masquerade

n. a party, dance, or other festive gatherings of persons wearing masks and other disguises, or a costume worn

on such an occasion; making a false outward show *synonym*: disguise, pretense, facade

(1) show up in a **masquerade**, (2) absurd **masquerade**The **masquerade** party was lavish, with guests in elaborate costumes and masks.

modernity

n. the quality or condition of being modern; the state or era of being up-to-date in technology, science, and culture synonym: contemporaneousness, present-day, contemporaneity
(1) spirit of modernity, (2) path toward modernity
He was fascinated by the contrasts between traditional life and the city's modernity.

prioritize

 to assign a higher level of importance to something compared to other things

synonym: rank, order, arrange

(1) **prioritize** tasks, (2) **prioritize** people over cars

The organization **prioritized** the needs of the community in its decision-making.
