#### conversation

#### casual

adj. relaxed and informal in manner or dress, not planned or expected; not involving commitment or seriousness

synonym: informal, relaxed, offhand

(1) casual dress, (2) take a casual glance

They had a casual conversation over coffee at the local cafe.

### harry

v. to persistently harass, badger, or bother someone or something; to persistently attack or pursue an opposing force or target

synonym: bother, pester, annoy

(1) **harry** the ship all night, (2) **harry** a suspect I need to **harry** my coworkers to finish the project on time.

slit

n. a narrow cut or opening, often made by a sharp instrument or tool; (verb) to cut or make a long, narrow opening or incision in something, typically with a sharp instrument such as a knife or scissors

synonym: slash, incision, cut

(1) slit pocket, (2) slit the fabric

He made a small **slit** in the paper to fit it in the envelope.

obsess

v. to fill the mind of someone continually so that one can't think of anything else

synonym: torment, beset, engross

(1) **obsess** over her weight, (2) he is **obsessed** with the fear

He's utterly **obsessed** with his promotion.

fangirl

 a girl or woman who is an extremely enthusiastic fan of someone or something, to the point where it may be considered obsessive or extreme

synonym: fan, enthusiast, admirer

(1) fangirl scream, (2) obsessed fangirl

The **fangirl** community organized a charity event in honor of their favorite celebrity.

transform

v. to change in outward structure or looks;

synonym: alter, convert, change

(1) **transform** an education system, (2) **transform** heat into power

My father's death transformed my life completely.

dictionary

 a reference book containing an alphabetical list of words and their definitions, as well as information about their origins, usage, and pronunciation

synonym: lexicon, glossary, vocabulary

(1) dictionary definition, (2) online dictionary

I need to purchase a new English dictionary.

### overly

adv. to a greater degree than is appropriate or desirable synonym: excessively, too much

(1) **overly** excessive, (2) **overly** unnecessary

The movie was **overly** dramatic, with exaggerated emotions and cliched plot twists.

### enthusiastic

- adj. having or showing great excitement, interest, or eagerness; energetic or passionate about somethingsynonym: ardent, fervent, crazy
- (1) **enthusiastic** football fan, (2) **enthusiastic** audience She was **enthusiastic** about starting her new job.

### fan

 a person who admires and supports a person, group, sport, sports team, etc.; a device for creating a current of air by the movement of a surface or surfaces

synonym: lover, devotee, blade

(1) a film **fan**, (2) engine cooling **fan** I'm a big **fan** of French food.

### technique

n. a particular way or art of doing something that needs skill

synonym: approach, procedure, strategy

(1) a **technique** in martial arts, (2) the **technique** applied to construction

Jockey's superior **technique** brought him victory.

### specific

adj. clearly defined or particular to a certain thing or situation; distinct, explicit, and precise

synonym: particular, definite, distinct

(1) **specific** instructions, (2) industry- **specific** regulations The scientist conducted a study that provided **specific** details about the species' behavior.

#### lethal

adj. causing or capable of causing death; extremely dangerous

synonym: destructive, fatal, brutal

(1) lethal injection, (2) lethal weapon

Malignant hypertension is the most **lethal** form of hypertension.

### reputation

 n. the general opinion that people have about someone or something, especially when this is based on their previous experiences or behaviors

synonym: fame, standing, esteem

(1) reputation risk, (2) cloud his reputation

She has a good **reputation** for being one of the best chefs in the city.

### apparently

adv. based on what you have heard or read synonym: evidently, obviously, supposedly

(1) **apparently** simple, (2) **apparently** unrelated The police **apparently** believed this explanation was plausible.

### supposedly

adv. according to what is generally assumed or believed without actually knowing for sure

synonym: seemingly, allegedly, purportedly

(1) **supposedly** identical, (2) neckless **supposedly** made of pure gold

He is supposedly nominated for a Nobel Prize.

### planet

 any of the nine large celestial bodies that circle in the solar system; any celestial body that revolves around a star

synonym: earth, world, globe

(1) **planet** like the Earth, (2) save the **planet** Mercury is the closest **planet** to the sun.

### reputed

adj. widely believed to be a certain way or to have a certain quality, without necessarily being proven or confirmed; having a certain reputation or status based on hearsay or common belief

synonym: alleged, supposed, rumored

(1) reputed company, (2) reputed author

He was a **reputed** expert in his field, known for his groundbreaking research.

### compassionate

adj. feeling or showing sympathy and concern for the suffering or bad luck of others

synonym: empathetic, sympathetic, merciful

(1) a **compassionate** heart, (2) **compassionate** leave My father has a serious and **compassionate** personality.

#### demeanor

 a person's behavior, attitude, or mannerisms, particularly about how others perceive them; the outward expression of one's personality or character

*synonym*: behavior, conduct, manner

(1) **demeanor** towards customers, (2) calm **demeanor**The lawyer's professional **demeanor** helped him win over the jury.

#### tweet

- a short, high sound made by a small bird; a message sent using Twitter, the social media application
- synonym: peep, chirp, post (on Twitter)
- (1) a chick's **tweet**, (2) his latest **tweets** We could hear the **tweet** of baby birds.

### angel

 a spiritual being believed to be a messenger of God often depicted as having wings and a halo

synonym: messenger, spirit, celestial being

(1) angel investors, (2) fallen angel

As she lay on her deathbed, a bright light appeared, and she saw a holy **angel** standing at the foot of her bed.

#### vomit

v. to eject food, blood, etc., from the stomach through the mouth; (noun) the matter ejected from the stomach through the mouth

synonym: puke, throw up, spew

(1) vomit abuse, (2) vomit after ingesting

She felt sick and had to run to the bathroom to **vomit**.

### freeway

 a major highway designed for high-speed traffic, with no stoplights or grade crossings and having interchanges or access roads to other highways

synonym: highway, expressway, motorway

(1) freeway exit, (2) expanded freeway

We got stuck in a traffic jam on the **freeway** for over an hour.

#### sacred

shrine

 adj. connected with religion or religious purposes; worthy of respect or dedication because of a connection with a god

synonym: holy, inviolable, hallowed

- (1) **sacred** music, (2) the halo of a **sacred** image
  This space is a private office **sacred** to the President
- a place considered holy because of its association with a deity or a sacred person or relic or because it is a

synonym: altar, temple, monument

(1) shrine temple, (2) religious shrine

place of pilgrimage or worship

The holy **shrine** to the local saint was a popular place for pilgrims to visit.

#### scroll

 a long roll of paper containing writing; (verb) to move through text or graphics on a screen to view different parts of them

synonym: manuscript, document, parchment

(1) roll up a **scroll**, (2) **scroll** through a document The house owner loved the large hanging **scroll** in the guest room.

totem

 a sacred object or symbol that represents a person, family, clan, or community, often used in indigenous cultures as part of a belief system or religious practice

*synonym*: emblem, symbol, mascot

(1) tribal totem, (2) animal totem

The **totem** pole symbolized the tribe's culture and history, depicting important figures and events.

### lampshade

 a cover or shade that fits over a lamp to diffuse or soften the light; a decorative object used to enhance the aesthetic appeal of a lamp

synonym: lamp cover, shade, light shade

(1) **lampshade** design, (2) patterned **lampshade**She decorated the **lampshade** with colorful ribbons and flowers.

#### fiction

 the type of book or story, especially novels, that describes imaginary events and people; anything made up or imagined that is not true

synonym: fantasy, fable, invention

(1) stuff of science **fiction**, (2) non- **fiction** bestseller Truth is stranger than **fiction**.

### protagonist

the main character in a literary work, film, or other stories

synonym: hero, central figure, leading character

(1) **protagonist** of drama, (2) play a **protagonist**The **protagonist's** triumph over adversity was the theme of this play.

#### romantic

adj. of or relating to love or a sexual relationshipsynonym: idealistic, unrealistic, amatory

(1) **romantic** movies, (2) **romantic** breakup It was his first **romantic** love.

### pregnant

*adj.* having a baby or young animal developing in the uterus *synonym*: expectant

(1) needs of **pregnant** women, (2) a silence **pregnant** with suspense

She vacated the position when she got pregnant.

#### cancer

 abnormal growth of cells that can invade and destroy surrounding tissues and organs; a disease characterized by the uncontrolled growth and spread of abnormal cells

*synonym*: tumor, carcinoma, malignancy

(1) **cancer** diagnosis, (2) **cancer** research

Breast **cancer** is the most common type of cancer in women.

### fugitive

n. a person who is running away or hiding from the law, often to avoid arrest or prosecutionsynonym: escapee, runaway, deserter

(1) **fugitive** from justice, (2) **fugitive** methane emissions The police are searching for the **fugitive** who escaped from prison.

### unthinkable

adj. too unlikely or shocking to imagine or acceptsynonym: impossible, inconceivable, outlandish

(1) an **unthinkable** coincidence, (2) in **unthinkable** trouble That accident was something **unthinkable** with my long experience.

### quitter

 a person who gives up easily or does not have the determination to finish what they have started

synonym: coward, deserter, surrender

(1) easy quitter, (2) serial quitter

He was labeled as a **quitter** after he abandoned the project halfway.

### explode

v. to burst or break open violently and noisily; to cause something to burst or break open

synonym: detonate, blast, rupture

(1) **explode** in anger, (2) **explode** in popularity The old building **exploded** in a fiery inferno.

### crazy

adj. stupid or not sensible; very angry synonym: insane, absurd, bizarre

(1) **crazy** about cars and racing, (2) a **crazy** scheme The rain and thunder are **crazy** today.

#### creepy

adj. causing an uneasy feeling of fear or unease synonym: eerie, unsettling, spooky (1) feel **creepy**, (2) **creepy** atmosphere

The old, abandoned house was **creepy** and gave me the chills.

#### insane

adj. extremely stupid, crazy, or dangerous; mentally ill synonym: crazy, mad, foolish

(1) go **insane** with pleasure, (2) an **insane** scheme Her excessive demands drove me **insane**.

### suddenly

adv. quickly and unexpectedlysynonym: abruptly, unexpectedly, unawares

(1) **suddenly** attacked by an enemy, (2) die **suddenly** Who answers **suddenly** knows little.

#### sidebar

n. a secondary, often informal, discussion or topic that is tangentially related to the main subject of a larger conversation, often taking place during a meeting, trial, or other formal gatherings; (of a newspaper) a small, secondary article or feature that accompanies the main article on a particular topic

synonym: sidebar, ancillary, subtopic

(1) accompanying **sidebar**, (2) legal **sidebar**The judge allowed a **sidebar** conversation between the lawyers and witnesses during the trial.

compile

v. to create a book, a list, a report, etc., by combining various objects, articles, music, etc.

synonym: assemble, collect, gather

(1) **compile** a biography, (2) **compile** the data We are attempting to **compile** a list of qualified candidates for the position.

react

- v. to take action in response to something synonym: respond, reply, oppose
- (1) **react** at a high temperature, (2) **react** against his way of thinking

### psychopath

 a person with an extreme personality disorder characterized by a lack of empathy, remorse, and ethical values; often associated with manipulative and deceitful behavior, impulsivity, and risk-taking tendencies

synonym: sociopath, antisocial, monster

- (1) **psychopath** tendencies, (2) violent **psychopath** The detective identified the **psychopath** who had been terrorizing the city for months.
- v. to warn or arouse to a sense of danger; (adjective) paying close attention or being in a state of readiness for action

synonym: warn, inform, (adjective) vigilant

(1) **alert** consumers to the dangers, (2) **alert** system The company's cybersecurity team **alerted** the CEO to potential threats.

#### mainstream

alert

the ideas, opinions, beliefs, etc., that are considered normal or accepted by most people

*synonym*: prevailing, average, common

(1) join the **mainstream**, (2) **mainstream** political beliefs His thinking is **mainstream** in the country's culture.

#### outlet

 a means of release or expression, often for emotions or energy; a place of business that sells goods directly to customers; a device or opening through which something can flow out

synonym: opening, vent, aperture

(1) an outlet for water, (2) media outlet

The **outlet** in the bathroom was faulty, so I had to use a different one for my hair dryer.

#### banshee

 a supernatural creature or spirit from Irish folklore, typically depicted as a female wailing in mourning to foretell of impending death or tragedy

synonym:

wraith, spirit, specter

(1) banshee howl, (2) wailing banshee

The **banshee's** piercing scream was said to foretell a death in the family.

### journalist

 a person who collects and writes news stories or articles for newspapers, magazines, radio, television, or other online media

synonym: reporter, newsperson, press

(1) a China-based **journalist**, (2) **journalist** on a magazine Foreign TV crews and **journalists** can go as they please in various locations during the Olympics.

### scary

adj. causing fear or fright; frightening; intimidatingsynonym: terrifying, frightening, alarming

(1) scary dream, (2) scary story

The horror movie was so scary that I couldn't watch it alone.

#### excite

- v. to make someone feel suddenly enthusiastic or eager synonym: thrill, exhilarate, animate
- (1) **excite** the crowd, (2) **excite** rebellion The news of her promotion **excited** her.

#### scream

v. to give a loud, high shout suddenly, especially because of fear, anger, excitement, etc.; to utter or declare in a very loud voice

synonym: cry, shout, yell

(1) **scream** a profanity, (2) **scream** at him to be quiet She kept **screaming** for an ambulance.

lung

- either of the two organs in the chest that people and some animals use for breathing
- (1) **lung** capacity, (2) do **lung** transplantation He has terminal **lung** cancer.

#### excitement

- n. a feeling of great enthusiasm and eagernesssynonym: thrill, exhilaration, incitement
- (1) the **excitement** in the business world, (2) aesthetic **excitement**

The **excitement** of the upcoming concert was palpable among the crowd.

#### norm

- n. something that is regarded as usual, typical, or standardsynonym: criterion, mean, standard
- norm of action, (2) cultural norm
   The systems we have developed has accepted as industry norms.

#### concert

 a musical performance given in public by one or more players or singers

synonym: gig, musical, show

(1) have a **concert** again, (2) a benefit **concert** This artist always packs the **concert** halls.

### pathetic

 adj. arousing pity, sorrow, or compassion; expressing or evoking sadness, weakness, or inadequacy; inadequate or inferior in quality or ability

synonym: pitiful, miserable, sad

(1) pathetic attempt, (2) pathetic display

The team's performance was **pathetic** and left the coach feeling disappointed.

### curiosity

- n. a strong desire to know or learn about somethingsynonym: interest, inquisitiveness, novelty
- (1) boundless **curiosity**, (2) satisfy my intellectual **curiosity** We are motivated by **curiosity** rather than necessity.

#### spark

v. to start something or make it grow, especially suddenly; to emit a tiny piece of fire or electricity

synonym: start, inspire, provoke

(1) **spark** his interest, (2) **spark** a chain reaction

The bankruptcy of the giant conglomerate **sparked** turmoil in the stock market.

### judgment

the ability to form valuable opinions and make reasonable decisions

*synonym*: conclusion, decision, determination

(1) an emotional **judgment**, (2) deliver a **judgment** Her **judgments** are consistently rational and sensible.

### suspect

- v. to consider anything to be actual or probable synonym: assume, distrust, surmise
- (1) **suspect** a plot, (2) **suspect** that he is sick The cops **suspected** him of being the killer.

#### backstreet

 adj. located in a less prominent or central area of a city or town, often associated with poorer or seedier neighborhoods or establishments

synonym: underground, illicit, shady

(1) backstreet bar, (2) backstreet deals

The concert was held on a **backstreet** stage, giving it a unique and intimate atmosphere.

### hysteria

n. a state of extreme excitement, fear, or anger that cannot be controlled

synonym: panic, fury, agitation

(1) global warming **hysteria**, (2) anxiety **hysteria** There was mass **hysteria** when the team won a championship.

### legitimate

adj. accordant with or allowed by law; lawful synonym: lawful, honest, fair

(1) a **legitimate** child, (2) **legitimate** question Public political demonstrations are considered **legitimate** rights for citizens.

#### disorder

 an untidy state or a lack of organization; a physical condition or illness that causes problems with how a section of the body or brain functions

synonym: chaos, disturbance, disease

(1) the files are in complete **disorder**, (2) people with bipolar **disorder** 

The doctor prescribed some medicine for the mental **disorder**.

### diagnose

v. to determine or distinguish the nature of a problem or an illness through a careful analysis

*synonym*: identify, analyze, interpret

(1) **diagnose** the problem, (2) **diagnose** with CT scans This device is used to **diagnose** brain cancer and other tumors.

### display

v. to exhibit or show something to others, often to attract attention or demonstrate its features, properties, or value

synonym: show, exhibit, present

(1) **display** merchandise, (2) **display** artwork
We need to **display** our products in an attractive way to attract customers.

### excessive

adj. greater than what seems necessary, normal, or desirable

synonym: unreasonable, exorbitant, inflated

(1) an **excessive** force, (2) take **excessive** care It would be best if you did not demand such an **excessive** charge.

#### emotion

 a strong feeling such as love, anger, etc. deriving from one's situation, mood, or relationships with others

*synonym*: feeling, sentiment, passion

(1) control my **emotion**, (2) afraid to show **emotion**Some **emotions** are common across cultures and backgrounds.

### hysterical

adj. marked by or in a state of excessive or uncontrollable emotion

synonym: agitated, frantic, crazy

(1) hysterical laughter, (2) get hysterical easily

The frustration that had accumulated for a long time made her **hysterical**.

#### womb

 the organ of a woman or female mammal in which a baby develops before birth

synonym: uterus, matrice

(1) tumor of **womb**, (2) **womb** transplant

The fertilized egg implanted itself in the **womb**.

### dysfunction

 a problem or fault in a system, organism, or part of the body or machine

synonym: malfunction, disorder, disfunction

(1) dysfunction of kidneys, (2) brain dysfunction

The **dysfunction** in the relationship was causing problems for both partners.

#### uterus

 a hollow muscular organ in the body of a woman or other female mammal in which a baby or young animal develops before birth

*synonym*: womb

(1) uterus cancer, (2) bleeding from uterus

The physician prescribed medication to relieve the contraction of the **uterus**.

### hysterectomy

 a surgical procedure that involves the removal of part or all of the uterus, typically performed to treat certain medical conditions such as uterine cancer or severe endometriosis

synonym: uterus removal

(1) **hysterectomy** surgery, (2) post- **hysterectomy** recovery

She hesitated to undergo a **hysterectomy** because of the potential risks and side effects.

#### removal

the act of taking something away or off from a particular place

synonym: extraction, elimination, eradication

(1) dental tartar **removal**, (2) **removal** truck

The **removal** of the statue caused much controversy in the community.

#### decide

- v. to make up someone's mind about something; to come to a conclusion or judgment after considering optionssynonym: choose, determine, settle
- (1) **decide** a question, (2) **decide** on a course of action She couldn't **decide** whether to order the pizza or the pasta for dinner.

#### declare

 to say, state, or announce something clearly, officially, or publicly

synonym: announce, state, affirm

(1) **declare** independence, (2) **declare** my love Foreign goods from abroad must be **declared** to customs when entering a country.

### obsession

n. the state in which a person's mind is filled with thoughts of one single object or particular person

synonym: compulsion, fixation, enthusiasm

(1) **obsession** with character, (2) national **obsession**Gambling became an **obsession** for him, and he eventually lost everything.

#### enthusiasm

 a strong feeling of excitement and interest in a particular subject or cause and an eagerness to become involved in it

synonym: eagerness, zeal, willingness

(1) unflagging **enthusiasm**, (2) lose **enthusiasm** We are tackling the development for updates with **enthusiasm**.

#### intellect

n. the ability to think logically and comprehend information, especially at an advanced level

synonym: mind, brightness, cleverness

(1) enrich my intellect, (2) human intellect

Your **intellect** is capable of distinguishing among similar objects.

### separate

- v. to force, take, or pull apart; mark as different synonym: disunite, isolate, ramify
- (1) **separate** video into chapter, (2) **separate** cream from milk

We need to **separate** the aspect of his personality from the part of his competence when making an investment decision.

#### shriek

v. to make a loud and high-pitched cry or scream, often in response to a sudden shock, surprise, or pain; to shout or protest loudly and forcefully

synonym: yell, scream, screech

(1) **shriek** in fear, (2) **shriek** with laughter

The horror film was so scary that it made me **shriek** out loud more than once.

### squeal

v. to make a high-pitched, shrill sound, usually as a result of pain, excitement, or surprise; to reveal something secret or incriminating to an authority figure

synonym: scream, shriek, yelp

(1) **squeal** with delight, (2) **squeal** in agony

The children were playing and **squealing** with excitement in the park.

### instinctively

adv. as a matter of nature or intuition rather than thought or training

*synonym*: inherently, intuitively, naturally

(1) **instinctively** grabbed the knife, (2) **instinctively** bad with children

Some researchers claim that even humans can instinctively

sense earthquakes.

#### flinch

to make a quick, nervous movement in response to pain, fear, or surprise; to draw back or wince involuntarily

synonym: shudder, recoil, wince

(1) **flinch** at the noise, (2) **flinch** from the truth I couldn't help but **flinch** when the door slammed shut.

#### mere

adj. used to emphasize how insignificant or minor someone or something is

synonym: bare, minor, sheer

(1) **mere** acquaintance, (2) **mere** incident

He lost the election by **mere** votes.

### carol

a song or hymn typically sung at Christmas, often with a joyful or celebratory theme

synonym: song, hymn, anthem

(1) Christmas carol, (2) sing a carol

I love the sound of carols playing in the background while we decorate the Christmas tree.

### breath

the air that is taken into and expelled from your lungs; the process of taking into and expelling air from your lungs

*synonym*: air, puff, whiff

(1) hold your **breath**, (2) **breath** of wind

He bated his **breath** when talking about this affair.

### imitate

to copy the speech, behavior, appearance, etc. of someone or something

synonym: mimic, emulate, replicate

- (1) **imitate** painting styles, (2) **imitate** animal sounds He **imitated** the modus operandi of the famous phantom thief.
- to cook food, especially meat or fish, in hot fat or oil synonym: cook, roast, bake

fry

(1) fry an egg, (2) fry over low heat

She devoted herself to **frying** the chicken in a pan until it was crispy and golden brown.

### apathy

- n. lack of emotion, concern, or enthusiasmsynonym: affectlessness, dispassion, indifference
- (1) apathy in the election, (2) political apathy

The global economic crisis has led to pervasive **apathy** and powerlessness.

#### reckon

- v. to think or believe something
- synonym: regard, imagine, suppose
- (1) hard to **reckon**, (2) **reckon** the company as a rival He **reckons** that corruption was rampant in the regime.

### superpower

 a country or nation that has significant global influence or formidable military, economic, or technological strength; a supernatural ability or force capable of extraordinary feats or feats beyond normal human capabilities

synonym: great power, empire, hegemony

(1) **superpower** country, (2) **superpower** leader
The ability to fly like a bird is often considered a **superpower** in comic books and movies.

#### **fearless**

adj. having no fear; brave

synonym: brave, courageous, daring

(1) fearless attitude, (2) fearless bravery

The **fearless** firefighter rushed into the burning building to save a trapped child.

### purity

 the state of being undiluted or unmixed with anything else; the state of being free from immorality, especially of a sexual nature

synonym: sinlessness, innocence, cleanliness

(1) the degree of purity, (2) high purity

Higher **purity** requires additional equipment and energy.

#### celebrate

v. to acknowledge a memorable or good day or event with a social gathering or enjoyable activity

synonym: praise, glorify, honor

(1) **celebrate** his election, (2) **celebrate** Christmas He **celebrated** the 10th anniversary of his tenure.

### apology

 an act of saying or writing that you are sorry for something that has been done wrong or that causes a trouble

synonym: regret, excuse, plea

(1) genuine **apology**, (2) accept his **apology** She wrote a letter of **apology** to the renter.

### culminate

- v. to reach a peak or climax synonym: end, finish, conclude
- (1) **culminate** in a heart attack, (2) **culminate** in failure The event will **culminate** in a grand fireworks display.

#### determination

- n. the quality of being persistent and purposeful; the act of finding out the exact nature or essence of something
   synonym: resolve, willpower, conviction
- (1) a steely **determination**, (2) **determination** of a DNA sequence
