#### balance

### government

 the group of people with authority to control a country or state

### tradition

synonym: custom, practice, ritual

### monetary

*adj.* of or relating to the money in the country *synonym*: financial, fiscal, economic

### policy

n. a set of rules, guidelines, principles, or procedures that govern decision-making or action, often used in the context of business or government; a course of action or plan of action adopted or followed by an organization or individual to achieve a goal or objective

#### federal

#### reserve

### treasury

 the government department in charge of managing public funds; the funds of a government or institution or individual

synonym: discern, distinguish, separate

fun

### entity

something that exists independently and has its own identity

synonym: body, object, existent

A company is a distinct legal **entity**.

#### collaboration

 the act or situation of working together to create or produce something

*synonym*: affiliation, alliance, coalition

(1) **collaboration** between companies, (2) **collaboration** platform

#### wealth

 a large amount of money, property, or other things that someone or an organization owns

synonym: affluence, assets, fortunate

#### distribute

#### confident

### template

 a pre-designed file or document used as a starting point for a particular application so that the format does not have to be created from scratch

synonym: pattern, model, blueprint

### convey

 to express ideas, feelings, etc. so that it is known or understood by other people; to carry something from one place to another

synonym: communicate, transfer, deliver

### absolutely

adv. without restriction or limitation; completely or utterly synonym: completely, utterly, definitely

### economy

n. the system by which a country or region produces manages, and distributes goods and services, including the money and finances involved in these activities; (of an airline) the lowest-priced, most basic option for seating in commercial travel

synonym: finance, trade, business

The **economy** of the country is struggling due to the recent political instability.

#### invention

 the creation of a new device or process resulting from study and experimentation; the act of inventing

### volatile

adj. likely to change rapidly or unexpectedly, or being unstable or explosive

synonym: unstable, unpredictable, explosive

### cycle

 an interval during which a recurring sequence of events occurs; a bicycle or motorcycle

synonym: revolution, rotation, bike

### recession

 a period of economic decline, typically lasting for six months or more, during which trade and industrial activity decrease, and unemployment increases

### expansion

 the process of becoming larger or more extensive, or the result of this process

synonym: growth, enlargement, development

#### boom

 a sudden increase in economic activity, or a sudden happening that brings good fortune; a deep, loud, and

### prolonged sound

#### woods

### wipe

### largely

### traditionally

#### breakdown

- n. a failure or collapse of a system or organizationsynonym: collapse, failure, malfunction

#### influence

 the ability to affect someone's or something's character, growth, or behavior, or the effect itself

synonym: power, leverage, effect

#### internal

*adj.* of or relating to the inside of something *synonym*: interior, inner, domestic

### pursue

### revolution

### democracy

### competition

 a situation in which someone is attempting to beat or outperform another synonym: contest, match, fight

### capitalism

- n. an economic system based on the private ownership of the means of production and their operation for profitsynonym: commercialism

### definitely

- adv. without any question and beyond doubt; clearlysynonym: absolutely, certainly, indeed

### evocative

*adj.* tending to evoke or bring something to mind *synonym*: suggestive, stimulating, provocative

### digit

### unemployed

adj. not having a job, although able to worksynonym: idle, inactive, jobless

### magnitude

- n. the extent, level, importance, or amount of something synonym: size, extent, level
- (1) a star of the first **magnitude**, (2) the **magnitude** of the disaster

### dynamics

n. the branch of mechanics that deals with the motion of bodies under the action of forces, including the particular case in which a body remains at rest; forces that produce or stimulate movement, growth, or change

synonym: mechanics, kinetics, kinematics

  The relationship **dynamics** between the two countries were complex and constantly changing.
- to surpass or go beyond a limit, expectation, or requirement; to be better or greater than anticipated or desired

### structure

exceed

 the way of construction of something and the arrangement of its parts, or a complex thing constructed of many parts

synonym: construction, architecture, establishment

The organizational **structure** of start-ups is often flat and straightforward.

#### lever

 a handle used to operate a vehicle or a machine; a rigid bar resting on a pivot so that one end of it can be pushed or pulled easily

synonym: lifter, crowbar, bar

### austerity

n. the state or condition of being stern, rigid, or uncompromising, or being simple or plain; an economic policy or measure that seeks to reduce government spending and debt

#### restructure

- v. to organize a company, business, or system in a new and different way to make it work more effectivelysynonym: reorganize, revamp, reconstruct

### forgiveness

### process

n. a series of actions or operations performed to achieve a particular outcome or goal; a systematic procedure or approach used to accomplish a specific task or objective; a method of treating milk to make it suitable for consumption or use in other dairy products

synonym: procedure, method, system

(1) **process** improvement, (2) decision-making **process**The **process** for applying for a visa can be lengthy and complicated.

### rebuild

v. to build again or anew

synonym: reconstruct, renovate, restore

### creative

adj. relating to or involving the use of skill and original and unusual ideas to create something

synonym: imaginative, innovative, inventive

(1) creative writing, (2) barren of creative spirit

adj. able to come up with novel and unique ideas synonym: imaginative, creative, innovative

### adaptable

adj. able or willing to modify or be modified to deal with new situations

### adaptation

the action or process of changing to suit different conditions

*synonym*: adaption, adjustment, transformation

(1) **adaptation** ability, (2) language **adaptation**The company's **adaptation** approach has been highly effective.

### wiggle

v. to move or cause to move up and down or from side to side in short and quick movements

synonym: wiggle, jiggle, squirm

(1) **wiggle** her lips, (2) **wiggle** with excitement Her hips **wiggle** as she walks.

### digital

adj. processing or storing information as a succession of 1
 and 0 to show that a signal is present or missing;
 relating to the use of computer technology, especially

### environment

### vicinity

### currency

### giant

### self-sufficient

#### threat
