synonym: sexuality

#### invention

n. the creation of a new device or process resulting from study and experimentation; the act of inventing

*synonym*: creation, design, innovation

### diagnose

v. to determine or distinguish the nature of a problem or an illness through a careful analysis

synonym: identify, analyze, interpret

### anxiety

 a feeling of worry, nervousness, or unease about something that is happening or might happen in the future

synonym: concern, dread, agita

#### disorder

 an untidy state or a lack of organization; a physical condition or illness that causes problems with how a section of the body or brain functions

*synonym*: chaos, disturbance, disease

The doctor prescribed some medicine for the mental

#### disorder.

### depression

n. a mental condition in which a person feels very unhappy and without hope for the future; a severe recession in an economy or market

*synonym*: recession, slump, despair

**Depression** symptoms might include a decrease in appetite and weight loss.

#### mention

- v. to speak or write about something or someone briefly synonym: reference, allude, cite

#### headache

*n.* pain in the head; someone or something that causes anxiety or trouble

*synonym*: concern, difficulty, problem

### migraine

 a severe headache typically felt as a throbbing pain on one side of the head

synonym: headache, cephalalgia, hemicrania

core

- n. the most essential or fundamental part of somethingsynonym: center, basis, heart

#### **Alzheimer**

 a neurodegenerative disease that causes memory loss, cognitive decline, and behavioral issues; is the most common cause of dementia in older adults synonym: dementia, memory loss, cognitive decline

(1) **Alzheimer's** brain, (2) **Alzheimer's** risk factors My grandmother has **Alzheimer's** disease requires special care and attention from her caregivers.

#### disease

 a disorder or illness that affects the body or mind, often characterized by specific symptoms or abnormal functioning of organs or systems

synonym: illness, ailment, affliction

(1) **disease** prevention, (2) **disease** control

The doctor diagnosed him with a rare **disease** that had no known cure.

#### dementia

- n. a severe decline in cognitive function, especially memory, as a result of disease or injury
   synonym: cognitive decline, memory loss, Alzheimer's disease

### planet

 any of the nine large celestial bodies that circle in the solar system; any celestial body that revolves around a star

#### statistics

- the discipline that concerns the collection, organization, analysis, interpretation, and presentation of data

v. to experience pain, distress, or hardship; to undergo or endure something painful or unpleasant

### lifespan

 the length of time for which a person, animal lives, or thing exists

#### launch

#### medicinal

### menopause

 the natural cessation of menstruation and fertility in women, typically occurring between the ages of 45 and 55

#### isolate

adj. extremely vital or necessary

#### hormone

- a chemical substance made by organs that encourages or influences the development, growth, sex, etc., of an animal and is carried around the body in the blood

#### testosterone

- a male hormone that is responsible for the development of male secondary sex characteristics

#### estrogen

- a category of female steroid sex hormone responsible for the development and regulation of the female reproductive system and secondary sex characteristics

### longevity

 the property of being long-lived; significant duration of service

#### process

n. a series of actions or operations performed to achieve a particular outcome or goal; a systematic procedure or approach used to accomplish a specific task or objective; a method of treating milk to make it suitable for consumption or use in other dairy products

synonym: procedure, method, system

(1) **process** improvement, (2) decision-making **process** The **process** for applying for a visa can be lengthy and complicated.

fade v. to vanish; to

#### midlife

- n. the period of life between young adulthood and old age, typically characterized by a sense of maturity, stability, and sometimes, dissatisfaction or restlessness

#### associate

#### ovary

### flash

n. a sudden intense burst of radiant energy; a momentary brightness

#### sweat

 the salty liquid that is produced by the glands in the skin, especially when the body is hot or under stress

#### insomnia

the condition of being unable to sleep, usually a chronic one

#### lapse

n. a temporary or brief failure in judgment, action, or behavior; a gradual or slow decline, often referring to a loss of performance, quality, or attention; a period of time that has passed; (verb) to fall or slip into a particular state, often one that is undesirable or unintended

synonym: break, failure, blunder

### neurological

adj. of or relating to the science of neurology or the nervous system

#### endocrine

 adj. relating to the glands in the body that secrete hormones directly into the bloodstream to regulate bodily functions and processes

synonym: hormonal, glandular, secretory

The **endocrine** system regulates many bodily functions, including metabolism and growth.

#### involve

v. to include or affect someone or something as a necessary part of something else

### reproduction

 the process by which organisms create offspring; the production of something similar to an original work

 reproduction of the plant depends on the pollinators.

#### **function**

n. the purpose or use of an object, system, or process; a particular activity or operation that is designed to serve a specific purpose; a mathematical concept that describes a relationship between two sets of values, called the input and output sets; (verb) to operate or work in a specific way, or to perform a particular task or purpose

synonym: purpose, mapping, job

(1) function properly, (2) immune function

The brain is an incredibly complex organ that controls the body's **function**.

#### estradiol

 a hormone typically found in females that plays a key role in the development and maintenance of female reproductive tissues and secondary sexual characteristics

synonym: estradiolum, oestradiol

(1) **estradiol** supplementation, (2) **estradiol** replacement therapy

Low levels of **estradiol** can lead to menstrual irregularities.

#### cellular

adj. of or connected with the cells of animals or plants; of or connected with a mobile telephone system that uses several short-range radio stations instead of wires

synonym: organic, biological, nuclear

(1) **cellular** and molecular biology, (2) a **cellular** phone handset

This factory employs a **cellular** manufacturing system.

#### neuron

- a cell that is specialized to carry information within the brain and between the brain and other parts of the body
   synonym: nerve cell

### glucose

a type of sugar that is found in plants, especially fruit,
 and is an essential energy source in living things

synonym: sugar, blood sugar

#### decline

v. to become gradually smaller, fewer, worse, etc.; to refuse to accept

### amyloid

 a type of protein that can accumulate abnormally in various tissues and organs in the body and is linked to various diseases, including Alzheimer's disease

(1) **amyloid** beta, (2) **amyloid** accumulation Alzheimer's disease is characterized by the buildup of **amyloid** plaques in the brain.

### plaque

n. a flat, often rectangular, piece of metal, wood, or other material, inscribed or carved with commemorative text or designs and used as a decoration or award; a soft, sticky film of bacteria that coats teeth and can cause tooth decay

### specific

adj. clearly defined or particular to a certain thing or situation; distinct, explicit, and precise

### hypothalamus

- n. a basal part of the brain that autonomically controls body temperature, hunger, and the release of hormones
- anterior hypothalamus, (2) hypothalamus hemorrhage
   Oxytocin is also produced in the nucleus of the hypothalamus.

### regulate

 to control something, especially by means of rules or laws

synonym: control, restrain, handle

(1) **regulate** blood sugar levels, (2) **regulate** our conduct We must manage to **regulate** our expenditure.

### temperature

- n. the degree of hotness or coldness of a thing or placesynonym: climate, warmth, degree
- (1) extreme **temperatures**, (2) the atmospheric **temperature**

Cities around the world set records for highest **temperatures** this summer.

#### stem

n. the central part of something from which other parts can develop or grow; the part of a word common to all its inflected variants; (verb) to grow out of, have roots in, or originate in

synonym: branch, limb, (verb) come from

(1) **stem** from a belief, (2) the **stem** of a matchstick A rose has thorns on its **stem**.

### amygdala

- one of two parts of the almond-shaped neural structure that are linked to emotions, especially fear and pleasure, memory, and the sense of smell
- (1) the decline in **amygdala** activity, (2) **amygdala** damage The **amygdala** has been associated with memories of past emotional events.

#### emotional

adj. relating to people's feelingssynonym: affecting, impactful, impressive

(1) emotional health, (2) emotional distress

Human **emotional** responses vary widely depending on the society to which they belong.

### hippocampus

- a major component of the brain of humans and other vertebrates that is part of the limbic system and is vital for memory

#### ebb

 the movement of the tide out to sea; low tide; (verb) to flow back or recede

### mood

 the way you feel at a particular time; an angry or impatient state of mind

### anatomy

- n. the scientific study that deals with the physical structure of humans, animals, or plants

#### scan

 to examine something hastily, with the eyes or with a machine, to get information

synonym: look over, scrutinize, browse

### positron

 an antiparticle of the electron with a positive charge that has the same mass as the electron but an opposite charge synonym: antielectron, antiparticle, positronium

(1) **positron** emission, (2) **positron** annihilation **Positron** emission tomography, or PET, is a medical imaging

technique.

#### emission

- n. the act of production or sending out gas, heat, light, etc.synonym: emanation, radiation, discharge
- (1) global **emissions** of greenhouse gases, (2) the **emission** of light

There are five distinct **emissions** at five unique wavelengths.

### tomography

 a diagnostic imaging technique used to produce detailed images of structures inside the body, typically by using X-rays, CT scans, or ultrasound

synonym: imaging, scanning, x-ray

- (1) acoustic **tomography**, (2) **tomography** image
  The **tomography** scan showed a clear image of the patient's internal organs.
- an animal that you have at home as a companion and treated kindly
- (1) a **pet** bird, (2) a teacher's **pet** I have a parrot as a **pet**.

### belong

pet

v. to be the property of someone or something; to be a member or part of a group; to be in the proper or appropriate place

synonym: fit, be appropriate, be suitable

(1) **belong** to different species, (2) **belong** to a group All the books in this section **belong** to the library's rare collection and must be handled carefully.

### purple

adj. of a color intermediate between red and blue synonym: violet

(1) deep **purple**, (2) **purple** sweet potatoes The plant has a stunning **purple** blossom.

### gradual

adj. happening slowly over a long period of time or distance; not steep or abrupt

synonym: incremental, gradational, piecemeal

(1) a gradual process, (2) a gradual change

The country experienced a **gradual** increase in population.

#### transition

 the process or period of changing from one state or circumstance to another

synonym: change, growth, shift

(1) **transition** phase, (2) ensure a smooth **transition**The nation's healthcare system is in **transition** at the moment.

### independence

- n. freedom from another's or others' control or influencesynonym: freedom, liberty, autonomy
- (1) financial **independence**, (2) **independence** ceremony There is nothing more valuable than **independence** and freedom.

#### confirm

v. to support or establish the truth or certainty of something previously believed or suspected to be the case

synonym: affirm, verify, assure

(1) **confirm** the diagnosis, (2) **confirm** a transaction Please write to **confirm** your reservation.

#### sensitive

adj. able to notice slight changes, signals, or influences; able to feel or perceive other's feelings; susceptible to the things people say or do

synonym: exposed, susceptible, keen

(1) **sensitive** documents, (2) baby with **sensitive** skin The teacher is very **sensitive** to children's feelings.

### straight

adj. extending or moving in one direction without bending or curving; having no deviations

synonym: linear, honest, consecutive

(1) a straight line, (2) straight for two months

He was sick for five **straight** days.

### chronological

adj. arranged in the order in which events occurred synonym: sequential, linear, temporal

(1) **chronological** progression, (2) sorted in **chronological** order

He presented the timeline of the project in a **chronological** sequence.

#### validate

- v. to check or prove that something is true; to make something officially or legally acceptable or approved
   synonym: approve, certify, verify

### clarify

v. to make something, such as a statement or situation, less confusing and more understandable

synonym: explain, ascribe, purify

(1) clarify a goal, (2) clarify his feelings

#### crazy

adj. stupid or not sensible; very angrysynonym: insane, absurd, bizarre

### adjust

v. to make a minor modification to something to make it more suited for a new set of conditions or to make it function better.

synonym: adapt, alter, acclimate

### underperform

v. to perform less successfully or effectively than expected, needed, or desired; to fail to meet one's own or others' expectations or standards

#### cognitive

#### forbid

### absolutely

adv. without restriction or limitation; completely or utterlysynonym: completely, utterly, definitely

I am absolutely opposed to his idea because of morality.

#### deserve

v. to be worthy of or entitled to something, especially something good or valuable

synonym: merit, earn, justify

(1) deserve respect, (2) deserve this prize

The employee **deserved** the promotion for their hard work and dedication.

#### promote

v. to encourage or persuade people to like, buy, use, do, or support something; to raise someone to a higher position or rank

synonym: boost, raise, advertise

(1) **promote** a better relationship, (2) **promote** bad behavior The government should do more to **promote** sustainable agribusiness.

### develop

v. to grow or expand; to improve or refine through a process of progress and refinement, often to achieve greater sophistication or complexity; to elaborate or add detail to something that is in the process of being created

synonym: evolve, progress, advance

(1) **develop** a strategy, (2) **develop** a skill We must **develop** a new system to streamline our workflow and increase efficiency.

### insight

 the ability to gain an accurate and deep understanding of people or situations; an accurate and deep understanding of what something is like

synonym: wisdom, discernment, understanding

(1) a profound **insight**, (2) share my **insights**We gained various **insights** by analyzing the vast amount of data owned by the company.

### negative

adj. having the quality of something bad or harmful; expressing refusal

synonym: minus, adverse, pessimistic

(1) have a **negative** effect, (2) a **negative** number The movie has received almost universally **negative** criticism.

#### clinical

adj. of or relating to the examination and treatment of patients rather than theoretical or laboratory studies

synonym: dispassionate, analytic, scientific

(1) **clinical** surgery, (2) participate in **clinical** trials She received special **clinical** training at the hospital.

#### medical

adj. relating to the treatment of illness or injuries; relating to the practice of medicine

synonym: health, disease, treatment

(1) a **medical** opinion, (2) temporary **medical** treatment The **medical** team worked quickly to save the patient's life.

#### intervention

- n. the action or process of being done to improve or help a circumstance, often they have not been asked to do sosynonym: interference, intercession, treatment
- (1) **intervention** by foreign powers, (2) surgical **intervention**

This **intervention** does not require the patient's consent.

### hysterectomy

 a surgical procedure that involves the removal of part or all of the uterus, typically performed to treat certain medical conditions such as uterine cancer or severe endometriosis

synonym: uterus removal

She hesitated to undergo a **hysterectomy** because of the potential risks and side effects.

### oophorectomy

 a surgical procedure that involves the removal of one or both ovaries from a woman's body, often performed to treat cancer or other conditions affecting the ovaries or to prevent pregnancy

synonym: ovariectomy, ovarian surgery
