#### sabotage

n. the deliberate and malicious damage, destruction, or disruption of equipment, machinery, or other property, often by someone with a particular agenda or motive; the subversion of an organization or institution by secret agents or spies

*synonym*: sabotage, subversion, destruction

(1) act of **sabotage**, (2) **sabotage** mission

The **sabotage** of the factory's equipment caused significant damage.

#### incinerate

- v. to burn something, especially waste material completely synonym: burn
- (1) **incinerate** waste, (2) the power to **incinerate** nations For safety reasons, we must completely **incinerate**

contaminated protective clothing.

#### artifact

 a person-made object, especially one of historical or cultural interest

synonym: antique, relic, heirloom

(1) paleolithic artifacts, (2) Peruvian artifacts

The museum has a vast collection of Greek artifacts.

#### inherit

v. to receive money, property, or a title from someone after they have died

synonym: obtain, gain, acquire

(1) **inherit** estate, (2) **inherit** ancestral property After his death, his sons **inherited** his business.

#### inscribe

 to write or carve something on a surface, especially as a formal or permanent record

synonym: engrave, carve, etch

(1) **inscribe** a message, (2) **inscribe** in her mind clearly The artist **inscribed** a beautiful design on the surface of the vase.

#### overwrite

v. to replace or overwrite existing data or information with new data, often in the context of computer files or software

synonym: rewrite, correct, revise

(1) **overwrite** setting, (2) **overwrite** memory Don't forget to back up your data before you **overwrite** any files on your computer.
