breastfeeding

 the act of feeding a baby with milk produced by the mother's breasts

synonym: nursing, lactation, suckling

miraculous

adj. very effective or lucky, or completely unexpected synonym: amazing, astonishing, awesome

ingest

probiotic

 a substance, typically a live bacterium, that is ingested to provide health benefits, particularly in aiding digestion or strengthening the immune system

synonym: probiotic bacteria, beneficial bacteria, microflora

(1) **probiotic** supplement, (2) **probiotic** yogurt **Probiotic-rich** foods, such as kefir and sauerkraut, can improve digestive health.

eczema

- a skin condition marked by itchy, red, hot, and scaly patches, often caused by allergies, irritants, or stress
- *synonym*: dermatitis, rash, skin inflammation

A good moisturizer can help relieve the symptoms of **eczema**.

oligosaccharide

a carbohydrate composed of a small number, typically
 3-10, of monosaccharide (= a type of simple sugar) units

linked together in a chain, often found as components of dietary fiber or added to foods as sweeteners or thickeners

(1) **oligosaccharide** synthesis, (2) plant-derived **oligosaccharide**

The **oligosaccharide** chain present in the protein influences its stability and function.

puzzling
