frame

n. a strong border or structure of the wood, metal, etc. that surrounds something such as a picture, door, or window

numb

adj. unable to feel physical sensation and movement; not showing human feeling or sensitivity

bullet

n. a metal projectile that is shot from a gun

synonym: projectile, slug, shot

on-again

adj. (often used with "off-again" like "on-again, off-again") describing a relationship or situation that has been temporarily broken off or ended but has been resumed or reestablished

synonym: intermittent, sporadic, patchy

relation

 the way two persons or groups of people feel and act toward one another

mad

struggle

v. to make a great effort to do something when it is difficult, or there are a lot of problems; to use force or violence to break away from restraint or constriction

synonym: toil, strive, compete

He could not **struggle** against temptation.

quitter

 a person who gives up easily or does not have the determination to finish what they have started

synonym: coward, deserter, surrender

(1) easy quitter, (2) serial quitter

He was labeled as a **quitter** after he abandoned the project halfway.

breakup

the end of a relationship between persons or nations;
 the separation of something into several pieces or sections

synonym: breakdown, divorce, separation

decide

- to make up someone's mind about something; to come to a conclusion or judgment after considering options
 synonym: choose, determine, settle

initially

adv. at the beginning; at first synonym: originally, primarily, firstly

navigate

synonym: guide, helm, voyage

co-parenting

 a parent who shares the responsibility of raising a child with another parent, often in cases of divorce, adoption, or surrogacy

synonym: joint parenting, shared parenting

(1) **co-parenting** arrangement, (2) **co-parenting** plan It's important to have a healthy **co-parenting** relationship for the children's sake.

spite

n. feelings of anger and resentment; (in spite of, also despite) a phrase that is used to indicate that something happened or exists even though there is a particular obstacle or difficulty

basement

crate

 a large container, typically made of wood or metal, used for transporting or storing goods

synonym: box, container, receptacle

stream

bond

poet

n. a person who writes poetrysynonym: versifier, rhymer, writer

release

- v. to set free or allow to escape from confinement synonym: free, let go, discharge

syndrome

 beliefs and actions employed to influence supernatural beings and forces; any art or performance that invokes supernatural powers

exciting

adj. causing a lot of interest or excitement synonym: exhilarating, stimulating, thrilling

amaze

possibility

- n. a chance that something may happen or be truesynonym: chance, prospect, likelihood

profitable

adj. making or likely to make material gain or profit synonym: advantageous, beneficial, thriving

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publicly

adv. in a manner accessible to or observable by the public; by the government

synonym: candidly, openly, honestly

She **publicly** denounced the government's mishandling of the economic crisis.

vulnerable

adj. capable of being hurt or influenced physically or mentally

synonym: susceptible, exposed, weak

(1) a **vulnerable** bridge, (2) **vulnerable** parts of the body Infants and pregnant women are particularly **vulnerable**.

grade

- a particular level of quality, size, importance, etc. synonym: score, rate, degree
- (1) boys in the twelfth **grade**, (2) students at all **grade** levels Departments may set requirements for a higher **grade** point average.

shout-out

- a public expression of appreciation or acknowledgment, often given to an individual or group of people, typically used in social media, advertising, or broadcast media synonym: acknowledgment, recognition

exuberant

degree

pickup

a type of vehicle with an open-air cargo bed at the back used for transporting goods or equipment; the act of collecting or gathering someone or something from a particular location; a warrant to take someone into custody

playdate
