#### superior

adj. better, higher in quality, or more advanced than others synonym: better, greater, exceptional

### immigrant

 a person who has come to a country where they were not born to live there permanently

### exposure

- the organized activity or business of preserving mental and physical health by preventing or treating illness through services offered by the health profession

#### nutrition

### schizophrenia

 a severe mental disorder in which a person has a distorted view of reality and may experience hallucinations, delusions, and disordered thinking and behavior

The **schizophrenia** patient was experiencing severe auditory hallucinations.

### depression

 a mental condition in which a person feels very unhappy and without hope for the future; a severe recession in an economy or market

### psychiatric

#### diagnose

#### clinical

### judgment

the ability to form valuable opinions and make reasonable decisions
