### complacent

distance

represent

accord

### degree

 a unit of measurement for angles, temperature, or level of proficiency or achievement; a rank or level of academic or professional attainment

synonym: level, qualification, diploma

She received her **degree** in psychology from the university.

### depression

 a mental condition in which a person feels very unhappy and without hope for the future; a severe recession in an economy or market

synonym: recession, slump, despair

**Depression** symptoms might include a decrease in appetite and weight loss.

### permanent

adj. lasting for a long time without essential change synonym: lasting, ceaseless, endless

#### estimate

v. to guess or calculate the cost, size, value, etc. of something

synonym: calculate, gauge, evaluate

### livable

adj. capable of being lived in comfortably and sustainably; suitable for human habitation

#### heatstroke

 a serious and potentially life-threatening condition caused by prolonged exposure to high temperatures, which symptoms include high body temperature, rapid heartbeat, and confusion or loss of consciousness

synonym: heat exhaustion, hyperthermia, sunstroke

### planet

### agriculture

 the practice or science of cultivating the land or raising stock

### rudimentary

*adj.* relating to basic facts or principles; fundamental *synonym*: essential, fundamental, elementary

#### industrial

adj. of or relating to or resulting from industry

*synonym*: manufacturing, mechanical

(1) beginning of the **industrial** revolution, (2) **industrial** alcohol

**Industrial** design has become more focused on human nature aspect than ever before.

### biology

- the scientific study of life and the natural processes of living things
- (1) evolutionary **biology**, (2) cell and molecular **biology** In junior high school, we had to dissect a frog in **biology** class.

#### creature

- n. a living being, especially an animal
- synonym: being, animal, organism
- (1) creature of habit, (2) artificial creature

The deep sea **creature** was unlike anything the scientists had ever seen before.

### saga

 a long, detailed story or account of heroic deeds, family history, or notable events, often consisting of a series of connected episodes

synonym: epic, tale, chronicle

(1) fantasy saga, (2) historical saga

The epic **saga** of the family's journey through time captivated readers worldwide.

#### revolution

 a large-scale attempt to overthrow the government of a country, often using violence or war;

synonym: coup, innovation, rebellion

(1) beginning of the industrial **revolution**, (2) a political **revolution** 

The **revolution** by the citizen resulted in a redistribution of wealth.

#### mess

- a state of confusion, dirtiness, or untidiness; (verb) to fail to do something or to make something dirty or untidy

### grandparent

- n. a parent of one's father or mother

fuel

a substance that is typically burned to generate heat or energy

#### gore

v. to pierce with a sharp object, causing injury or death; (noun) coagulated blood from a wound

### damage

#### millennium

- n. a span of 1000 years, or the 1000th anniversary (plural: millennia)

#### stable

adj. firm and steady; not easily moved, disturbed, or changed

synonym: sturdy, unmoving, durable

#### brink

 the point at which something is about to happen; the edge of a steep place

synonym: edge, verge, threshold

(1) brink of war, (2) on the brink

We were on the **brink** of a financial crisis.

### catastrophe

- n. a sudden event that causes extreme ruin and misfortunesynonym: disaster, calamity, cataclysm

The lack of funds has resulted in a **catastrophe** for our university system.

#### crisis

 a time of great disagreement, confusion, or danger when problems must be resolved or critical decisions must be taken

#### ancestor

- n. a person from whom one is descended; a forefathersynonym: forebear, forefather, progenitor

#### relative

adj. considered and evaluated through comparison with something else

### terrifying

adj. very frightening or intimidating

synonym: frightening, intimidating, alarming

#### ultimate

#### hell

n. the place thought to be where bad people go and are punished after death, often depicted as being located beneath the earth; an extraordinarily unpleasant or difficult place

#### scenario

a description of possible actions or events in the future;
 a written outline of a play, film, or literary work

#### obstacle

a thing that blocks one's way or prevents or hinders progress

synonym: hindrance, barrier, block

#### enormous

adj. extremely large or great synonym: huge, giant, gigantic

#### carbon

- a chemical element that can be found in pure form as diamond or graphite, and it is also an essential part of coal and oil and is found in all plants and animals
- (1) carbon dioxide, (2) carbon emission

Trees absorb **carbon** dioxide and give off oxygen.

### atmosphere

 the mass of air that surrounds the Earth; the pervading tone or mood of a place, situation, or creative work

synonym: air, ambiance, circumstances

The spaceship began to burn up as it approached the Earth's atmosphere.

#### lever

 a handle used to operate a vehicle or a machine; a rigid bar resting on a pivot so that one end of it can be pushed or pulled easily

This initiative will be a **lever** for increasing company sales.

#### inaction

n. the lack of action or activity; the state of not doing anything; the failure to take action when action is needed

### recognize

v. to acknowledge or realize something or someone; to identify, remember, or become aware of something that was previously known or encountered

synonym: acknowledge, identify, admit

(1) **recognize** talent, (2) **recognize** achievement It's important to **recognize** your strengths and weaknesses.

### mythology

a collection of myths (= traditional stories accepted as history) or the study of myths

synonym: folklore, legend, fable

tale from mythology,
 ancient mythology
 studies Greek and Roman mythology.

### theology

- n. the study of the nature of God and religious beliefsynonym: divinity, religion, faith
- (1) **theology** student, (2) a college of **theology**The professor specialized in the **theology** of the early church.

#### doubt

 a feeling of being uncertain about something, especially about how good or accurate it is

synonym: distrust, suspect, mistrust

(1) dispel **doubts**, (2) no **doubt** about the news **Doubt** is the start, not the end, of intelligence.

### array

 a large group or collection of things or people, especially one that is impressive or attractive

synonym: collection, display, batch

#### barnacle

n. a type of crustacean that attaches itself to hard surfaces underwater, such as rocks, ships, or docks; a metaphorical term used to describe a person or object that is difficult to remove or separate from another person or object

synonym: cirripede, shellfish, crustacean

### deploy

v. to move troops or weapons into a position or military action; to bring into something in an effective way

#### broad

adj. very wide; general

synonym: wide, expansive, comprehensive

sliver

n. a small, thin, narrow piece or fragment of something, often characterized by its length or its sharpness or thinness; a small portion or amount of something, often used in a metaphorical sense to describe a trace or a hint of something

synonym: splinter, shard, fragment

(1) sliver of wood, (2) sliver of metal

I had to be careful not to step on a **sliver** of glass on the floor.

desert

- arid land with little or no vegetation often covered with sand or rocks
- (1) **desert** basin, (2) oasis in the **desert** This region is predominantly **desert**.

absorb

- v. to take in a fluid or other substance gradually synonym: consume, soak, ingest
- (1) absorb energy, (2) absorb a shock

The sponge **absorbs** water well.

grid

 a pattern of regularly spaced horizontal and vertical lines; a system of high tension cables by which electrical power is distributed throughout a region

synonym: gridiron, battery grid, power system

(1) a grid design, (2) a wire grid

Grid pattern roads often appear in urban areas.

nuclear

adj. of or relating to or constituting the nucleus of an atom;
 deriving destructive energy from the release of atomic energy

synonym: atomic

(1) **nuclear** fusion, (2) use of **nuclear** power Many countries have now agreed to a treaty banning the use of **nuclear** weapons.

### competitive

adj. involving competition or competitiveness

synonym: aggressive, ambitious, militant

(1) a **competitive** price, (2) **competitive** position

The mobile application industry is a **competitive** one.

#### renewable

adj. capable of being renewed, extended, or replaced synonym: sustainable, replaceable

(1) **renewable** energy, (2) **renewable** subscriptions

The production of **renewable** fuels requires massive volumes of fresh water.

### practical

adj. of or connected with actual use or real situation rather than with theory and ideas

synonym: applicable, functional, realistic

(1) **practical** English, (2) gain **practical** experience Her concept is highly **practical** and helpful.

#### afford

- to have enough money or time to be able to buy or do something
- (1) **afford** to buy a new car, (2) **afford** a high travel cost He cannot **afford** a holiday.

### vegan

- a person who does not eat or use any animal products, typically for ethical or environmental reasons
- (1) raw food vegan, (2) vegan lifestyle

The **vegan** diet is based on plant-based foods.

#### tradition

 a belief, custom, or way of doing something that has been passed down from generation to generation within a group or society

synonym: custom, practice, ritual

(1) a **tradition** of a culture, (2) against **tradition** It is a **tradition** in many families to have a big Thanksgiving dinner with all their relatives.

cattle

 cows, bulls, and buffalos that are raised for their milk or meat as farm animals synonym: cows, herd, oxen

(1) cattle barn, (2) cattle hide

The **cattle** are on the grassland and grazing.

sink

v. to submerge or go down below the surface of a liquid or substance; to decline or deteriorate; to cause something to go down into a liquid substance or sink into something else

*synonym*: descend, drop, plummet

(1) **sink** a lot of capital, (2) **sink** a buzzer-beater
The abandoned ship slowly began to **sink** into the murky waters of the harbor.

prefer

v. to like, choose, or want one thing or person better than another

synonym: choose, like, favor

(1) **prefer** physics to chemistry, (2) **prefer** a window seat The birds **prefer** open water areas with reeds around them.

techno

- n. a style of electronic dance music that originated in Detroit in the 1980s and is characterized by a repetitive, synthesized beat and minimalist sound effects; the use of advanced technology or techniques in a particular field

The club's playlist featured a lot of **techno** music.

lab

 a workplace for the conduct of scientific research; a laboratory

*synonym*: workshop, laboratory, research chamber

probable

adj. likely to happen or likely to be true

*synonym*: likely, possible, potential

(1) probable outcome, (2) probable cause of a fire

#### seaweed

 a plant that grows in the sea or on land very close to the sea, especially marine algae

synonym: kelp, algae

- a chemical compound with the chemical formula CH4 with no smell or color, often used as a fuel

### puzzle

vast

adj. enormous in size, number, amount, or quantitysynonym: expansive, extended, boundless

vast majority, (2) vast desert
 A vast audience viewed the broadcast.

### complicated

adj. involving a lot of different things or parts in a way that is difficult to understand or analyze

synonym: complex, convoluted, intricate

(1) a **complicated** process, (2) become increasingly **complicated** 

He did **complicated** pen-and-ink drawings in just a few days.

#### bullet

- n. a metal projectile that is shot from a gun
- (1) bullet wound, (2) bullet train

#### decarbonize

v. to stop or reduce emitting carbon gases, especially carbon dioxide, by replacing energy made from fossil fuels with renewable energy

#### mathematics

### capture

synonym: catch, arrest, imprison

#### industrious

adj. hardworking, diligent, and persistent in effortsynonym: diligent, hardworking, assiduous

#### undo

v. to reverse the effect of an action or event, typically one that is recent or specific

synonym: reverse, retract, revoke

#### infrastructure

 the basic systems, services, or features that are necessary for an organization or country, such as transport and power supplies

synonym: foundation, framework

(1) IT infrastructure, (2) infrastructure cost

Aging societies tend to require huge costs for **infrastructure** maintenance.

#### cement

v. make fast as if with cement; (noun) a building material that is a powder made of a mixture of calcined limestone and clay, used with water, sand, and small stones to make concrete

synonym: adhesive, glue

emit

v. to give off or send out something such as light, heat, sound, gas, etc.

*synonym*: give off, radiate, expel

seawall

n. a barrier or structure made of concrete, stone, or other materials that are built along the coastline or riverbanks to protect against erosion, flooding, or waves; a structure that separates the water from the land and helps to preserve the shoreline
