app

 (abbreviation for application) software designed to run on smartphones and other mobile devices or inside a web browser on a PC

synonym: application, software

miscarriage

n. the spontaneous loss of a pregnancy before the 20th week; the failure of an effort or plan to come to fruition

synonym: stillbirth, abortion

cramp

 a sudden, painful contraction or spasm of a muscle, typically in the leg or abdomen; a feeling of tightness or discomfort in a muscle caused by prolonged use or stress

synonym: crick, spasm, twinge

nap

synonym: cause, factor, element

One **determinant** of success is having a positive attitude and a strong work ethic.

rev

n. a measure of the rate at which an engine or motor rotates, often expressed in revolutions per minute (RPM); (verb) to increase the number of rotations per minute

synonym: revolution, RPM, speed

He stepped on the gas pedal, and the engine released a loud rev.

affluence

n. an abundance of wealth, resources, or property;prosperity

synonym: wealth, prosperity, richness

institutionalize
