suppose

- v. to think that something is likely to be actual or possible synonym: guess, assume, presume

squirt

to eject or discharge with force in a fast stream or jet; to spray or sprinkle with a liquid or substance

synonym: spray, eject, spurt

(1) squirt water, (2) squirt oil

mustard

a yellow or brown condiment that tastes spicy made from the seeds of various plants; (adjective) between yellow and brown

synonym: condiment, sauce, spice

(1) mustard leaf, (2) black mustard seed

He had to endure the **mustard** gas attack during the war.

pickle

vegetables or fruit preserved in salty water or vinegar served cold with meat, salads, etc.; informal terms for a difficult situation

synonym: jam, predicament, quagmire

(1) pickle a cucumber, (2) pickle barrel

The **pickle** must have an acidity level high enough to inhibit the growth of bacteria.

frustrate

to hinder or prevent efforts, plans, or desires from doing, succeeding, or being fulfilled; to make someone feel upset or annoyed because they are unable to change or achieve something

impressive

reuse

- v. to eject saliva or other liquid from the mouth synonym: expectorate, saliva, spew

grim

 food or drink prepared in a restaurant or store for customers to take and eat elsewhere rather than being consumed on the premises

synonym: takeout, to-go, carry-away

(1) carry-out container, (2) carry-out serviceI need to order some carry-out food for dinner tonight.

virgin

 a person who has never had sex; (adjective) being used or worked for the first time

synonym: virtuous, vestal, beginner

(1) **virgin** material, (2) enter **virgin** territory

Within a few years, no **virgin** forests will remain.

chlorine

n. a chemical element with the symbol CI and atomic number 17, a greenish-yellow gas that is highly reactive and used in a variety of applications, including as a bleach and disinfectant

synonym: element, greenish-yellow gas, bleach

napkin

fiber

 a small piece of cloth or paper used for wiping one's mouth and hands while eating; a decorative cloth placed on a table for formal occasions

synonym: serviette, handkerchief, cloth

(1) paper napkin, (2) linen napkin

I always keep a stack of **napkins** on my desk while I eat to prevent any messes.

speckle

n. a small, irregular spot or marking, often caused by the presence of dust, dirt, or other particles; (verb) to mark or cover something with small, irregular spots or flecks of color

The **speckle** of red on the white porcelain vase made it stand out in the antique shop.

vogue

- the popular or fashionable trend or style of a particular time, especially in clothing, music, or general culture synonym: trend, style, fashion

 Bellbottoms were in **vogue** during the 1970s but are not as popular today.

discuss

v. to talk about or examine in detail through conversation or debate; to exchange ideas, opinions, or information on a particular topic

synonym: talk about, converse, debate

(1) **discuss** options, (2) **discuss** solutions

We need to **discuss** the next steps for the project during our meeting tomorrow.

crusader

n. a person who is committed to a cause or campaign that they see as being beneficial or righteous; historically, a person who took part in the medieval military campaigns to retake the Holy Land from the Muslims

synonym: advocate, activist, ideologue

(1) anti-corruption **crusader**, (2) a **crusader** for justice The history books are full of tales of legendary **crusaders** who went on epic adventures.

reduction

- n. a decrease in size, amount, or degree synonym: diminution, decrease, cutback
- (1) **reduction** strategy, (2) a gradual **reduction**The **reduction** in carbon emissions has been significant since the implementation of the new policy.

ditch

a long, narrow, and shallow depression or channel that is dug into the ground; (verb) to throw away

synonym: trench, channel, furrow

(1) agricultural ditch, (2) ditch my career

The farmers used **ditches** to drain water from their fields.

critic

n. someone who expresses opinions about the quality of books, music, etc.

synonym: pundit, analyst, attacker

collaborate

v. to work with someone else to produce or achieve something

synonym: cooperate, unite, get together

contrarian

 a person who tends to oppose or reject commonly held beliefs or opinions, often for the sake of being different or creating controversy

synonym: dissenter, maverick, rebel

(1) **contrarian** investor, (2) **contrarian** philosophy

The politician's **contrarian** stance on immigration has earned

him a lot of supporters and detractors alike.

folk

 n. people in general, especially those of a particular group or type

synonym: community, family, person

folk art, (2) the folk songs of a particular district
 Some seaweed was used as folk medicine in ancient times.

obvious

adj. easy to see, discover or understand *synonym*: apparent, conspicuous, evident

(1) **obvious** reasons, (2) his conclusion was **obvious** There are **obvious** differences between the two wine-producing regions.

industrious

adj. hardworking, diligent, and persistent in effort *synonym*: diligent, hardworking, assiduous

(1) **industrious** worker, (2) **industrious** student He was known to be very **industrious** and would often work late into the night.

conflict

 a strong disagreement, argument, or a violent clash between two opposing groups or individuals

synonym: clash, discord, competition

(1) the **conflict** between good and evil, (2) the longstanding **conflict**

He and I often had **conflicts**, not only in personality but also in ideology.

vociferous

adj. characterized by loud, insistent, or attention-grabbing verbal expression

synonym: loud, noisy, clamorous

(1) **vociferous** protest, (2) **vociferous** criticism

The **vociferous** fans cheered loudly for their team during the game.

vigilant

adj. keeping careful watch for possible danger or difficulties synonym: watchful, attentive, alert

vigilant watch, (2) vigilant about hand-washing
 The guards had to remain vigilant to ensure the safety of the

high-security facility.

peter

v. to fail or lose power, efficiency, or value gradually before coming to an end

synonym: decrease, drop, lower

(1) eventually **peter** out, (2) begin to **peter** out The music just **petered** out.

liberate

to set free; to release or rescue from captivity or oppression

synonym: emancipate, release, set free

(1) **liberate** people from oppression, (2) **liberate** potential The prisoners were **liberated** after the war ended.

modern

adj. of or belonging to the present time or recent timessynonym: contemporary, stylish, current

(1) **modern** poetry, (2) pre- **modern** agricultural society Their headquarters are in a **modern** skyscraper.

mindset

 the established set of attitudes or fixed ideas held by someone

synonym: attitude, ethos, mentality

(1) flexible **mindset**, (2) the **mindset** in an education system

Countries whose goal is economic development often focus on fostering an entrepreneurial **mindset** in each individual.

vegan

- a person who does not eat or use any animal products, typically for ethical or environmental reasons
- (1) raw food vegan,(2) vegan lifestyleThe vegan diet is based on plant-based foods.

decide

- v. to make up someone's mind about something; to come to a conclusion or judgment after considering options
 synonym: choose, determine, settle
- (1) **decide** a question, (2) **decide** on a course of action She couldn't **decide** whether to order the pizza or the pasta for dinner.

bacon

 a type of salt-cured pork that is usually sliced and fried;
 a meat product that is derived from the back or sides of a pig

synonym: ham, pork belly, gammon

(1) bacon and eggs, (2) bacon sandwichI love the smell of bacon sizzling in the morning.

sausage

n. a type of meat product usually made from pork, beef, or poultry, chopped into small pieces, put in a long tube of skin, then cooked or served cold in thin slices

synonym: bratwurst, wurst, frankfurter

(1) beef **sausage**, (2) German **sausage**The mother sliced off a piece of **sausage**.

stick

to put something, usually a sharp object, into something; to restrict yourself to doing or using one certain thing and not change; (noun) a thin piece of wood or other

material

pastry

 a baked food made of flour, fat, water, and sometimes eggs, sugar, and other ingredients, used as a base or casing for sweet or savory dishes

The chef's specialty is a savory **pastry** with spinach and feta cheese.

gracious

adj. behaving in a kind, polite and generous way synonym: cordial, affable, courteous

welfare

the general health, happiness, and prosperous of a person or group

synonym: well-being, benefit, health

(1) child welfare, (2) a welfare state

influence

n. the ability to affect someone's or something's character, growth, or behavior, or the effect itself

synonym: power, leverage, effect

(1) **influence** a child's future, (2) **influence** the daily life The former emperor had a particular **influence** even after he abdicated.

empathy

 the ability to share another person's feelings or experiences by imagining that person's situation

synonym: compassion, sympathy, tenderness

(1) full of **empathy**, (2) **empathy** for patients

Empathy is also necessary to understand history.

opposed

adj. being completely different from something or disagreeing strongly with something

synonym: anti, averse, hostile

(1) two **opposed** characters, (2) absolutely **opposed** to abortion

I'm strongly **opposed** to that plan.

terrific

adj. causing terror or fear; extremely great or intense; very good or excellent

synonym: fantastic, great, excellent

(1) absolutely **terrific**, (2) at a **terrific** speed

The view from the top of the mountain was **terrific**, with sweeping vistas of the valley below.

recommendation

 an official suggestion that something is good or suitable for a particular purpose or job

synonym: guidance, advice, suggestion

(1) follow his **recommendations**, (2) a letter of **recommendation**

We made a **recommendation** to the client.

temple

 a place of worship, especially one that is associated with a particular religion or faith; the flat area on either side of the forehead

synonym: shrine, mosque, synagogue

(1) temple complex, (2) a tour guide at the temple

He visited the **temple** to pray and make offerings to the gods.

renowned

adj. famous and respected for great achievements, qualities, etc.

synonym: noted, prominent, acclaimed

(1) a **renowned** artist, (2) **renowned** as a novelist

This area is **renowned** for its hot springs.

react

v. to take action in response to something

synonym: respond, reply, oppose

(1) **react** at a high temperature, (2) **react** against his way of thinking

How did he **react** to your idea?

facility

 a building or place that provides a particular service or is used for a particular industry

synonym: building, structure, installation

(1) a cell phone with an internet **facility**, (2) **facility** design This company has an entire recycling **facility**, including major reprocessing plants.

slaughterhouse

 a facility where animals are killed and processed for meat

synonym: abattoir, meatpacking plant, butcher shop

(1) **slaughterhouse** operation, (2) **slaughterhouse** facility The smell of the **slaughterhouse** made him feel sick to his stomach.

handle

- v. to deal with a situation, problem, or strong emotion synonym: control, manage, deal with
- (1) **handle** a precious object, (2) **handled** the incident We all should learn how to **handle** stress.

prod

v. to poke or jab with a pointed object, often to urge or encourage movement or action; to provoke or stimulate someone to take action or respond in a particular way
