elaboration

(1) cognitive **complexity**, (2) **complexity** theory

The project's **complexity** made it difficult for the team to complete it on time.

majesty

- n. regal or royal dignity; grandeur or greatness
- synonym: grandeur, royalty, eminence
- (1) morning **majesty**, (2) **majesty** of nature

The king's **majesty** was apparent in his elegant attire and powerful presence.

pause

v. to take a short break from talking or doing something before continuing

synonym: halt, break, intermit

(1) pause a moment, (2) pause for a reaction

The man **paused** before opening the door.

calm

adj. not excited, angry, or nervous; free from wind, large waves

synonym: quiet, peaceful, tranquility

(1) calm sea, (2) calm manner

It was the first time in a long time that I felt truly **calm** and at peace.

exchange

v. to give something and receive something else in return, often with the implication that the items being traded are of equal or comparable value; (noun) the act of giving or taking something in return for something else; a place or system where goods or services can be bought, sold, or traded

synonym: trade, swap, interchange

(1) **exchange** rate, (2) **exchange** a few friendly words My sister and I frequently **exchange** books, as we love reading.

extravagant

adj. exceeding the bounds of reason or necessity; wildly excessive; lavish

synonym: excessive, lavish, indulgent

dance performance.

(1) **extravagant** expenses, (2) **extravagant** lifestyle The wedding was an **extravagant** affair with a guest list of over 500 people.

mincing

adj. affectedly dainty or delicate in behavior, speech, or manner; (of food) cut or chopped into very small piecessynonym: dainty, affected, delicate

(1) mincing garlic, (2) mincing wordsI couldn't stand the mincing steps of the ballerina in the

ballet

- a type of performance dance that tells a dramatic story or expresses an idea with music but no talking or singing
- (1) a **ballet** enthusiast, (2) **ballet** lessons

 She is a leading female classical **ballet** dancer

weird

adj. extraordinary, unexpected, or difficult to explain synonym: bizarre, creepy, peculiar

a weird dress,
 the state of being weird
 my computer has been acting weird recently.

cancel

v. to decide that a previously scheduled activity will not take place

synonym: abort, invalidate, annul

(1) **cancel** a class, (2) **cancel** a free subscription trial When customers **cancel** their reservations, they lose the deposit they made.

offend

- v. to cause someone to feel upset, angry, or annoyed synonym: insult, hurt, anger
- offend his sensibilities, (2) offend a customer
 His rude comments offended many people at the party.

holocaust

n. the systematic killing of millions of Jews and other minority groups by the Nazis during World War II, or any similar act of mass destruction

synonym: genocide, mass murder, devastation

(1) nuclear **holocaust**, (2) the **holocaust** museum Many **holocaust** survivors still suffer from the trauma they experienced during that time.

survivor

 a person who remains alive after an event in which others have died

synonym: subsister

(1) ovarian cancer **survivor**, (2) a single **survivor**The shipwreck **survivor** was rescued after floating in the ocean for three days.

boom

 a sudden increase in economic activity, or a sudden happening that brings good fortune; a deep, loud, and prolonged sound

synonym: roaring, prosperity, boost

(1) **boom** in sales, (2) a sonic **boom**The high-technology industry is enjoying a **boom**.

forgiveness

n. the act of stopping feeling angry or resentful towards someone for a mistake or offense with compassion

synonym: pardon, amnesty, compassion

(1) forgiveness of liabilities, (2) beg for forgiveness

He gained debt forgiveness.

savior

 a person who rescues a people from harm or danger; (in Christianity) Jesus Christ who is a teacher and prophet born in Bethlehem and active in Nazareth

synonym: hero, rescuer, redeemer

(1) political savior, (2) pray to the savior

The guru of that religion thought of himself as a savior.

define

 to state or explain precisely the nature, scope, or meaning of something

synonym: characterize, depict, express

(1) **define** a word, (2) **define** my position

To advance this discussion, we must **define** "success" rigorously.

broadcast

 to send out a program or some information on radio or television

synonym: air, announce, advertise

broadcast a concert, (2) broadcast a radio ad
 Most of the programs are broadcast in this area.

lovable

adj. deserving or inspiring love and affection *synonym*: adorable, charming, dear

(1) **lovable** personality, (2) a **lovable** creature

The little puppy was lovable and had a playful personality.

hypocrisy

n. the practice of engaging in the same behavior or activity for which one criticizes another or the practice of claiming to have moral standards or beliefs to which one's behavior does not conform

synonym: insincerity, dissembling, duplicity

(1) without **hypocrisy**, (2) self-serving **hypocrisy**

The commentaries often criticized the government's political **hypocrisy**.

dare

- v. to have the courage to do something
- *synonym*: challenge, risk, attempt
- (1) dare not go, (2) dare to take risks

I wouldn't **dare** to speak to him like that.

repulsive

- adj. causing strong dislike or disgust; offensive, unpleasant, or grotesque; resisting or rejecting contact or influence
- synonym: disgusting, revolting, repugnant
- (1) repulsive smell, (2) repulsive act

The politician's rhetoric was so **repulsive** that many people refused to vote for him.

unconditional

- adj. not subject to any conditions; absolute or complete; not limited by any qualifications or restrictions
- synonym: absolute, complete, unqualified
- (1) **unconditional** forgiveness, (2) **unconditional** support Her love for him was **unconditional**, despite all of his flaws.

qualified

- adj. officially recognized as having completed a training course or passed the exams that are necessary to perform a particular job
- synonym: eligible, skillful, accomplished
- (1) a **qualified** doctor, (2) **qualified** in medicine We seek a person **qualified** for the post.

precondition

- n. a necessary condition or requirement that must be met for something else to happen or be possible
- synonym: requisite, prerequisite, stipulation
- (1) **precondition** agreement, (2) essential **precondition** A peaceful environment is a **precondition** for meaningful negotiations.

apologize

- v. to express regret for committing wrongdoing or causing a problem
- synonym: excuse, justify, atone
- (1) apologize for being late, (2) apologize ahead of time

I apologize for neglecting your email.

theoretical

 adj. relating to the concepts and principles upon which a particular topic is founded, rather than practice and experience

synonym: conceptual, conjectural, ideal

(1) **theoretical** models, (2) **theoretical** physicist Absolute zero is the lowest **theoretical** temperature.

hero

 a person who is admired or idealized for courage, outstanding achievements, or noble qualities; a character in literature or history who is central to the plot and who exhibits heroic qualities

synonym: champion, protagonist, savior

(1) local **hero**, (2) unsung **hero**

The soldier who sacrificed his life for his country is considered a national **hero**.

murder

- n. the crime of killing somebody intentionally
- synonym: slaying, killing
- (1) **murder** in the second degree, (2) attempted **murder** This intriguing **murder** mystery remains unsolved.

gallows

 a wooden structure, typically formed by two upright poles and a crossbeam, used for the execution of criminals by hanging

synonym: gibbet, scaffold, hanging

(1) gallows humor, (2) with gallows eyes

The judge sentenced the criminal to the **gallows** for his heinous crimes.

noose

 a loop or knot, typically made of rope, used for hanging or executing a person or animal; a trap or snare in which the neck catches the prey

synonym: loop, snare, halter

(1) noose knot, (2) hangman's noose

The criminal was caught in the **noose** of the law and faced

severe consequences for their actions.

blindfold

- n. a covering for the eyes used to block out light, particularly one used as a means of sensory deprivation or as a form of punishment or revenge; (verb) to cover someone's eyes with a blindfold or similar material, often as a way of preventing them from seeing something or to make a game or activity more challenging
- (1) blindfold game, (2) blindfold challenge

The doctor administered a **blindfold** test to evaluate the patient's sense of touch.

pardon

 to forgive someone for something they have said or done, such as a crime; (noun) the act of excusing a mistake or offense

synonym: forgive, excuse, absolve
