### exchange

### coverage

### compassion

 a strong feeling of sympathy and sadness for another's suffering or bad luck

### wipe

### systemic

### anxiety

### disadvantage

#### capita

grand

steady

rotation

#### deem

- v. to empty or dry something by removing the liquid from it synonym: draw off, bleed

#### destruction

### desegregation

firm

### exposure

 the state of being in a particular situation or place where there is no protection from or guarantee to something harmful; the disclosure of something secret

toxic

*adj.* of or relating to or caused by a poison; poisonous *synonym*: poisonous, harmful, contaminated

instrument

 an object used to make musical sounds, such as a piano, guitar, or drum; a tool or device used for a specific activity, particularly in specialist or scientific work

#### mortgage

a loan secured by the collateral of a specific property,
 such as a house, that is repaid over a set period of time
 with interest; the legal agreement governing this loan

#### crisis

 a time of great disagreement, confusion, or danger when problems must be resolved or critical decisions must be taken

The Chinese word for **crisis** comprises two characters, one for danger and the other for opportunity.

### develop

v. to grow or expand; to improve or refine through a process of progress and refinement, often to achieve greater sophistication or complexity; to elaborate or add detail to something that is in the process of being created

synonym: evolve, progress, advance

(1) **develop** a strategy, (2) **develop** a skill

We must **develop** a new system to streamline our workflow and increase efficiency.

### aggressive

adj. behaving in an angry, energetic, or threatening way towards another person; tending to spread quickly

synonym: assertive, combative, threatening

(1) an **aggressive** war, (2) an **aggressive** tumor An **aggressive** tide wrecked the ship.

#### communal

adj. belonging to or used by a group rather than individuals; for common use

synonym: collaborative, combined, collective

(1) **communal** swimming pool, (2) **communal** combination of funds

**Communal** elections were held in several European countries.

#### leafy

adj. covered with or having many leaves; of or relating to plants that produce many leaves, especially those that are broad and flat

synonym: verdant, leaf-covered, foliated

(1) leafy canopy, (2) leafy suburbs

The neighborhood is known for its **leafy** trees and verdant gardens.

#### mount

 to increase, go up, or advance gradually or continuously; to prepare and supply with the necessary equipment for execution or performance; to ride on something or someone

synonym: climb, increase, get on

(1) mount a hill, (2) mount a counterattack

They **mounted** pictures on the paper in preparation for the birthday card.

### pleasant

*adj.* enjoyable, attractive, friendly, or agreeable *synonym*: agreeable, delightful, pleasing

(1) pleasant news, (2) pleasant odor

The hotel's staff is very **pleasant** and efficient.

#### foreclosure

n. the legal process by which a lender repossesses and sells a property or asset due to the borrower's failure to meet loan payments; the act of taking control of or seizing property or assets to satisfy a debt

synonym: repossession, seizure, default

(1) **foreclosure** proceeding, (2) **foreclosure** crisis

The family faced **foreclosure** on their home after falling behind on mortgage payments.

### brokerage

 n. the business of buying and selling goods or services on behalf of others, often for a commission or fee; the activity of acting as an intermediary or agent in negotiations or deals between two parties synonym: agency, firm, house

(1) mortgage **brokerage**, (2) international **brokerage** I need to contact a **brokerage** firm to help me invest my money.

#### refinance

 to obtain a new loan or mortgage by paying off an existing loan or mortgage, often to take advantage of lower interest rates or better terms

synonym: restructure, reorganize, renew

(1) refinance existing debt, (2) refinance loanI want to refinance my mortgage to get a lower interest rate.

#### inflated

adj. swollen or blown up, especially with air or gas; excessively or unreasonably high

synonym: enlarged, swollen, distended

inflated prices, (2) an inflated balloon
 the athlete's ego became inflated by their success.

#### balloon

 a small bag made of thin rubber or other light material that can be inflated with air or gas, used as a toy or as a decoration; (verb) to become inflated

synonym: aerostat, blimp, (verb) billow out

#### prepaid

adj. referring to something that has already been paid for in advance; paid for before it is used or received

#### penalty

- n. a punishment for violating a law, rule, or contract synonym: punishment, sentence, fine

### perception

- a belief, opinion, or image you have based on how you regard, understand, or interpret something; the ability to see, hear, or notice something through the senses

#### afford

- v. to have enough money or time to be able to buy or do something
- (1) **afford** to buy a new car, (2) **afford** a high travel cost He cannot **afford** a holiday.

#### risky

- adj. involving the possibility of danger, failure, or loss synonym: dangerous, perilous, scary
- (1) change **risky** behavior, (2) a **risky** enterprise It is extremely **risky** to sail in such a storm.

#### stereotype

- n. a fixed and unvarying idea or image that people have about what someone or something is like, but which is often not true in reality and may cause hurt and offense
- avoid stereotype, (2) negative stereotypes
   Changing stereotypes about LGBTQ requires considerable effort.

### subprime

- adj. of or relating to financial loans, particularly mortgages, which are made to individuals with poor credit histories or limited income, often associated with higher interest rates and a greater risk of default
- (1) **subprime** lending, (2) **subprime** market The **subprime** mortgage crisis of 2008 led to a global economic downturn.

#### creditor

- a person, company, etc. to whom a debtor owes money
- the creditor's claims, (2) bankrupt creditor

voluntary liquidation.

#### racial

adj. of or related to the race (= classification of humans into groups based on physical traits or social relations)

synonym: ethnic, tribal, ethnical

#### discriminate

v. to treat a person or particular group of people worse or better than another, especially in an unfair way; to recognize or perceive the difference between people or things

### profitable

mold

n. a hollow container used to give shape to liquid or soft substance, which then becomes solid in the same shape as the container; a soft, green, or gray growth that forms on stale food or objects exposed to warm, moist air for too long

### colleague

 one of a group of a coworker, especially in a profession or a business

trillion

#### wealth

### equity

- n. the value of the shares issued by a company synonym: fairness
