adj. empty, simple, or apparent; devoid of any qualifications

synonym: crude, blunt, desolate

adj. covered with ice or frost; very cold; lacking warmth or friendliness

synonym: frosty, cold, glacial

adj. relating to Jupiter or its characteristics Jovian

synonym: Jupiter, giant planet

a chemical compound with the chemical formula CH4 with no smell or color, often used as a fuel

determinant

 a factor, circumstance, or condition that contributes to the shaping, influencing, or determining of a particular outcome or result

synonym: cause, factor, element

(1) environmental **determinant**, (2) a **determinant** of crop yields

One **determinant** of success is having a positive attitude and a strong work ethic.

recognizable

adj. easy to become aware of or identify synonym: noticeable, perceptible, definite

(1) to a **recognizable** degree, (2) **recognizable** landmark His car was easily **recognizable** in the parking lot.

asteroid

 a small rocky body orbiting the sun, typically in the region between Mars and Jupiter

synonym: minor planet, planetoid, rocky planetesimal

(1) asteroid mining, (2) asteroid explorer

Scientists are studying the composition and origins of the **asteroid** belt to understand the early solar system better.

ethane

 a colorless, odorless hydrocarbon gas with the molecular formula C2H6 that is a basic component of natural gas and is used as a fuel source and in the production of chemicals

synonym: natural gas, methane, propane

(1) ethane production, (2) ethane gas

Ethane combustion is an important energy source for heating and electricity generation.

dragonfly

- a slender-bodied non-stinging insect having two pairs of large transparent wings that are outspread at rest

rotorcraft

 an aircraft or vehicle that uses one or more rotors for lift, propulsion, and directional control, including helicopters, gyroplanes, and tilt rotors

rover

- n. a vehicle designed to travel over rough terrain, especially on the surface of a planet or moonsynonym: vehicle, robot, explorer

The **rover** on Mars is gathering data on the planet's surface and sending it back to Earth.

octocopter

n. a type of uncrewed, remote-controlled aerial vehicle or drone that is powered by eight electric motors and uses rotors to achieve vertical takeoff and landing, as well as maneuvering in various directions

synonym: drone, multicopter, UAV

opportune

tantalize

manna

n. a sweet-tasting and nutritious substance that, according to the Bible, was provided by God to the Israelites during their journey through the wilderness; any unexpected or miraculous source of sustenance or benefit

synonym: sustenance, nourishment
