adj. having many different parts and small details that all work together

synonym: complicated, convoluted, complex

The politician managed to deal with that **intricate** issue.

## thunk

 a dull, heavy, or muffled sound; the sound made by a blunt or heavy object hitting something solid

synonym: thud, bang, thump

(1) **thunk** sound, (2) the **thunk** of a falling object He heard a loud **thunk** when the heavy box fell off the truck.

#### hatch

v. to cause an egg to break to allow a young animal to come out; to produce and expand something that is in an early stage

synonym: incubate, breed, produce

(1) hatch a plan, (2) hatch a baby chick

The eggs began to **hatch**, and the small chicks emerged.

## sloppy

- adj. characterized by a lack of order or neatness; careless, disorganized, or careless in appearance or performance
- synonym: messy, untidy, disheveled

  She looked **sloppy** in her wrinkled shirt and mismatched socks.

#### tuck

v. to push a stray piece of clothing or material into a particular area or position, especially to make it more orderly or comfortable

synonym: insert, wrap, pinch

You should **tuck** your shirt into your trousers.

## humming

adj. producing a continuous, low, vibrating sound like that of the bee

*synonym*: buzzing, droning, vibrating

(1) humming sound, (2) humming bird

The **humming** of the bees filled the air as she walked through the garden.

#### commute

v. to regularly travel a particular journey, especially between one's home and place of work; (noun) a regular journey of some distance to and from your place of work

synonym: travel, journey, trip

#### robotic

adj. of or relating to mechanical robots; (robotics) the interdisciplinary branch of computer science and engineering with the practical use of robots

## recycle
