disqualify

v. to declare someone or something ineligible or unfit for a particular role or activity; to exclude or bar someone from participation in something

synonym: disbar, invalidate, exclude

(1) **disqualify** a candidate, (2) **disqualify** from the election The athlete's lousy behavior was enough to **disqualify** him from the competition.

proclaim

- v. to announce or state something publicly and forcefully synonym: announce, declare, trumpet
- (1) proclaim victory, (2) proclaim law

The leader **proclaimed** a state of emergency in the country.

nonillion

- a cardinal number represented by 1 followed by 30 zeros
- (1) **nonillion** atoms, (2) **nonillion** stars

 The **nonillionth** digit of pi is easier to calculate with advanced computing.
