### fast-forward

### quintessence

### feat

### genius

#### illustrate

#### elite

#### athlete

 a person who competes in one or more sports that involve physical strength, speed, or endurance synonym: player, contestant, jock

#### deliberate

adj. done with full consciousness of nature and effects rather than by accident

synonym: intentional, planned, careful

#### eventual

adj. expected to happen at a later time; likely to occur in the future

synonym: ultimate, final, last

#### broad

adj. very wide; general

synonym: wide, expansive, comprehensive

## delay

peer

# plateau

### comport

### precocious

### ignore

hymn

n. a song of praise or worship, especially one in a religious service or ceremony

largely

# background

- the details of a person's social heritage, such as family, vocational or educational experience; past information that is essential to understanding a situation or problem synonym: ground, experience, backdrop

#### admire

v. to have regard for or respect for someone's qualities or the actions they have performed

synonym: esteem, respect, marvel

#### shun

 to avoid deliberately or keep away from someone or something

### mathematics

 the science dealing with the logic of quantities, shapes, spaces, and arrangement

#### novel

 an extended fictional work in prose; usually in the form of a story; (adjective) original and of a kind not seen before

#### medal

### prestigious

# philosophy

 the study of general and fundamental questions, such as those about existence, reason, knowledge, values, mind

v. to meet the requirements or expectations; to achieve or realize

# logic

### binary

# badge

 a small emblem or token worn as a symbol of belonging or rank, often used by law enforcement or military organizations

synonym: emblem, insignia

### institute

 an organization that has a specific purpose, particularly one dealing with science, education, or a particular profession; (verb) to initiate, introduce, or establish something

#### laureate

### typical

### decline

v. to become gradually smaller, fewer, worse, etc.; to refuse to accept

### normally

### volleyball

### badminton

n. a sport played with rackets and a shuttlecock, in which players on either side of a net hit the shuttlecock back and forth over the net, trying to make the other player(s) fail to return the shuttlecock to the opposite side

#### skate

#### dabble

#### enthusiast

- n. a person having a strong liking for something

### spectrum

 an ordered array of colors into which a light beam can be split
