#### involve

v. to include or affect someone or something as a necessary part of something else

synonym: implicate, include, engage

#### revolution

 a large-scale attempt to overthrow the government of a country, often using violence or war;

synonym: coup, innovation, rebellion

(1) beginning of the industrial **revolution**, (2) a political **revolution** 

The **revolution** by the citizen resulted in a redistribution of wealth.

## vision

 n. the ability to think about or see the future with imagination and intelligence; the faculty of being able to see

*synonym*: sight, image, concept

(1) a prodigious vision,(2) telescopic visionDriving is difficult for me because of my poor vision.

## legacy

n. something that is handed down from an earlier generation or time, often something that has had a significant impact on subsequent generations; a bequest made by a person in their will, often money or property

*synonym*: inheritance, bequest, estate

(1) financial **legacy**, (2) cultural **legacy** 

Her **legacy** as a philanthropist will live on for generations to come.

## congressperson

 a person who belongs to a congress, especially a member of the US House of Representatives; congressman (congressperson is used to avoid gender discrimination)

synonym: lawmaker, politician, representative

(1) hawkish **congressperson**, (2) former **congressperson**The term of a **congressperson** is two years.

#### conversation

 an informal talk between two or more people to exchange their views, ideas, information, etc.

synonym: chat, discussion, dialogue

(1) **conversation** in English, (2) a friendly **conversation** Your **conversation** reflects your thoughts.

#### honor

 high regard or great respect for someone; the quality of having and doing based on a keen sense of morality; (verb) to show respect towards someone

synonym: integrity, virtue, acclaim

(1) womanly honor,(2) honor our ancestorsI claim on my honor that it is true.

## opportune

adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purpose

synonym: suitable, timely, practical

(1) **opportune** occasion, (2) an **opportune** remark The phone rang at the most **opportune** time.

## represent

v. to speak, act, or be present on behalf of another person or group; to form or constitute

*synonym*: depict, express, describe

(1) **represent** by a diagram, (2) the characters that **represent** numbers

We elected him to **represent** us at the international conference.

## precious

adj. uncommon and extremely valuable

synonym: adored, cherished, valued

(1) price of **precious** metals, (2) **precious** information We cannot afford to squander **precious** time.

# willingness

- n. the state of being ready or inclined to do somethingsynonym: readiness, eagerness, enthusiasm
- (1) **willingness** to help, (2) indicate a **willingness** to change

Her willingness to help others earned her many friends.

## wrap

 to cover or enclose something entirely with paper, cloth, or other material

synonym: surround, cover, bandage

(1) wrap a fish in foil, (2) wrap up a meetingWrap the bandage tightly around the injured arm.

#### rural

adj. of or relating to the countryside synonym: agrarian, country, rustic

(1) **rural** accents, (2) people in **rural** areas Many **rural** areas are still impoverished.

belt

 to sing loudly and forcefully; to hit someone or something hard; (noun) a strip of leather or other material worn to tie or buckle something around the body

synonym: sing, hit hard, (noun) strap

(1) belt him in the face, (2) leather belt

The band was **belting** out old songs in response to audience requests.

cult

a small religious group, especially one that is not part of a larger religion and that is regarded as outside the norm; followers of an exclusive system of beliefs and practices

synonym: sect, faith, religion

(1) **cult** members, (2) **cult's** practices

The **cult** leader promised his followers that they would achieve enlightenment if they followed his teachings.

spirit

the part of a person which is the seat of their mind, feelings, and character rather than their physical body; the general atmosphere of a place or situation and the effect that it has on people

synonym: soul, attitude, enthusiasm

- (1) **spirit** and the letter of the law, (2) an indomitable **spirit** Despite their tragic loss, the family is showing great **spirit**.
- a plant that is grown in warm countries and bears bolls containing seeds with soft and long hairs that are made into textile fiber and thread for sewing
- (1) **cotton** cloth, (2) culture of **cotton** The price of raw **cotton** continued to rise.

**fuss** 

- a state of agitation or excitement; an angry disturbance synonym: commotion, agitation, disturbance
- (1) make a **fuss**, (2) get into a **fuss** There was a **fuss** about the broken vase, but it was quickly forgotten.

complain

to say dissatisfaction or annoyance about something or somebody

synonym: gripe, claim, denounce

(1) **complain** about a job, (2) call and **complain** frequently Our users are often **complaining** about the slow application.

cotton

## pray

v. to make a request or petition to a higher power, especially in the form of a respectful or humble request synonym: implore, supplicate, entreat

(1) pray devoutly, (2) pray for rain

She closed her eyes and **prayed** for strength to overcome difficult times.

#### dew

the tiny drops of water that have condensed on a cool surface overnight

synonym: condensation, vapor, fog

(1) a drop of **dew**, (2) morning **dew** 

Moisture in the atmosphere condenses at night and forms **dew**.

## weigh

v. to have a particular weight; to carefully evaluate things before making a conclusion

synonym: consider, cogitate, count

(1) **weigh** heavily on stock prices, (2) **weigh** a cargo The baby **weighs** 1 pound 3 oz.

## strategy

 a detailed plan of action designed to achieve a long-term or overall goal.

synonym: approach, procedure, scenario

(1) military **strategy**, (2) develop a **strategy** 

Our plan includes a comprehensive marketing strategy.

## downtown

*adv.* in or towards the central area of a town or city *synonym*: central, city-center, urban

(1) downtown building, (2) downtown traffic

He decided to take a walk **downtown** area to explore the city.

#### attend

v. to be present at an event, to go to a placesynonym: go, be present, accompany

(1) attend a meeting, (2) attend service

We must **attend** to this matter.

## encourage

v. to give someone support, confidence, or hope; to persuade someone to do or continue to do something by making it easier for them and making them believe it is a good thing to do

synonym: facilitate, persuade, stimulate

(1) **encourage** a sense of affinity, (2) **encourage** antisocial behavior

They **encouraged** customers with a premium for loyal patronage.

#### contribute

- v. to give something, especially money or goods, to provide or achieve something together with other people synonym: donate, devote, commit
- (1) **contribute** a large sum of money to the fund,
- (2) **contribute** to society

Government workers cannot **contribute** to political campaigns.

## labor

n. productive work, especially physical work done for wages; the people who do manual or physical work in a country or company for wage; (verb) to work hard or to strive and make an effort to reach a goal

synonym: toil, moil, donkeywork

(1) seasonal **labor**, (2) manual **labor** In several countries, child **labor** is a serious social problem.

folk

*n.* people in general, especially those of a particular group or type

*synonym*: community, family, person

(1) **folk** art, (2) the **folk** songs of a particular district Some seaweed was used as **folk** medicine in ancient times.

# desegregation

 the action or process of eliminating segregation, typically of races or ethnic groups, in educational, social, or other institutions

synonym: integration, assimilation

(1) desegregation plan, (2) legal desegregation

**Desegregation** of schools was a major social issue in the 1960s.

#### submit

- v. to give or offer a document, proposal, etc. to a decision-maker for examination or consideration
- synonym: hand in, present, propose
- (1) agree to **submit** the bill, (2) **submit** an application Please **submit** the assignment to me.

## transcript

- a written or printed version of something, especially a dictated or recorded speech, interview, or conversation; an official record of a student's coursework and grades at a school or university
- *synonym*: record, certificate, report
- (1) academic **transcript**, (2) official **transcript**The court reporter was responsible for creating a **transcript** of the trial proceedings.

#### invite

- v. to ask someone to come or join; to offer an opportunity or possibility for something to happen or take place synonym: ask, request, summon
- (1) invite guests, (2) invite criticismWe want to invite you to our annual charity event.

# boycott

- v. to refuse to buy, use, or patronize a particular product or service as a form of protest or to bring about change; (noun) a deliberate and organized refusal to buy or use a product, service, or organization as a form of protest or to apply pressure for change
- synonym: protest, abstain, avoid
- (1) **boycott** campaign, (2) **boycott** the discussion Many people have decided to **boycott** the company due to their unethical practices.

#### sermon

a speech or lecture given by a religious leader,
 especially a minister or priest, as part of a worship service

synonym:

homily, discourse, lecture

(1) lengthy **sermon**, (2) a lay **sermon** 

The preacher delivered a powerful **sermon** on the importance of forgiveness.

## apostle

- n. one of a group of early Christian leaders who were chosen and trained by Jesus to spread his teachingssynonym: messenger, envoy, delegate
- (1) Apostle Paul, (2) an apostle of revolution

The twelve **apostles** were Jesus' closest followers and were chosen to spread his teachings.

### **Christ**

 the man that Christians believe is the prophet and the son of God, and whose life and sermons form the basis for Christianity

synonym: Savior, Jesus Christ, Jesus

(1) teaching of Christ, (2) before Christ

**Christmas** is the day to celebrate the birth of Christ.

#### arrest

v. to take into custody

synonym: capture, detain, imprison

(1) arrest the thief, (2) arrest the progress

A police officer has the authority to arrest a criminal.

#### immediate

adj. happening or done without delay or occurring shortly after something else

synonym: prompt, quick, instantaneous

(1) take **immediate** effect, (2) the **immediate** past Both forts were subject to **immediate** attacks.

appeal

 a serious, earnest, or urgent request for money, information, or help; a quality that makes somebody or something attractive or interest

synonym: request, charm, attraction

(1) draw out your **appeal**, (2) an **appeal** for help He needed to resolve the problem as soon as possible, so he made an appeal directly.

## gospel

 a set of beliefs or teachings of a particular religious group, especially when considered authoritative or sacred

synonym: doctrine, truth, teaching

(1) preach the **gospel**, (2) **gospel** music

The **gospel** of love and forgiveness is central to their religion.

#### silent

adj. without any or little soundsynonym: quiet, hushed, mute

(1) **silent** reading, (2) give **silent** consent

The politician remained **silent** despite intense media scrutiny.

# inspire

v. to make somebody fill with the desire, confidence, or enthusiasm, especially to do something creative

synonym: boost, encourage, enlighten

(1) **inspire** a feeling of curiosity, (2) **inspire** him to write a novel

The unique style of this martial arts **inspired** many action film producers.

## nonviolence

n. the use of peaceful means, such as civil disobedience or passive resistance, rather than violence to achieve a goal, especially in the context of political or social change

synonym: pacifism, nonresistance, peacekeeping

(1) **nonviolence** movement, (2) **nonviolence** protest Martin Luther King Jr. was a champion of **nonviolence** in the fight for civil rights.

#### essential

*adj.* indispensable; fundamental *synonym*: critical, crucial, basic

(1) **essential** amino acid, (2) **essential** commodities of life Trial and error is an **essential** part of education.

#### worldview

 a particular philosophy or cognitive orientation of life or conception of the world

synonym: perspective, position, viewpoint

(1) mainstream **worldview**, (2) the **worldview** of the ancient civilization

The war between the two countries was also a battle between competing **worldviews**.

## theology

- n. the study of the nature of God and religious beliefsynonym: divinity, religion, faith
- (1) **theology** student, (2) a college of **theology**The professor specialized in the **theology** of the early church.

#### minister

a person appointed to or a job of a head of a government department

*synonym*: bishop, official, ambassador

(1) **Minister** for Education, (2) deputy prime **minister** The **minister** occasionally preaches at this church.

# philosophy

- n. the study of general and fundamental questions, such as those about existence, reason, knowledge, values, mind synonym: doctrine, attitude, creed
- (1) **philosophy** of education, (2) western **philosophy** Ethics is a branch of **philosophy**.

# discipline

 the practice of training people to obey rules or a code of behavior, using and punishments if these are broken; a region of activity, knowledge, or influence

synonym: training, restraint, field

(1) break **discipline**, (2) rigid **discipline**He quickly learned the military **discipline**.

# dignity

 the quality of being worthy of esteem or respect; high office or rank or station

synonym: grace, elegance, nobility

(1) respect for human dignity, (2) retain everyone's dignity

The failure destroyed his trust and personal dignity.

faith

 n. complete trust in something or someone's ability or knowledge; a strong belief in religion, divine power, etc.

synonym: belief, trust, confidence

(1) religious faith, (2) faith in government

He kept his robust faith in his company.

jail

 a facility where criminals are kept to be punished for their crimes; a prison

synonym: prison, slammer, penitentiary

(1) county jail, (2) be in jail

The police escorted the prisoner to the jail.

engage

v. to attract and keep someone's attention and interest; to participate in or obtain services of something

synonym: confront, employ, amuse

- (1) **engage** in environmental protection activities,
- (2) engage a new employee

Many multinational companies are **engaged** in the reconstruction of that country.

violent

adj. involving or caused by physical force or aggression against someone or something

synonym: aggressive, intense, turbulent

(1) victim of a **violent** crime, (2) **violent** incident The protesters became **violent** when the police tried to disperse them.

courage

 the ability to face danger, difficulty, uncertainty, or pain without being overcome by fear or despair; the quality of being brave or courageous

synonym: bravery, valor, fearlessness

(1) mental **courage**, (2) inspire **courage**It takes a lot of **courage** to stand up for what you believe is right.

## brutality

- n. the quality or state of being cruel or savagesynonym: cruelty, ferocity, savagery
- (1) military **brutality**, (2) **brutality** against civilians

  The protesters were outraged by the police **brutality** they witnessed at the demonstration.

#### surround

- v. to be all around something or somebody synonym: encircle, encompass, envelop
- (1) **surround** a town, (2) a stone wall **surrounds** the palace On three sides, mountains **surround** the settlement.

#### mob

 a large and disorderly crowd of people; a large horde of animals

synonym: crowd, throng, horde

(1) **mob** psychology, (2) **mob** violence

The excited **mob** was getting out of control at the concert.

## dynamic

adj. having a lot of energy, ideas, and enthusiasm, and a strong personality; of or relating to dynamics (= the branch of physics and engineering concerned with the forces that cause motions of bodies)

synonym: energetic, active, vital

(1) a **dynamic** market, (2) **dynamic** person The sprinter has a **dynamic** way of running.

#### burden

 a duty, responsibility, etc. that is oppressive or worrisome; a load, typically a heavy one that is difficult to carry

synonym: obligation, duty, load

(1) carry a **burden**, (2) **burden** of disease That car has a low environmental **burden**.

## someplace

adv. somewhere without specifying a particular or exact location

synonym: somewhere, anywhere, wherever

(1) from **someplace** deep inside, (2) **someplace** quiet Let's go **someplace** new and try something we have not

- v. to make up someone's mind about something; to come to a conclusion or judgment after considering optionssynonym: choose, determine, settle
- (1) **decide** a question, (2) **decide** on a course of action She couldn't **decide** whether to order the pizza or the pasta for dinner.

## possibility

- n. a chance that something may happen or be truesynonym: chance, prospect, likelihood
- (1) **possibility** for growth, (2) **possibility** of a major earthquake

The **possibility** of getting the disease will drastically increase.

#### viral

- adj. relating to or caused by a virus
- fight viral infections, (2) detect a viral code
   This device can more accurately detect viral pathogens.

# religion

n. a deep conviction in a supernatural power that controls human destiny

synonym: faith, creed, belief

 religion sociology, (2) freedom of religion
 Their religion strictly prohibits them from drinking or gambling.

#### communal

adj. belonging to or used by a group rather than individuals;for common use

synonym: collaborative, combined, collective

(1) **communal** swimming pool, (2) **communal** combination of funds

**Communal** elections were held in several European countries.

## rigorous

adj. allowing or demanding no deviation from a standard; extremely careful, thorough, or accurate

synonym: severe, exact, strict

rigorous standards, (2) have rigorous criticism
 The way he manages his employees is extremely rigorous.

#### maintain

v. to continue to uphold or sustain; to keep in a particular state or condition; to assert or declare something to be true

synonym: preserve, uphold, sustain

(1) **maintain** order, (2) **maintain** good health I need to **maintain** my car regularly to prevent any major mechanical issues.

#### commitment

 a promise or firm decision to do something or to behave in a certain way

synonym: burden, obligation, promise

(1) a **commitment** to an alliance, (2) meet his **commitments** 

His business **commitments** took him to the United States.

## appreciate

- v. to value and acknowledge the worth of someone or something; to be grateful for something or someonesynonym: acknowledge, admire, enjoy
- (1) **appreciate** her feedback, (2) **appreciate** the value We would **appreciate** an early reply.

## committed

adj. willing to put in a lot of effort, time, and energy into something; firmly believing in something

synonym: devoted, faithful, attached

(1) in a **committed** relationship, (2) strong and **committed** sales staff

Our company is strongly **committed** to meeting customers' needs.

#### drama

 a play in a theatre, television, or radio, or performance on a stage *synonym*: acting, play, theater

(1) secular **drama**, (2) upcoming crime **drama**She had an audition for **drama** school.

## pretension

 n. the act of claiming or asserting something, especially without good reason or without evidence; an unfounded or excessive claim or ambition

synonym: presumption, pretense, affectation

(1) **pretension** to authority, (2) baseless **pretension**His **pretensions** of being a gourmet were quickly exposed when he could not identify basic herbs and spices.

## almighty

adj. having supreme or ultimate power or authority; complete and total; omnipotent

synonym: omnipotent, all-powerful, supreme

(1) almighty power, (2) almighty dollar

The **almighty** ruler of the kingdom held ultimate power over his subjects.

# testimony

 a formal written or spoken statement that something is true, especially one given in court; something that serves as evidence

*synonym*: affirmant, evidence, proof

(1) **testimony** before Congress, (2) give his **testimony** Witness **testimony** backed up the defendant's claims.

# bloody

 adj. covered in or smeared with blood; involving or characterized by bloodshed or brutality

synonym: gory, gruesome, savage

(1) **bloody** massacre, (2) **bloody** diarrhea The crime scene was **bloody** and gruesome.

claim

v. to assert that something is true; to demand or request something as one's own; to lay legal or moral right to something; (noun) a demand or assertion of a right or something that one believes to be true

synonym: assert, declare, maintain

## (1) claim responsibility, (2) false claim

He wants to **claim** ownership of the abandoned property.

## redemption

 the act of saving or being saved from sin, error, or evil, or the process of regaining or earning something of value

*synonym*: rescue, salvation, liberation

(1) redemption of a loan, (2) a redemption bill

He saw his time in prison as an opportunity for **redemption**.

## tradition

 a belief, custom, or way of doing something that has been passed down from generation to generation within a group or society

synonym: custom, practice, ritual

(1) a **tradition** of a culture, (2) against **tradition**It is a **tradition** in many families to have a big Thanksgiving dinner with all their relatives.

preach

- v. to deliver a religious or moral message to an audience synonym: expound, advocate, sermonize
- preach the gospel, (2) preach to the masses
   The pastor preached about the importance of forgiveness.

#### confession

 a formal statement in which one admits that they have done something wrong or illegal

synonym: admission, avowal, acknowledgment

(1) a **confession** of guilt, (2) a **confession** of faith The prisoner made a full **confession** and admitted to his crime.

#### embrace

to accept something willingly and enthusiastically;
 (noun) the act of clasping another person in the arms as in greeting or affection

synonym: grasp, hold tightly, accept

(1) **embrace** an opportunity, (2) a warm **embrace** The woods **embrace** the house.

## acknowledge

v. to accept or admit the existence, reality, or truth of something; to accept that someone or something has a particular authority or quality; to express obligation, thanks, or gratitude for someone's help, commitment, etc.;

synonym: accept, agree, declare

(1) **acknowledge** the deed, (2) **acknowledge** his help He never **acknowledged** his fault.

## slavery

 the practice or system of owning, buying, and selling people as property and forcing them to work

*synonym*: bondage, servitude, enslavement

(1) slavery labor, (2) institution of slavery

The abolition of **slavery** in the United States was a major achievement in the fight for human rights.

## lynch

v. to put to death or punish (usually by hanging) without legal authorization or due process, often as an act of mob justice or vigilante action; (noun) a violent punishment, often extrajudicial, in which a mob or group of people seize and kill someone, usually by hanging, as a form of punishment or vengeance

*synonym*: hang, execute, mob

(1) lynch law, (2) lynch him to death

The mob wanted to **lynch** the suspect before he could be tried in court.

# segregation

n. the act or process of separating or isolating people, things, or groups based on race, gender, religion, social class, or other characteristics; a political or social system that enforces such separation or isolation

*synonym*: isolation, separation, discrimination

(1) racial segregation, (2) segregation of powerSegregation based on race or ethnicity is illegal and unjust.

skip

v. to move along lightly and quickly, making a step from one foot to the other with a hop or bounce; to intentionally fail to do something which would normally

do

*synonym*: bounce, spring, neglect

(1) **skip** across the country, (2) **skip** breakfast

We **skipped** the topic because it was too complicated.

## apology

 an act of saying or writing that you are sorry for something that has been done wrong or that causes a trouble

synonym: regret, excuse, plea

(1) genuine **apology**, (2) accept his **apology** 

She wrote a letter of **apology** to the renter.

## confederate

 a person who is allied or associated with another person or group, especially in a political or military context; a supporter of the Confederate States of America

synonym: ally, associate, partner

(1) **confederate** soldier, (2) **Confederate** government The two countries are **confederates** and have a strong alliance.

## symbol

something visible that is used to represent something else

synonym: mark, character, insignia

(1) **symbol** color, (2) **symbol** for happiness The dragon is considered a **symbol** of bravery.

## resistance

n. the act of defending oneself from an aggressor or refusing to accept something

synonym: opposition, antagonism, defiance

(1) **resistance** movement, (2) **resistance** to insulin The bill to increase the consumption tax had passed despite much **resistance** from the public.

#### urgent

adj. requiring immediate attention or action; pressing synonym: pressing, critical, immediate

(1) an urgent telegram, (2) urgent situation

It is **urgent** that we leave for the airport now to catch our flight.

# reject

v. to refuse to accept, consider, or use something or someone

synonym: decline, turn down, repudiate

(1) **reject** the proposal, (2) **reject** all imperfect merchandise The company **rejected** the job candidate's application due to a lack of experience.

## extraordinary

adj. exceptional, unexpected, very unusual; surpassing the ordinary or usual

synonym: exceptional, noteworthy, astonishing

(1) **extraordinary** ability, (2) **extraordinary** weather He narrated the **extraordinary** story of his adventure.

## apologize

v. to express regret for committing wrongdoing or causing a problem

synonym: excuse, justify, atone

(1) **apologize** for being late, (2) **apologize** ahead of time **I apologize** for neglecting your email.

# forgiveness

- n. the act of stopping feeling angry or resentful towards someone for a mistake or offense with compassionsynonym: pardon, amnesty, compassion
- (1) **forgiveness** of liabilities, (2) beg for **forgiveness** He gained debt **forgiveness**.

# acknowledgment

 the act of accepting or admitting something, or the fact of being accepted or admitted; recognition or acceptance of the existence or truth of something

synonym: recognition, acceptance, admission

(1) in thankful **acknowledgment**, (2) **acknowledgment** of obligation

The recipient signed the **acknowledgment** of receipt.

#### individual

- n. a single person or thing, as distinct from a groupsynonym: person, being, self
- (1) a private **individual**, (2) **individual** freedom
  As an **individual**, he had the right to make his own decisions and live his life as he saw fit.

#### revere

v. to feel deep and profound respect or admiration for someone or something; to hold in high esteem

synonym: worship, venerate, admire

(1) **revere** a hero, (2) **revere** a deity

Many people **revere** their religious leaders and look up to them for guidance.

#### church

 a building or institution dedicated to religious worship or activities; a Christian religious organization or denomination

synonym: chapel, cathedral, synagogue

(1) church bell, (2) small church

The **church** on the corner is hosting a free community meal tonight.

#### barefoot

adj. without shoes or other foot coverings; wearing nothing on the feet

synonym: bare, shoeless, unshod

(1) barefoot walk, (2) barefoot fashion

The **barefoot** hiker enjoyed feeling the earth beneath their feet.

## assassin

 a person who murders a prominent or well-known person for political reasons or in exchange for money

synonym: killer, manslayer

(1) fall victim to an **assassin**, (2) would-be **assassin**She hired an **assassin** to kill her opponent.

## critic

 someone who expresses opinions about the quality of books, music, etc.

synonym: pundit, analyst, attacker

(1) art critic, (2) severe critic

Advocates for legal reform hear less harsh words from their critics.

## violation
