#### normally

adv. usually; under normal conditionssynonym: commonly, generally, naturally

#### economy

n. the system by which a country or region produces manages, and distributes goods and services, including the money and finances involved in these activities; (of an airline) the lowest-priced, most basic option for seating in commercial travel

*synonym*: finance, trade, business

(1) economy of scale, (2) economy class

The **economy** of the country is struggling due to the recent political instability.

## fungus

 a type of organism that includes yeasts, molds, and mushrooms, which are heterotrophic, meaning they do not produce their food and must consume organic matter to survive

synonym: mold, mildew, yeast

(1) fungus infection, (2) symbiotic fungus

Certain types of **fungus** can be toxic to humans, causing severe illness if ingested.

#### consensus

 general agreement or accord in the judgment or opinion reached by a group as a whole

synonym: agreement, accord, harmony

(1) a public **consensus**, (2) **consensus** among scientists The two parties have reached a **consensus**.

## ubiquitous

adj. being or existing everywhere at oncesynonym: universal, omnipresent, everywhere

(1) **ubiquitous** computing, (2) **ubiquitous** across ecosystems

Sugar is ubiquitous in food.

## ecosystem

- all the plants and living creatures in an area and the way they affect each other and the environment
- (1) marine **ecosystem**, (2) change the **ecosystem**

## simultaneously

adv. at the same time

synonym: concurrently, coincidently, together

## persistent

 adj. continuing firmly or obstinately in the course of action despite difficulty or opposition; lasting or enduring without fading or being lost over time

synonym: tenacious, steadfast, unrelenting

(1) persistent cough, (2) persistent data

Despite the setbacks, he remained **persistent** in his pursuit of his dreams.

#### survive

- v. to live or exist despite a dangerous event or period synonym: endure, persist, stay
- (1) **survive** a blizzard, (2) **survive** a plane crash These birds can only **survive** in temperate climates.

#### mass

 a large amount of a substance with no definite shape or form; a large number of people or things grouped or crowded together

synonym: abundance, crowd, mob

(1) a **mass** of molten rock, (2) critical **mass**The **mass** of people who do not own property is politically impotent.

#### extinction

- *n.* the complete disappearance of a species from the earth *synonym*: disappearance, eradication, annihilation
- (1) **extinction** prevention, (2) brink of **extinction**The **extinction** of the dinosaurs is thought to have been caused by an asteroid impact.

#### rely

v. to require a specific thing or the assistance and support of someone or something to continue, run properly, or succeed.

synonym: depend, count, lean

(1) **rely** on convenience stores, (2) **rely** entirely on him Babies heavily **rely** on others for food.

## cognition

n. the psychological process of perception and learning and reasoning; the mental action or process by which knowledge and understanding are developed in the mind

synonym: awareness, understanding, comprehension

(1) social **cognition**, (2) **cognition** disorder

The professor focused on the research of infant **cognition**.

#### decision

 the act or process of making up someone's mind about something; a choice or judgment reached after considering options

synonym: choice, determination, judgment

(1) decision authority, (2) a selfish decision
She was struggling to make a decision between two job offers.

beg

v. to ask for something urgently or earnestly; to appeal to someone to do something

synonym: plead, implore, entreat

(1) **beg** the question, (2) **beg** for help

She **begged** her parents to let her go to the concert.

cheat

v. to act dishonestly or unfairly to gain an advantage or to deceive someone; to break the rules or laws

synonym: deceive, swindle, defraud

(1) **cheat** on my taxes, (2) **cheat** in a game

Even though he knew it was wrong, he cheated on the exam.

#### absence

 the fact or condition of being away from a place where they are typically anticipated to be

synonym:

dearth, scarcity, lack

absence from work, (2) a leave of absence
 Another critical factor of child poverty is the father's absence.

#### colon

- the punctuation mark (:) used to introduce a list, summary, explanation, etc., or before reporting what someone has said; a significant part of the large intestine, the final section of the digestive system
- (1) **colon** examination, (2) the **colon** at the end of the sentence

Consumption of vegetables may aid in the prevention of **colon** cancer.

#### arbuscule

n. an intricate, tree-like structure that forms in the tissues of plant roots as a result of a symbiotic relationship with certain types of fungi, allowing for increased nutrient absorption

synonym: root hair, fungal penetration

(1) **arbuscule** formation, (2) **arbuscule** morphology **Arbuscule** symbiosis is a type of mycorrhizal association between plants and fungi.

## mycorrhiza

n. a mutually beneficial association between a fungus and the roots of a plant, in which the fungus helps the plant absorb water and nutrients, and the plant provides the fungus with sugars produced through photosynthesis

synonym: fungus, root, relationship

(1) mycorrhiza fungi, (2) orchid mycorrhiza

Some studies have shown that plants grown in soil with a high population of **mycorrhizal** fungi are more resistant to drought and disease.

## complexity

 the state or quality of being complicated or intricate and difficult to understand

synonym: intricacy, sophistication, elaboration

cognitive complexity, (2) complexity theory
 project's complexity made it difficult for the team to

complete it on time.

## underground

adj. under the surface of the ground; a secret group organized to achieve a specific purpose, such as overthrowing the government or occupying a force

synonym: subterranean, subsurface, confidential

(1) water flowing **underground**, (2) **underground** activist Having **underground** parking has been very beneficial throughout the winter.

#### filament

 a thin wire or thread, especially one used to produce light in an electric bulb

synonym: fiber, thread, filament

(1) filament lamp, (2) carbon filament

The **filament** in the light bulb burned out, and now it's not working.

#### thread

n. a fine cord of natural or synthetic fibers or filaments, such as cotton or nylon, used in sewing, knitting, or weaving; a series of connected messages or comments on a social media platform or online forum, often related to a particular topic; a sequence or line of events, ideas, or actions that are connected or related; (verb) to pass a thread through a needle or other small opening, in preparation for sewing or stitching

synonym: filament, string, yarn

(1) thread a catheter, (2) start a new thread

The detective followed a **thread** of clues which ultimately led to the suspect's arrest.

#### cotton

- a plant that is grown in warm countries and bears bolls containing seeds with soft and long hairs that are made into textile fiber and thread for sewing
- (1) cotton cloth, (2) culture of cotton

The price of raw **cotton** continued to rise.

#### subway

- n. an underground railway system, typically in a citysynonym: underground, metro, tube
- (1) **subway** train, (2) rapid transit **subway**He took the **subway** to work every day to avoid traffic congestion.

#### unload

 to remove contents of something from a vehicle, ship, container, etc.

synonym: empty, offload, unpack

(1) **unload** the cargo, (2) **unload** a dishwasher He had to **unload** the merchandise before the Black Friday bargain.

#### dense

adj. containing a large number of people or something with little space between them

synonym: heavy, thick, idiotic

nutrient- dense foods, (2) dense forests
 The entire mountain is covered in dense rainforest.

## roughly

adv. approximately but not precisely; with a violent manner synonym: approximately, more or less, around

(1) **roughly** explain my idea, (2) **roughly** speaking Five miles is **roughly** similar to eight kilometers.

## gram

- a metric unit of weight equal to one-thousandth of a kilogram
- (1) centimeter- **gram-second** system, (2) **gram** amount How much is it per one hundred **grams?**

#### dirt

 soil, dust, or any substance that makes a surface not clean; the part of the earth's surface consisting of humus and disintegrated rock

*synonym*: filth, grime, muck

(1) dirt road, (2) dirt track

The garden was filled with **dirt** and needed to be tilled before planting.

#### thimbleful

a small amount of liquid that would fit into a thimble (= a small, bell-shaped implement); a very small amount or quantity of anything

synonym: tiny amount, small quantity, wee bit

(1) thimbleful of water, (2) thimbleful of coffee

I only need a **thimbleful** of sugar for my tea, and I don't like it too sweet.

#### soil

- n. the top layer of Earth in which plants grow synonym: earth, ground, mud
- (1) **soils** retentive of moisture, (2) parched **soil**

**Soil** moisture is another significant component controlling soil respiration.

#### shrub

 a woody plant that is smaller than a tree and has several main stems emerging from the soil

synonym: bush, hedge, fern

(1) tree and **shrubs**, (2) small **shrub** 

These are **shrubs** with no trunks that rarely grow taller than 3 meters.

#### vine

- a climbing plant that produces grapes; any plant with a growth habit of trailing or climbing stems
- (1) a green vine, (2) vine of ore

A **vine** remains productive throughout the year.

#### associate

v. to mentally connect someone or something with someone or something else

synonym: tie in, link, consociate

(1) **associate** alcohol with gambling, (2) **associate** with people widely

The majority of consumers associate this brand with quality.

## jargon

n. specialized language or vocabulary used by a particular group or profession that is often difficult for outsiders to understand; language that is full of technical slang or obscure terms and is often used to obscure or confuse

## rather than clarify

synonym: lingo, vernacular, slang

(1) business jargon, (2) scientific jargon

The financial industry is notorious for using complicated jargon that confuses consumers.

## surprisingly

adv. in a way that causes amazement or wonder synonym: exceptionally, notably, unusually

(1) surprisingly advanced culture, (2) have surprisingly little effect

The exam was **surprisingly** tricky for everyone.

## strategy

a detailed plan of action designed to achieve a long-term or overall goal.

synonym: approach, procedure, scenario

(1) military **strategy**, (2) develop a **strategy** 

Our plan includes a comprehensive marketing **strategy**.

## exchange

to give something and receive something else in return, often with the implication that the items being traded are of equal or comparable value; (noun) the act of giving or taking something in return for something else; a place or system where goods or services can be bought, sold, or traded

*synonym*: trade, swap, interchange

- (1) exchange rate, (2) exchange a few friendly words My sister and I frequently **exchange** books, as we love reading.
- a close emotional connection between two or more people; a certificate of debt that a government or corporation issues to raise money

synonym: bind, adhesion, attachment

(1) **bond** as a family, (2) global **bond** market They had formed a friendship **bond**.

bond

#### essential

adj. indispensable; fundamental synonym: critical, crucial, basic

(1) **essential** amino acid, (2) **essential** commodities of life Trial and error is an **essential** part of education.

#### carbon

- a chemical element that can be found in pure form as diamond or graphite, and it is also an essential part of coal and oil and is found in all plants and animals
- (1) carbon dioxide, (2) carbon emissionTrees absorb carbon dioxide and give off oxygen.

## phosphorus

 a chemical element with the symbol P and atomic number 15 that is a non-metallic, highly reactive, and luminescent element

synonym: P, phosphoric, phosphorous

(1) **phosphorus** element, (2) yellow **phosphorus Phosphorus** compounds are commonly used to manufacture fertilizers to promote plant growth.

## nitrogen

- a chemical element with the symbol N and atomic number 7, which is a highly reactive element that forms part of many compounds, including amino acids and proteins
- (1) heavy **nitrogen**, (2) **nitrogen** absorption **Nitrogen** gas is used to inflate car tires because it does not react with rubber.

#### nutrient

 any substance that is essential for the maintenance and growth of living things

synonym: food, vitamin

(1) nutrient medicine, (2) a nutrient for hair

They used fast-acting **nutrients** on the flowers in the flower beds.

## penetrate

v. to pass into or through something, often by overcoming resistance

synonym: pierce, stab, go through

(1) **penetrate** a cell, (2) **penetrate** quickly into the skin Western ideology slowly **penetrates** through the eastern countries.

#### structure

 the way of construction of something and the arrangement of its parts, or a complex thing constructed of many parts

synonym: construction, architecture, establishment

(1) the **structure** of a machine, (2) **structure** and function of the brain

The organizational **structure** of start-ups is often flat and straightforward.

#### harmonious

adj. characterized by harmony or agreement; free from conflict or disagreement; pleasing or soothing in sound or tone

synonym: concordant, consistent, melodious

(1) **harmonious** relationship, (2) **harmonious** blend The painting's **harmonious** composition and balance of colors made it a masterpiece.

#### scratch

v. to cut or damage the surface of something or the skin with a sharp or pointed object

synonym: claw, rub, scrape

(1) **scratch** off a name, (2) **scratch** my signature Don't **scratch** your mosquito bites.

#### pause

v. to take a short break from talking or doing something before continuing

synonym: halt, break, intermit

(1) **pause** a moment, (2) **pause** for a reaction The man **paused** before opening the door.

## evolution

- n. a gradual process of transformation of living thingssynonym: elaboration, expansion, transition
- (1) human **evolution**, (2) **evolution** theory

They study the **evolution** of the universe.

#### determinant

 a factor, circumstance, or condition that contributes to the shaping, influencing, or determining of a particular outcome or result

*synonym*: cause, factor, element

(1) environmental **determinant**, (2) a **determinant** of crop yields

One **determinant** of success is having a positive attitude and a strong work ethic.

#### brain

- the organ inside the head that is responsible for one's movement, thought, memory, and feeling
- *synonym*: intellect, mind, encephalon
- basic brain function, (2) permanent brain damage
   rays revealed a small tumor in his brain.

#### reaction

a response that reveals a person's feelings or attitude;
 (in chemistry) a process in which one or more substances are changed into others

synonym: response, reply, answer

(1) chemical **reaction**, (2) trigger a **reaction**There was a chemical **reaction** of the lime with the groundwater.

#### tropical

- *adj.* originating in, located in, or characteristic of the tropics *synonym*: equatorial, tropic
- (1) **tropical** cyclones, (2) **tropical** islands **Tropical** storm Marco is making his way along the coast of Florida.

#### rainforest

- n. a forest rich in biodiversity that is generally found in tropical settings with heavy annual rainfall
- (1) **rainforest** destruction, (2) tropical **rainforest**The destruction of the **rainforest** is a ticking time bomb for the Earth.

#### incredible

adj. unbelievable; enormoussynonym: unbelievable, fantastical, inconceivable

(1) **incredible** amount, (2) at **incredible** speed Her response revealed **incredible** idiocy.

## diversity

 the quality or fact of many different types of things or people being included in something; a range of different things or people

synonym: variety, multiplicity, variousness

- (1) the **diversity** policy of the university, (2) lingual **diversity** He was impressed by the range and **diversity** of the collection.
- the most important facts, ideas, or events from which something is developed; the way how things are organized or arranged

synonym: foundation, base, ground

(1) on an equal **basis**, (2) **basis** for calculation This evidence will form the **basis** for our discussion.

#### nutrition

basis

- n. the substances or the process that organisms take into their bodies as food for their growth and healthsynonym: alimentation, nourishment, sustenance
- (1) nutrition condition, (2) nutrition intakeThis food contains all the nutrition your dog requires.

#### **function**

n. the purpose or use of an object, system, or process; a particular activity or operation that is designed to serve a specific purpose; a mathematical concept that describes a relationship between two sets of values, called the input and output sets; (verb) to operate or work in a specific way, or to perform a particular task or purpose

synonym: purpose, mapping, job

(1) **function** properly, (2) immune **function**The brain is an incredibly complex organ that controls the body's **function**.

#### interact

- v. to communicate or react with somebodysynonym: cooperate, combine, collaborate
- (1) **interact** directly with customers, (2) **interact** with one another

He should **interact** more with his colleagues.

#### fast-forward

v. to advance or move forward in time or progress, particularly in a rapid or accelerated manner; to increase the playback speed of a recording

synonym: advance, hasten, speed up

(1) **fast-forward** 10 seconds, (2) **fast-forward** to the good part

I like to **fast-forward** through commercials when watching TV shows.

## manipulate

- v. to influence or control something or someone to your advantage, often in an unfair or dishonest way
   synonym: control, exploit, abuse
- (1) **manipulate** figures, (2) vulnerable to **manipulate** Please tell me how to **manipulate** this computer.

#### consistent

adj. always behaving or happening in the same way, or having the same thoughts, standards, etc.

synonym: coherent, constant, compatible

(1) do on a **consistent** basis, (2) get **consistent** results You are not **consistent** in your behavior.

## discriminating

adj. having or showing the ability to judge or discern,
 typically by distinguishing differences or making careful and considered choices; selective in a discerning way; showing refined taste or awareness of quality

synonym: selective, critical, discerning

(1) **discriminating** judgment, (2) **discriminating** eye The restaurant has **discriminating** tastes when selecting the best ingredients for their dishes.

#### allocate

- v. to give or distribute something, such as resources or duties, to someone or something for a particular purpose synonym: apportion, assign, distribute
- (1) **allocate** resource, (2) **allocate** budgets

  The company **allocated** a portion of its profits to developing new products.

## reciprocal

- adj. given or felt by each toward the other; mutual;corresponding or interchangeablesynonym: mutual, complementary, supplemental
- (1) have a **reciprocal** respect, (2) **reciprocal** actions

  Their relationship was based on **reciprocal** love and respect for each other.

## experiment

 the scientific test conducted to observe what happens and gain new knowledge

synonym: experimentation, investigation

(1) **experiment** design, (2) series of **experiments** His **experiments** showed highly positive results.

#### inoculate

v. to introduce a vaccine into the body to produce immunity to a specific disease

synonym: vaccinate, immunize, protect

(1) **inoculate** against disease, (2) **inoculate** with a virus The doctor **inoculated** the child with a vaccine.

#### emerge

v. to move out of or away from something and become visible

synonym: arise, occur, appear

(1) **emerge** as a butterfly, (2) **emerge** from poverty During colonial eras, new migratory patterns **emerged**.

#### nonetheless

adv. in spite of what has just been said or done; nevertheless synonym: nevertheless, regardless, still

(1) we are **nonetheless** confident, (2) love him **nonetheless** 

They each choose **nonetheless** to battle.

#### incredibly

adv. in a way that is very difficult to believe; exceedingly or extremely

synonym: enormously, exceptionally, extraordinarily

(1) **incredibly** cheerful character, (2) get **incredibly** insecure

Several cities are experiencing **incredibly** high unemployment rates.

## opportunistic

- adj. making use of a current situation to get power or advantage, especially regardless of planning or principlesynonym: timeserving, conciliatory
- (1) **opportunistic** fungus, (2) **opportunistic** behavior Many of the party's members joined for simply **opportunistic** reasons.

## hijack

v. to seize control of an airplane or other vehicle during an operation, especially with violence

synonym: commandeer, seize, pirate

(1) **hijack** a helicopter, (2) **hijack** a phone number He made a desperate effort to **hijack** an airliner.

## uptake

n. the rate or amount of something that is taken in or used by a particular system or organism; the process of taking food into the body through the mouth by eating

synonym: absorption, incorporation, intake

(1) uptake rate, (2) uptake of calcium

The uptake of the new technology was slower than expected.

## suppress

v. to bring something under control by force or authority; to put an end by force

synonym: subdue, bury, stifle

(1) **suppress** a yawn, (2) **suppress** a revolt

The doctor prescribed medication to **suppress** the patient's appetite.

#### addiction

n. the inability to stop using or doing something as a habit, especially something harmful

synonym: dependence

(1) alcohol **addiction**, (2) **addiction** to foreign oil He is now fighting his **addiction** to drugs.

#### inflate

 to fill something with air or gas so that it becomes bigger and rounder

synonym: blow up, expand, puff up

(1) **inflate** a tire, (2) **inflate** expense reports She **inflated** the balloons for the party.

#### extract

hoard

n. a short passage taken from a book, piece of music, etc.; a substance obtained from something through a specific process; (verb) to obtain from something or to remove something by effort or force

synonym: excerpt, quote, distillation

- (1) a brief **extract** from the book, (2) botanical **extract** Anesthetize the gum before **extracting** the teeth.
- v. to collect money, valuables, etc., for future use secretly; (noun) a secret store or collection of money, valuables, etc., for future use

synonym: stockpile, accumulation, stash

(1) hoard my possessions, (2) plutonium hoardThey hoarded a common secret instead of sharing it.

#### unavailable

adj. not able to be used or accessed; not present, able to be found, or able to be contacted

synonym: inaccessible, unobtainable, out of reach

(1) **unavailable** resource, (2) **unavailable** option

The professor is currently **unavailable** but will respond to your email as soon as possible

#### compete

 to strive to achieve more success than someone or something

synonym: contend, contest, vie

## compete

(1) **compete** against a friend, (2) **compete** fiercely You must **compete** with others to obtain this position.

#### economics

 n. the branch of social science that deals with the production, consumption, and transfer of goods and services

synonym: social science, finance, business

(1) welfare economics, (2) economics professorHis class will cover an introduction to agricultural economics.

avail

- v. to help or benefit; to use or take advantage of synonym: help, benefit, serve
- (1) **avail** you little, (2) **avail** ourselves of this opportunity Their financing options are reasonable and easy to **avail**.

## cunning

- adj. clever or skillful in achieving a goal, especially deceptively or secretly; shrewd or wily
- synonym: sly, crafty, tricky
- (1) cunning plan, (2) cunning thief

The **cunning** fox managed to elude the hunters and escape with his prey.

#### orchid

- n. a plant with showy or unusual flowers, typically having either a single, complex flower or a cluster of small flowers, many of which are prized for their beauty and often cultivated as ornamental plants
- orchid garden, (2) orchid species
   The orchid blooms were so delicate and beautiful.

#### devious

- adj. cunning and deceitful; not straightforward; tricky synonym: cunning, deceitful, tricky
- (1) **devious** plot, (2) use **devious** methods
  The **devious** plan to cheat on the test was foiled by the teacher.

#### tap

to hit someone or something quickly, gently, and often repeatedly; to use existing resources, such as energy,

knowledge, etc.

synonym: knock, exploit, use

(1) **tap** a new market, (2) **tap** keyboard with an index finger To expand the company, we must **tap** new human resources.

## photosynthesis

- n. the process through which plants and other organisms transform light energy into chemical energy, which is then released through cellular respiration to power the organism's activities.
- (1) oxygenic photosynthesis, (2) process of photosynthesis In photosynthesis, plants use carbon dioxide to feed themselves.

## parasite

- an organism that lives on or in another organism and benefits by deriving nutrients at the other's expense
   synonym: hitchhiker, leech, saprophyte
- (1) blood-sucking **parasite**, (2) **parasite** disease Tapeworms are **parasites** that live in the intestines of humans and animals.

#### flourish

- v. to grow or develop vigorously or successfully synonym: boom, advance, succeed
- flourish economically, (2) flourish worldwide
   The Ottoman Empire flourished for over five centuries.

#### decode

v. to convert something, such as a message or piece of information, from a specific form into one that you can understand

*synonym*: decipher, translate, interpret

(1) **decode** a message, (2) ability to **decode** the differences. The software could **decode** the encrypted data and reveal the hidden information.

#### altruism

 n. the belief or practice of disinterested and selfless concern for the well-being of others; unselfish devotion to the welfare of others often expressed as acts of

## kindness or charity

synonym: selflessness, philanthropy, generosity

(1) acts of altruism, (2) altruism in society

His act of volunteering at the homeless shelter was a clear example of practical **altruism**.

## struggle

v. to make a great effort to do something when it is difficult, or there are a lot of problems; to use force or violence to break away from restraint or constriction

synonym: toil, strive, compete

(1) **struggle** against discrimination, (2) **struggle** to get the iob

He could not **struggle** against temptation.

## judge

 a person who makes decisions in a court of law; (verb) to determine the result of or form a critical opinion of something

synonym: arbiter, justice, (verb) deduce

(1) **judge** a competition, (2) an associate **judge**The strict **judge** ruled in favor of the plaintiff in the case.

morality

- n. principles of right and evil or good and bad behaviorsynonym: decency, rectitude, righteousness
- (1) business **morality**, (2) sense of **morality**She found fault with the **morality** of politicians.
