n. a hard, gray stone that can produce sparks when struck with steel used historically to start fires; a type of microcrystalline quartz used for making tools, weapons, and jewelry

*synonym*: hardstone, tinder, firestone

The archeologist found a **flint** arrowhead on the dig site.

Zion

n. a term used in the Bible to refer to the hill in Jerusalem, which is the symbolic center of Jewish worship and identity; in a broader sense, Zion sometimes refers to the Jewish people, the land of Israel, or the idea of a promised homeland for the Jewish nation

synonym: jerusalem, promised land, holy city

(1) going up to **Zion**, (2) the ancient land of **Zion**The Jewish people strongly connect to **Zion** as a symbol of their homeland and identity.

obsessive

 adj. relating to or characterized by an obsession or excessive interest in a particular thing or activity; tending to dwell on or repeat certain thoughts or behaviors

synonym: compulsive, fixated, besetting

(1) obsessive-compulsive disorder, (2) obsessive

### thoughts

Her **obsessive** behavior towards perfectionism often led to burnout.

#### facet

 one of the many aspects or sides of a subject or situation, especially when seen from different angles or perspectives; a particular feature or characteristic of something

synonym: aspect, side, angle

(1) facet to a question, (2) important facet

The different **facets** of his personality make him a complex individual.

#### contaminate

v. to make something impure, unclean, or poisonous by contact or mixture

synonym: defile, pollute, adulterate

(1) **contaminate** with a disease, (2) **contaminate** his ego We strive not to **contaminate** the environment when demolishing petroleum plants.

#### whit

- n. a very small or insignificant amount or quantity, often used in the phrase "not a whit," meaning not at all synonym: bit, atom, smidgen
- (1) a **whit** of evidence, (2) not a **whit** of difference His argument had a **whit** of truth, but it was primarily exaggerated.

#### infect

 to affect a person, an animal, or a plant with a disease-causing organism

synonym: pollute, contaminate, affect

(1) **infect** other animal species, (2) **infect** a computer with a virus

Children often **infect** parents with this head cold.

# Legionella

 a bacterium found in water sources responsible for causing Legionnaires' disease, a serious form of pneumonia (1) **Legionella** infection, (2) **Legionella** outbreak **Legionella** bacteria can be found in natural water sources such as rivers and lakes.

#### autoimmune

- adj. relating to a condition in which the body's immune system attacks and destroys healthy body tissue, mistaking it for harmful foreign substances
- (1) insulin **autoimmune** syndrome, (2) **autoimmune** disorder

The presence of certain substances triggered the **autoimmune** response.

### **lupus**

- an autoimmune disease that can affect various parts of the body, including the skin, joints, and internal organs, and is characterized by inflammation and tissue damage
- (1) drug-induced **lupus**, (2) **lupus** treatment Treatment for **lupus** depends on the severity of the disease and may include medication, lifestyle changes, and regular check-ups with a rheumatologist.

### inequity

a lack of fairness or justice; an unfair or unequal situation or practice

synonym: injustice, unfairness, bias

(1) **inequity** in education, (2) market **inequity**There's an **inequity** in the criminal justice system that needs to be addressed.

# deregulation

 the process of reducing or removing government regulations and restrictions in a particular industry or sector, often to promote competition and reduce costs

synonym: liberalization

(1) **deregulation** of the economy, (2) aviation **deregulation** The government's **deregulation** of the telecommunications industry led to increased competition.

#### cofounder

one of several people who establishes an organization or starts a business

(1) **cofounder** of the university, (2) late **cofounder** He is the **cofounder** and chairman of this tech company.

#### facade

the face or front of a building, especially a large one;
 superficial or false appearance intended to conceal something unpleasant

synonym: front, camouflage, masquerade

(1) the outside **facade** of a castle, (2) **facade** of wealth A gentle **facade** concealed his powerfulness.

#### billboard

 a large outdoor sign or display that is used for advertising, marketing, or public information, typically located along highways or main roads

synonym: hoarding, signboard, advertisement

(1) **billboard** advertising, (2) digital **billboard**The new **billboard** on the highway promotes a popular vacation destination.

#### nestle

- v. to settle comfortably or cozily into a place synonym: snuggle, cuddle, curl up
- (1) **nestle** deeper against him, (2) **nestle** in a cozy spot The cat **nestled** in my lap and fell asleep.

#### aquifer

- an underground layer of rock, sand, or Earth that can take in and hold water
- (1) **aquifer** soil, (2) subsurface **aquifer**Some areas melt snow by harnessing heat from underground **aquifers**.

#### countdown

n. a counting sequence leading up to an event, often marked by a series of signals or cues, also used as a term to describe the final stages leading up to a major event or deadline

synonym: timer

(1) **countdown** clock, (2) wedding **countdown**The **countdown** to launch began as the astronauts prepared for their mission.

#### institutionalize

v. to establish or make something a part of an institution (= a place such as a university, hospital, etc.)

synonym: formalize, establish, regularize

(1) **institutionalize** a system, (2) **institutionalize** customary laws

The new policy aims to **institutionalize** the use of renewable energy sources.

#### manslaughter

 the killing of a person by another person, but without the intent to cause death, often resulting from reckless or negligent behavior or actions

synonym: unintentional homicide, accidental killing

(1) manslaughter charge, (2) involuntary manslaughter The lawyer argued that his client's actions didn't constitute murder but were a case of manslaughter due to lack of intent.

#### condensation

n. the process by which water vapor in the air turns into a liquid when it comes into contact with a surface that is cooler than the air; the act of making something more concise or shorter

synonym: vaporization, evaporation, precipitation

(1) **condensation** nuclei, (2) **condensation** of ideas The **condensation** on the window was a clear sign of the high humidity.

# lightheaded

adj. feeling dizzy, weak, or faint; having a sensation of being slightly detached from reality or detached from one's surroundings

synonym: dizzy, giddy, faint

(1) become **lightheaded**, (2) **lightheaded** from dehydration After the rollercoaster ride, I felt **lightheaded** and needed to sit down.

#### overwhelm

v. to defeat someone or something by using a great deal of force; to have a strong emotional effect on somebody

synonym: conquer, crush, dominate

(1) he was **overwhelmed** with gratitude, (2) **overwhelm** opponents by numbers

Too much variety may **overwhelm** and confuse viewers.

#### barbecue

 a cooking method or apparatus that uses open flames or heated coals to grill or smoke meat, fish, or vegetables; a social gathering or meal characterized by outdoor grilling or barbecuing of food

synonym: grill, cookout, outdoor cooking

(1) barbecue sauce, (2) barbecue grill

The **barbecue** at the park was a hit with all the families who attended.

sip

v. to drink a liquid by taking small mouthfuls; (noun) a small drink

synonym: taste, sample, drink

(1) **sip** a drink, (2) take a **sip** of beer

He **sipped** his tea slowly, savoring the taste.

### poetic

 adj. of or relating to poetry (= a piece of writing that emphasizes the expression of feelings and ideas); using language in an imaginative and expressive way

synonym: literary, verse-like, rhythmic

(1) poetic genius, (2) poetic justice

The sunset was so beautiful it looked like a **poetic** scene from a movie.
