## psychology

#### violent

### intensify

## identity

 the features, emotions, or ideas that distinguish persons

#### from one another

synonym: character, personality, individuality

#### relation

 the way two persons or groups of people feel and act toward one another

*synonym*: association, linkage, connection

(1) **relation** between cause and effect, (2) **relation** of inclusion

## argument

 a set of statements or reasons used to support or refute a proposition or theory; a verbal or physical fight or dispute

*synonym*: debate, discourse, discussion

## fraught

adj. causing, accompanied by, or full of anxiety, tension, or stress

synonym: tense, anxious, stressed

## practical

adj. of or connected with actual use or real situation rather than with theory and ideas

synonym: applicable, functional, realistic

#### posit

v. to suggest or accept something as fact or as a basis for argument or consideration

synonym:

assert, declare, assume

## recognize

v. to acknowledge or realize something or someone; to identify, remember, or become aware of something that was previously known or encountered

synonym: acknowledge, identify, admit

#### underestimate

v. to think or suppose that a quantity, price, or size is smaller than it is

synonym: underrate, misjudge, miscalculate

#### deserve

v. to be worthy of or entitled to something, especially something good or valuable

#### calm

#### confident

adj. feeling sure about your abilities or qualities or having trust in people, plans, or the future

adj. extraordinary, unexpected, or difficult to explain synonym: bizarre, creepy, peculiar

## contradictory

adj. containing or consisting of conflicting or incompatible elements

synonym: conflicting, opposing, inconsistent

(1) apparently **contradictory**, (2) **contradictory** evidence His statements were **contradictory**, leaving the audience confused.

## daisy

- a wildflower that typically has a yellow disc at the center of a white or pink-and-white flowerhead
- synonym: marguerite, bellis, chrysanthemum

## background

- n. the details of a person's social heritage, such as family, vocational or educational experience; past information that is essential to understanding a situation or problem

## papier-mache

#### moderate

#### severe

adj. extremely serious or bad in feeling, manner, or strict and harsh; extremely strong or vigorous

The senator received **severe** criticism from his opponent.

#### autism

- a developmental disorder characterized by difficulties in social interaction, verbal and nonverbal communication
- (1) high-functioning **autism**, (2) **autism** spectrum disorder There is no cure for **autism**, but early intervention and therapy can improve outcomes for individuals with the condition.

## profession

an occupation or vocation requiring advanced education or specialized training

synonym: occupation, vocation, trade

- profession choice, (2) healthcare profession
   Being a doctor is considered a highly respected profession.
- a person who is highly interested and knowledgeable about a particular subject or field, often to the point of being obsessed

synonym: nerd, dork, enthusiast

(1) airplane geek, (2) geek enthusiast

He was a computer **geek** and spent all his free time coding.

#### inherit

v. to receive money, property, or a title from someone after they have died

synonym: obtain, gain, acquire

(1) inherit estate, (2) inherit ancestral property

#### enroll

v. to officially register or sign up for something, particularly a course of study, an organization, or a service

synonym: register, enlist, join

- a person who makes important decisions, especially at a high level in an organization

## affinity

 a natural liking or attraction to something; kinship by marriage or adoption *synonym*: liking, attraction, fondness

(1) affinity group, (2) have a high affinity

He has a strong **affinity** for music and plays multiple instruments.

#### commerce

 the activity of buying and selling things, especially on a large scale

*synonym*: trade, transaction, dealings

(1) interstate **commerce**, (2) the local chamber of **commerce** 

This company has invested heavily in Internet **commerce**.

## suppose

- v. to think that something is likely to be actual or possible synonym: guess, assume, presume
- (1) **suppose** you're right, (2) **suppose** beforehand What do you **suppose** the culprit's motive was?

#### inevitable

*adj.* certain to happen and unavoidable *synonym*: inescapable, unavoidable, sure

(1) **inevitable** changes of the seasons, (2) **inevitable** result In times of recession, an increase in unemployment is **inevitable**.

#### strength

 the quality or state of being physically, or sometimes mentally, strong

synonym: resilience, power, muscles

(1) **strength** of the economy, (2) muscular **strength** Health and **strength** are, above all, gold.

#### outcome

- n. the result or effect of an action, event, etc.
- synonym: result, consequence, effect
- (1) improved student **outcomes**, (2) a desirable **outcome** They awaited news of the **outcome** of the election.

## opportune

adj. suitable or happening at a time that is suitable or convenient for a particular purpose

synonym:

suitable, timely, practical

(1) **opportune** occasion, (2) an **opportune** remark The phone rang at the most **opportune** time.

## scaremongering

 spreading frightening or alarming rumors or ideas, typically to manipulate public opinion in some way; (noun) the act of spreading or promoting fear or anxiety about a particular issue or event, often for political or personal gain

synonym: fearmongering, alarmism, panic-mongering

- (1) **scaremongering** campaign, (2) media **scaremongering** The politician's **scaremongering** tactics were criticized for unnecessarily inflaming public fears and anxieties.
- democracy
- a form of government in which the people have the authority to deliberate and decide legislation, or to choose governing officials to do so

*synonym*: self-government, republic, commonwealth

- (1) **democracy** advocate, (2) principles of **democracy Democracy** often entails inclusive capitalism as well.
- spy

  n. a person who is employed or trained to observe or gather information in secret, often for military or political purposes; a person who secretly or illegally gathers

synonym: agent, undercover operative

information about a private individual or organization

ban

- v. to officially or legally forbid or refuse to allow something synonym: forbid, prohibit, restrict

We should **ban** mildly violent video games from a child's development perspective.

## difficulty

#### solid

## comparison

 the consideration or examination of the similarities between two or more people or things

synonym: equivalence, analogy, contrast

(1) ease of **comparison**, (2) **comparison** of foods on a caloric basis

## economy

 the system by which a country or region produces manages, and distributes goods and services, including the money and finances involved in these activities; (of an airline) the lowest-priced, most basic option for seating in commercial travel

synonym: finance, trade, business

(1) **economy** of scale, (2) **economy** class

The **economy** of the country is struggling due to the recent political instability.

#### restrict

- v. to limit someone's actions or movements, or to limit something to lessen its size or prevent it from increasing

## judgment

the ability to form valuable opinions and make reasonable decisions

synonym: conclusion, decision, determination

(1) an emotional **judgment**, (2) deliver a **judgment**Her **judgments** are consistently rational and sensible.

## develop

v. to grow or expand; to improve or refine through a process of progress and refinement, often to achieve greater sophistication or complexity; to elaborate or add

detail to something that is in the process of being created

synonym: evolve, progress, advance

(1) **develop** a strategy, (2) **develop** a skill

We must **develop** a new system to streamline our workflow and increase efficiency.

#### evaluate

v. to assess or estimate the quality, significance, quantity, or value of something

synonym: assess, estimate, consider

(1) **evaluate** the grant proposal, (2) **evaluate** a situation The meeting aims to **evaluate** possible choices.

#### interact

- v. to communicate or react with somebody synonym: cooperate, combine, collaborate
- (1) **interact** directly with customers, (2) **interact** with one another

He should interact more with his colleagues.

#### embed

- v. to fix or set firmly in a surrounding mass synonym: entrench, fix, set
