#### gymnastics

- a sport that involves feats of strength, agility, and balance, often performed on apparatus such as a balance beam or a set of parallel bars; any physical exercise that involves movement and agility
- *synonym*: acrobatics, tumbling, contortion
- (1) **gymnastics** competition, (2) **gymnastics** routine **Gymnastics** classes are fun for kids to stay active and learn new skills.

#### nation

 a large organized community of people living in a particular country or region and having a particular culture

synonym: country, state, sovereign entity

(1) nation-state, (2) a seafaring nation

The **nation** of Japan is known for its unique culture and advanced technology.

#### induct

 to formally admit someone to a job or position of authority; to officially introduce someone to an organization or group, or beliefs or ideas

synonym: enlist, recruit, conscript

(1) **induct** them into military service, (2) **induct** a clergyperson to a benefice

We were **inducted** into the honor society.

#### athletics

 the physical activities or sports that involve physical exertion and competition, such as running, jumping, throwing, or walking

synonym: sports, physical activity, exercise

(1) high school **athletics**, (2) professional **athletics**She excelled in **athletics** during high school and went on to compete at the collegiate level.

fame

 the condition of being well-known and discussed by a large number of people as a result of one's accomplishments, abilities, and so on

synonym: celebrity, renown, stardom

- (1) leap into **fame**, (2) his undying **fame**
- Good **fame** is better than a good face.

#### confer

v. to have a meeting or discussion to come to a decision or agreement or exchange ideas; to bestow something

synonym: consult, meet, discuss

(1) confer degree, (2) confer honor

The leaders of the two countries met to **confer** on the issue.

## insight

 the ability to gain an accurate and deep understanding of people or situations; an accurate and deep understanding of what something is like

synonym: wisdom, discernment, understanding

(1) a profound **insight**, (2) share my **insights**We gained various **insights** by analyzing the vast amount of data owned by the company.

#### crisis

 a time of great disagreement, confusion, or danger when problems must be resolved or critical decisions must be taken

*synonym*: concern, problem, emergency

(1) financial **crisis**, (2) **crisis** management The Chinese word for **crisis** comprises two characters, one for danger and the other for opportunity.

honor

 n. high regard or great respect for someone; the quality of having and doing based on a keen sense of morality; (verb) to show respect towards someone

synonym: integrity, virtue, acclaim

(1) womanly honor,(2) honor our ancestorsI claim on my honor that it is true.

## pyramid

n. a polyhedron having a polygonal base and triangular sides with a common vertex; a massive monument with a square base and four triangular sides, begun by Cheops around 2700 BC as royal tombs in ancient Egypt

synonym: monument, edifice, tomb

(1) pyramid architecture, (2) a truncated pyramidThe Egyptian pyramids consist of a vast number of blocks.

#### effusive

adj. expressing feelings of gratitude, affection, or enthusiasm in an unrestrained or excessive way; overflowing

synonym: gushy, demonstrative, unrestrained

(1) effusive welcome, (2) effusive tears

The employee received an **effusive** compliment from their

boss for their hard work.

## applaud

v. to express approval of someone or something by clapping the hands

synonym: clap, celebrate, praise

## championship

 a contest to decide who is the best player or team in a particular sport; the act of providing approval and support

*synonym*: crown, title, contest

(1) a world **championship**, (2) **championship** flag His team won the **championship** for three years running.

elect

v. to choose someone for a specific position by voting for them; to decide or choose to do something

synonym: select, choose, prefer

(1) **elect** the school board, (2) **elect** death

Every five years, the provincial governors are **elected**.

#### award

n. a prize or other mark of recognition given in honor of an achievement

*synonym*: prize, honor, accolade

award ceremony, (2) participation award
 He won the award for best actor at the film festival.

### institutionalize

v. to establish or make something a part of an institution (= a place such as a university, hospital, etc.)

synonym: formalize, establish, regularize

(1) **institutionalize** a system, (2) **institutionalize** customary laws

The new policy aims to **institutionalize** the use of renewable energy sources.

dam

 a wall constructed over a river to block the flow of water, mainly used to generate energy synonym: barricade, barrier, embankment

(1) dam-building program, (2) dam collapsing

The break in the **dam** threatened the valley.

## straight

adj. extending or moving in one direction without bending or curving; having no deviations

synonym: linear, honest, consecutive

(1) a straight line, (2) straight for two months

He was sick for five **straight** days.

#### medal

 a flat, usually circular piece of metal or other material that is often given as an award or commemoration for an achievement, victory, or honor

*synonym*: award, decoration, badge

(1) gold medal, (2) a prize medal

She was proud to receive a **medal** for her hard work and dedication to the sport.

#### athlete

 a person who competes in one or more sports that involve physical strength, speed, or endurance

synonym: player, contestant, jock

(1) become a professional **athlete**, (2) high school **athletes** His dream is to become an Olympic **athlete**.

#### emotional

adj. relating to people's feelings

synonym: affecting, impactful, impressive

(1) emotional health, (2) emotional distress

Human **emotional** responses vary widely depending on the society to which they belong.

## physically

adv. in a way related to a person's body or appearance rather than their mind

(1) **physically** and mentally, (2) stay **physically** fit Having a **physically** healthy physique is essential for a great life.

#### profit

*n.* money that is earned in business or by selling things after deducting the costs involved

synonym: earnings, gain, proceeds

(1) gross profit, (2) make a profit

This business yields little **profit**.

## employee

- n. a person who is hired to work for a business or organization in exchange for wages or salary; a worker synonym: worker, staff, personnel
- (1) **employee** benefits, (2) **employee** evaluation The **employee** handbook outlines the rules and regulations that all employees must follow.

## hyperfocus

 an intense focus on a single task or activity to the exclusion of other things

synonym: zone, intense focus, deep focus

(1) **hyperfocus** state, (2) **hyperfocus** on the economy He had a hard time focusing on anything else because he was in **hyperfocus** on his project.

## component

 one of several parts that combines with others to form something bigger

synonym: element, part, factor

(1) key **component**, (2) spare **components** for cars

The researchers try to discover a common **component** in all types of successful organizations.

## sweep

v. to clean something, especially a floor or an area, by using a broom; move swiftly and smoothly

synonym: clean, clear, brush off

(1) **sweep** up dead leaves, (2) **sweep** a room with a glance The politician tried to **sweep** the embarrassing incident under the rug.

## proverb

 a short saying that expresses a truth or gives advice based on practical experience

synonym: adage, saying, maxim

## damage

v. to harm or cause injury to something or someone, often resulting in decreased value or functionality; to impair or negatively affect something, such as a reputation or relationship; (noun) harm or injury that is caused to a person, thing, or entity

synonym: harm, impair, injure

## develop

redefine

v. to grow or expand; to improve or refine through a process of progress and refinement, often to achieve greater sophistication or complexity; to elaborate or add detail to something that is in the process of being created

synonym: evolve, progress, advance

(1) **develop** a strategy, (2) **develop** a skill We must **develop** a new system to streamline our workflow and increase efficiency.

## champion

someone who has won first place in a competition;
 someone who fights for a specific group of people or a belief

synonym: victor, winner, fighter

(1) a **champion** of peace, (2) the grand **champion** 

The **champion** bicyclist outrode all his competitors.

#### brag

v. to say something in a boastful manner, to impress others, or make oneself feel superior

synonym: boast, swagger, vaunt

(1) **brag** to each other, (2) **brag** about my knowledge Despite his impressive achievements, he refrained from **bragging** about his success.

dictate

- v. to state or give order with total authority; to say or read aloud for somebody else to write down or to be recorded
   synonym: read out, prescribe, order
- (1) **dictate** a letter to secretary, (2) **dictate** to the associate The allies **dictated** the terms of surrender to the country.

appoint

 to give someone a job or role, especially as a public official or member of an organization; to arrange or decide on a time or a place

synonym: designate, assign, name

(1) **appoint** members, (2) **appoint** the day The court **appointed** a guardian for the child.

ballet

- a type of performance dance that tells a dramatic story or expresses an idea with music but no talking or singing
- (1) a **ballet** enthusiast, (2) **ballet** lessons

  She is a leading female classical **ballet** dancer

cartwheel

 a gymnastic move in which a person performs a spinning movement with the body held straight while moving sideways in a handstand position; the wheel of a cart

synonym: sommersault, wheeling, flip

- (1) **cartwheel** kick, (2) attempt a **cartwheel**The gymnast did a perfect **cartwheel** across the mat.
- mimic
- v. to imitate someone's speech, movement, or behavior, especially to make others laugh

synonym: mirror, imitate, ape

(1) **mimic** a human voice, (2) **mimic** numerous instruments He is very popular at school because he can **mimic** all the teachers' accents.

## tough-minded

adj. having a practical, no-nonsense approach to life, often characterized by resilience, determination, and a lack of sentimentality or emotionalism

synonym: resolute, determined, unsentimental

#### relentless

adj. persistent and determined; continuing despite difficulties or setbacks

## sympathetic

#### bullish

## empathy

*n.* the ability to share another person's feelings or experiences by imagining that person's situation

synonym: compassion, sympathy, tenderness

downright

adj. (especially of something bad) complete and absolute; utter; (adverb) completely and absolutely

synonym: absolute, utter, complete

abysmal

adj. extremely bad or unsuccessful, to the degree of being bottomless or unfathomable

synonym: dreadful, terrible, appalling

brash

 adj. self-assertive in a rude, noisy, or overbearing way;
 impetuous; lacking in consideration for consequences or the opinions or feelings of others

synonym: reckless, impulsive, daring

The **brash** young CEO made a lot of enemies with his bold decisions.

solid

*adj.* hard or firm; characterized by good substantial quality *synonym*: stable, reliable, hard

arrogance

- n. excessive self-confidence or self-importancesynonym: hubris, haughtiness, conceit
- (1) brazen **arrogance**, (2) **arrogance** of power He acted with **arrogance** and was not well-liked by his colleagues.

#### demean

v. to lower or damage someone's dignity, honor, or reputation; to treat someone disrespectfully, often in a way that makes them feel inferior or humiliated

synonym: lower, degrade, humiliate

#### belittle

v. to speak or write about someone or something in a way that shows a lack of respect

#### motivate

## bully

## dogmatic

## fortify

#### freshman
